- Turns on/off automatically.


Noted: you will hear the Voice guidance of Power On, Power Off, Pairing, Connected, Disconnected and Battery low for related operating.

USING YOUR SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA

1.TURNING ON THE SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA

Slide the on/off button to turn the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA on or off.





2.FIRST TIME PAIRING WITH YOUR DEVICE

First make sure SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA was slid ON, LED indicator will guide you through pairing with your mobile phone.

- Press and hold Multi-function button for 3 seconds until LED indicator flashing blue and red alternative(entering pairing mode).
- On your mobile device, turn on the Bluetooth feature.
- Select your BC980SA from the device list. Once paired, the LED indicator glows blue and Flashing Blue once every 10 seconds.

Tip: The Bluetooth feature is usually found in the Settings menu.




NOTE : After the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA and a mobile phone have been paired they will automatically connect whenever the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA is switched on and the mobile phone has bluetooth activated and is within range.

3.Positioning the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA


Clip the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA to the sun visor in your vehicle.

4.Charging YOUR SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA

- In-car charging**
Connect the USB cable with car charger attachment to the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA and the car lighter socket in your vehicle.
- PC charging**
Connect the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA to any available USB slot on your PC, using the USB cable.

What you see	What it means
Steady Blue on 3 seconds	Power on
Steady Red on 1 seconds	Power off
Flashing Blue twice every 10 seconds	The SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA is powered on, but not connected to a mobile phone (standby mode)
Flashing Blue and Red	The SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA is in pairing mode, and ready to connect
Flashing Blue once every 6 seconds	A mobile phone Bluetooth connected to the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA
Flashing Blue once every 6 seconds	Music streaming
Steady red	Battery is charging
Green off	Battery is fully charged
Flashing Red every 5 seconds	Low battery

SUPPORT FAQ

Q: I hear crackling noises
A: Bluetooth is a radio technology that is sensitive to object between the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA and the connected device. Ensure the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA and the connected device are within 33 feet (10 meters) of each other, with no major objects in the way (walls, etc.).

Q: I cannot hear anything
A: - Increase the speaker volume.
- Ensure the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA is paired to a device that is playing.
- Make sure your phone is connected to the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA by pressing and holding the Multi-function button.

Q: I am having pairing problems
A: You may have deleted the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA pairing connection in your mobile phone. Follow the pairing instructions.

Q: Will the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA work with other Bluetooth equipment?
A: The SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA is designed to work with Bluetooth mobile phones. It can also support other Bluetooth devices that are compliant with Bluetooth version 1.1 or higher and support a headset, hands-free and/or advance audio distribution profile.

Q: I cannot use Reject call, call on hold, Redial or voice dialing
A: These features require your mobile phone to support a handsfree profile. Refer to your mobile phone user manual for more details.

Q: My voice commands does not work
A: This feature requires your mobile phone to support voice commands such as Siri, Google assistant or other voice control software. Refer to your mobile phone user manual for more Details.

Q: I want to reset the pairing list in my speakerphone
A: - The speakerphone registers a list of up to 8 mobile phones . To clear the pairing list and reset the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA to factory settings you can turn the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA on while pressing and for about 10 seconds.
- When you see LED indicator flashing blue and red, release the buttons.
- The time you power on the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA it will automatically go into pairing mode.

Q: I want to cancel Auto Power On function
A: - MANUALLY disable this feature by turning off the speakerphone . Slide the on/off button to turn the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA of f.

Q: Pairing With Two Mobile Phones
A: 1). Slide on the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA .Pair and connect BC980SA with the FIRST phone as the above pairing instructions.
2). Slide off the SUNITEC BC980SA and deactivate the Bluetooth on the first phone.

- Slide on the SUNITEC PREMIUM BC980SA again. Pair and connect BC980SA with the SECOND phone as the above pairing instructions.
- Slide off the SUNITEC BC980SA and activate the Bluetooth on the both phones.
- Slide on the SUNITEC BC980SA, connected with both phones.
