






We recommend using the supplied hand strap to avoid dropping the camera.

- HR6/AA Rechargeable Ni-MH (nickel metal hydride) batteries
- Do not use batteries other than those listed above.

4. Sequence of operations



Press the Power button

The power is turned on.

Press the shutter button and take pictures

- 1 Press halfway (press lightly and focus)
- ② Press fully (press the button all the way to record)

Press [MODE] button to select the Recording Mode.

- Taking pictures with automatic settings.
- Take pictures with your own settings.
- SQN Take pictures according to scene.
- Take motion pictures.

■Setting the menu

Press [MENU/SET] to display the menu screen to change the recording function, camera settings, and other settings.
