How to change the temperature/airflow

2	Press OK again.	ß		
	The black bar turns to red: the value can now be changed. Change value using \bigcirc and \bigcirc and press \bigcirc to	↓ 23 °C		
	To set airflows:	& <mark>80</mark> %
