## Stokke tripp trapp high chair manual

The material from which the Table Top™ is manufactured, is not dishwasher-safe. Therefore we recommend washing it by hand. The Table Top™ and suction cups can be washed with warm water and dishwasher detergent. Stokke® Tray is compatible with Stokke® Baby set version "V2" or "V3". If there is a mark "V2" or "V3" on the inner side of the Baby set rail (next to the sides attachment), then the Stokke® Tray will be compatible with the Baby set. If there is no mark on the rail the Baby set is version V1 and the Stokke® Tray will unfortunately not fit. The tamper-proof buckle has an effective design that is intended to protect your little one securely on the Tripp Trapp® chair. We encourage you to spend 10 minutes to familiarize yourself with the product and properly adjust it prior to first use. Please remember that since your child is constantly growing you need to readjust the Stokke® Harness on a regular basis. Most important: never leave your child unattended. The Stokke® Table Top is only meant to be used on level, smooth and clean surfaces, otherwise the suction cups cannot create a vacuum. If you suspect the suction cups may not be functioning adequately, please test the product on various surfaces. The Tray should not be loaded with more than 5 kg/11 lbs. Please see this film showing how to assemble the Stokke Harness. Click here. The Stokke® Table Top is not scratch-proof. Its surface can be damaged with a hard or sharp object and scratches may appear on the surface after some time. This is considered a result of normal wear and tear of the product.



"If you find that the leg space of the current, plastic Stokke® Tripp Trapp® Baby Set™ is too tight for your child, please make sure the Tripp Trapp® chair itself is adjusted correctly (with the seat plate installed according to the instructions in the Tripp Trapp® user guide) and the Baby Set™ fitted according to instructions in the Baby Set™ user guide. Both user guides for the Tripp Trapp® chair as well as the Baby Set™ can be downloaded from: On a general note, the new Stokke® Tripp Trapp® Baby Set™ has undergone rigorous testing and had been in use in the US, to high customer satisfaction, for several years before its introduction in Europe in 2011. It was designed to meet revised international safety standards for high chairs (used between 6 and 36 months of age) and to fit the average child. Of course, it may well happen in some cases that a child grows faster than the norm and outgrows the Baby Set™ before it reaches the maximum age advertised." In the box, the Stokke® Tripp Trapp® Baby Set™ (6-36 months) measures 43 x 19 x 22 cm. and weighs 0.75 kg. The dimensions of the product itself are as follows: Safety rail: width, from end to end, 40 cm / depth, from front to back, 20 cm / height, top of the rail to the seating plate, 20 cm. Back piece: width 35 cm / height 22.5 cm. In the box, the Stokke® Tripp Trapp® Newborn Set™ (0-6 months) measures 51 x 20 x 36 cm, and weighs 2.5 kg. The dimensions of the product itself are as follows: Outer shell: length 50.5 cm / width 35 cm / height 19.5 cm. Inner seat: length "head to toe" 41 cm / max. depth (at centre) 16 cm The EU/UK Stokke® Tripp Trapp® Newborn Set™ is compatible with US Tripp Trapp® chairs. However, it has not been certified for sale in the US due to differing standards and test methods from those in Europe. The Stokke® Table Top suction cups are packed in pairs and these are stuck together in the packaging. Please check whether you have two packages of two suction cups. If this is not the case, please contact our Customer Service helpdesk for your respective country via the following link and provide your full address details: The Stokke® Table Top tray is made of MABS (Methylmethacrylate Acrylonitrile Butadiene Styrene) and free from harmful substances such as phthalates and bisphenol. It is perfectly safe to use with food. Page 2 2US/CA• Never leave child unattended• The Tripp Trapp® Baby Set™ should only be used with the seat plate in the rst groove from the top of the chair. • Always use the restraint system when the seat is in one of the top 3 grooves. • Always keep child in view. • Stay in reach of your child. • Do not use the chair unless all components are correctly tted and adjusted. Pay special attention to the seat and foot plate - make sure these are properly fastened before you put your child into the chair. • Do not place the chair near an open re or other sources of strong heat, such as electric bar res, gas res etc due to the risk of re. • Do not use the chair if any part is broken, torn or missing. • Do not use the chair before the child can sit up by itself. • Always place the chair on a level stable surface and make sure that the chair has space to slide backwards. • Be careful not to place small items, toxic substances, hot objects, and electrical exes etc near the chair where your child can reach them, as they may cause choking, poisoning or other injuries. • Remember to retighten all screws 2-3 weeks after assembly of the chair. After that you should check on and retighten the screws if necessary on a regular basis, e.g. every second month. Keep the Allen key for future use, but out of the childs reach. • Do not use any accessories or replacement parts not manufactured by STOKKE®; this may aect your child's safety. • Do not use the chair as a step stool. • Do not use with a booster seat• The child should be secured in the chair at all times by the restraining system• TRIPP TRAPP® is intended for use when your child is capa-ble of sitting upright unassisted (approximately 6 months)• Front of footrest not to exceed front legs of chair at oor level• NEVER use the Tripp Trapp® chair without any glider. • Do not use the harness if it shows any signs of deteriora-tion or excessive wear and tear, such as fraying of the straps or cracks in the plastic. If any such deterioration or excessive wear and tear is observed, please contact Stokke Customer service to order a replacement. • If the chair is used with a tray, the tray is not designed to hold the child in the chair. Rough surfaces (uneven oors ), for instance rugs and tiles To prevent the Tripp Trapp® chair from tilting when pushed backwards, it has plastic gliders underneath the legs. Their function is to enable the chair to slide backwards and return to an upright position when pushed backwards. To make sure that the gliders function as intended, the chair should be placed on a surface enabling the chair to slide backwards. Thus, the surface should be level, stable and with a certain hardness. Uneven and/or rough surfaces, for instance some tiled oors, and rugs/carpets that are soft or with long loose ends, are generally unsuitable for chairs used by toddlers. Although the Tripp Trapp® chair is recognized for its stability, these conditions also apply here. The gliders as well as the oor must be kept clean. To further increase the backward stability of the Tripp Trapp® highchair,a replaceable, extended rear glider ("Extended Glider") has been devel-oped for the Tripp Trapp® highchair. For the period when the chair is used with a harness or the Tripp Trapp® Baby Set, we recommendthat you always use it with the Tripp Trapp® Extended Glider. This is especially important if the chair is placed on a soft carpet and/or at a table where the child can push against a frame underneath the table-top with its feet.WarningNEVER let your child play around the Tripp Trapp® chair if it is not in the intended position for use. TableBe aware of the risk that a big frame under the table top makes it easier for children to push their legs against the table and tilt backwards. Also note that Tripp Trapp® is designed for dining tables 28-30" (72-76cm) high. WarningWhen the footrest is positioned close to the metal rod, there will be a small gap between the inside of the chair legs and the metal rod. This is perfectly normal. Never try to use excessive force to make the metal rod touch the side legs of the chair as this can cause damage to the chair and/or make it unstable. FootrestMake sure the forward edge of the footrest NEVER exceeds the front tip of the chair legs at oor level. This may cause the chair to be unstable when a child climbs in and out of the Tripp Trapp® chair.Page 3
