- 16-1. Installation of the LCD

- 4. The display window size should be the same as the effective viewing area.

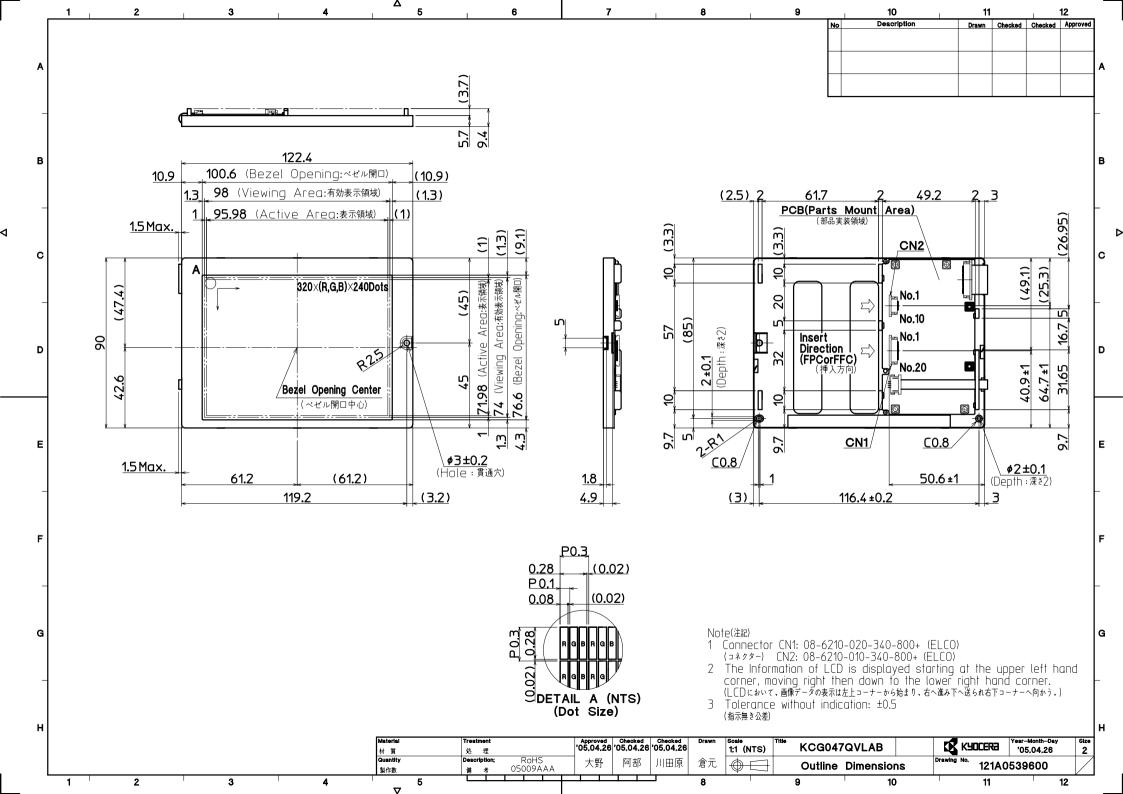
