Use

- Prepare the plug at the power pack for the existing socket:
 - US: Unfold the plug on the product.
 - EU, UK, AU: Fold in the plug on the product.
Fit the required plug attachment onto the retracted plug.
- Plug the power pack into the socket.
- Connect the USB device to be operated to the suitable USB port of the power pack using a matching USB cable.
