Its easier for me to torture test and say ya or na to a board for you guys. Then let you guess. I can always sell no good setups to some kid for gaming, they love them. Like the SLI NF4 fiascos. The NF3s are much better for PTLE. Even my old Abit NF7s NF2 with a mobile XP 2500 beats the NF4s. I don't every remember anyone having a real bad setup with the DFI and running it stock or a little OCed. Matt. Im having trouble with buffer problems during playback. Im thinking it would be because I didn't install it with the standard pc option. So I try to reinstall windows XP Pro with the standard pc option but all it allows me to choose is. Standard pc with cstep i486 or other Doesn't let me choose anything else. If I choose standard pc with cstep i486, the computer freezes at the starting windows stage. Should I delete my partition beforehand instead of doing it later in the windows installer.

Even then, it shouldn't really affect what I can choose as options tho. I imagine a 16MB Cache Hard Drive will send and receive data quickly, so Im going to use that with Pro Tools, and it was cheaper than a 200GB 8MB Cache Hard Drive. Im going to buy a smaller, 8MB cache hard drive from Micro Center right now. I hope this system works out. I haven't seen this problem yet. You should be able to use this board with ACPI settings. I think you need to install different drivers for your hard drive controllers. Should have come with the Asus motherboard CD. How much ram did you install Allen The reason I ask is because I have always used Memorex CDRs for no reason other than brand loyalty. FutureShop had a killer deal on some Sony CDRs, and I figured Sony was a good name, but none of the CRDs would allow me to burn. Put in the good old memorex and I was burning again. I was just wondering if this Liteon is picky at all. Who knows, maybe I just bought a bad batch of Sonys. Looks great Ras. Way to go! Allen. Known issue with Microsoft install. Use your up arrow when you get to the install choices you can only see 2 choices at a time during this point of your installation. Anyway, use up arrow to get to Standard PC or whatever else you choose That should get you set to go. GregJ. I was running PT on my Mac G4 400 but it was simply getting to the point where all the new versions of PTs and new plugins were just too sluggish. With the advent of WinXP, Ive developed a totally new opinion of PC based systems as reliable workhorses. Anyway, I am delighted with the performance of my new system so I thought Id share what I built on this thread. I have had a very complex session running with Reason 2.5, lots of midi tracks playing ARP 2600 V and Moog Modular V AND my hardware synths and quite a few plugins mostly Waves and this system still copes easily.
