SAFETY FIRST

Safety is essential in the use and maintenance of this tool. This instruction manual and any markings on the tool provide information for avoiding hazards an unsafe practices related to the use of this tool. Observe all of the safety information provided.

SAFETY ALERT SYMBOLS

This symbol is used to call your attention to hazards or unsafe practices that could result in injury or property damage. The three signal words, defined below, indicate the severity of the hazard. The message after the signal word provides the information for preventing or avoiding the hazard.

Make sure bystanders are clear of the work area when loading, unloading or dispensing cable onto iTOOLco Axles.

Do not use with damaged reels. Damaged reels may not roll freely and may be pulled off the axle.

WARNING - ENTANGLEMENT HAZARD

Do not operate this tool while wearing loose-fitting clothing. Retain long hair.

DESCRIPTION AND SPECIFICATIONS

iTOOLco Axles are designed to safely and quickly support wire reels in conjunction with reel jacks such as iTOOLco's Real Jacks. All iTOOLco Axles are manufactured from steel 1026 ASTM A 513.



Axle capacity calculated to a factor of safety three times.

Moment of point load not to exceed 18 inches from either end at max load rating.



SET UP AND OPERATION

One set of iTOOLco Real Jacks (or two alike reel stands) and one iTOOLco Axle are required for complete set up.

Set Up and Operation

- 1. Always wear gloves and eye protection when working with iTOOLco Real Jacks and Axles.
- 2. Make sure wire reel is chocked to prevent movement during setup.
- 3. Position the iTOOLco Axle through the center holes of wire reel. (Fig. 1)
- 4. Place Real Jacks on either side of reel with longer side (T-shaped end) toward the pull.
- 5. Pull out the pop pin and stand the jack upright.
- 6. Place hitch pin into vertical hole position.
- 7. Adjust roller cage to appropriate height and lock into place using the t-handle pop pin.
- 8. Slide jack into or over axle, leaving 10" between jack and reel to allow for handle to turn.
- 9. Turn handle to lift reel off floor approximately 1".
- 10. Level reel by jacking up each side to the appropriate height. Begin pulling wire.
- 11. When finished dispensing wire, the reel should be lowered in the reverse manner.

If the part(s) if found to be defective, iTOOLco will refund freight charges paid by you in retuning the defective part(s) and prepay replacement part(s) freight charges. iTOOLco will not be responsible for more than replacement of any defective part(s) and standard freight charges (parcel post or UPS ground rate) of any part(s) found to be defective.

ITOOLCO SHALL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL OR CONSEUQNTIAL DAMAGES RESULTING FROM ANY DEFECTS COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY OR ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY APPLICABLE TO THE PRODUCT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PROPERTY DAMAGE, LOSS OF USE OF PRODUCT, LOSS OF TIME, LOSS OF PROFITS, INCONVENIENCE, COMMERCIAL LOSS, LABOR COSTS, SERVICE TRIPS, AND MILEAGE.

Dealer/Distributor Warranty Claim Procedure

- 1. All warranty claims must be pre-approved by iTOOLco Warranty Department PRIOR to starting any warranty work. Warranty work performed without prior approval will not be considered.
- 2. All claims must be handled through dealer/distributor.
- 3. Written approval must be received from iTOOLco before return of merchandise. A Return Authorization is to be returned with the merchandise which is sent back.
- 4. All parts must be returned to iTOOLco at the address shown below, freight prepaid.
- 5. The serial number of the product and the date of delivery must accompany the part(s) being returned.
- 6. If the part(s) is found to have failed because of a defect in material or workmanship, replacement will be made on a no-charge basis, and the part(s) returned, freight prepaid. Standard freight charges (parcel post or UPS ground rate) incurred in returning the part(s) will be refunded.
- 7. For reasons of expediency, replacement and/or repair part(s) may be shipped as soon as possible and billed to the dealer/distributor. When part(s) is returned, if it is covered under warrant, credit will be issued for the part(s) and freight charges.
- 8. All parts found to be defective shall be retained by and shall become the property of iTOOLco. This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
