Diagnostic Tool Instructions

Self-Service Software Updates

Application / Introduction

These instructions are only applicable with the diagnostic tools listed in the preceding *Important Information* section.

The Self-Service Software Update feature allows you to directly download the latest software upgrades and service releases (updates) as soon as they become available.

Checking For Software Updates

- 1. Connect the diagnostic tool to Wi-Fi.
- 2. From the home screen select **Tools** > **Software Updates** (*Figure 1*).



- a. If updates <u>are</u> available, download instructions are displayed, see **Downloading Software Updates (next section)**.
- b. If updates <u>are not</u> available, a message displays (*Figure 2*) indicating your software is up to date. Exit the menu, no further action is needed.



Downloading Software Updates

IMPORTANT

READ THIS BEFORE YOU START - Depending on your Wi-Fi connection and the size of the update, download times will vary. Download times can range from 15 to 120 minutes or more.

NOTE

If the Internet connection is interrupted or you select cancel during a download, the download is canceled. You must restart the process from the beginning.

If software upstates were available when **Checking For Software Updates (previous section)**, follow these steps to download the update:

- 1. Connect the AC power supply to the diagnostic tool.
- 2. Connect the tool to Wi-Fi.
- 3. Select Download and Install (Figure 3).



- **4.** Once the download completes (*Figure 4*), select:
 - a. Install Now—starts the installation immediately
 - b. Finish Later—allows you to install the update at another time. To install the software later, re-select Tools > Software Updates.



- 5. Review the EULA, then click the checkbox and select Agree and Continue.

6. Once the installation is complete, press the "Y/✓" button to restart the tool.

7. After the tool has restarted, recheck and install any additional updates. See Checking for Software Updates (previous section) to restart the process. Repeat the process until your software is up to date as shown in Figure 6.
