Returning an old modem?


- Place the old modem and power cord into a sturdy cardboard box.
 Ensure there is cushioning material around the modem
- 2. Seal the box and affix the shipping label provided
- 3. Drop off at any Canada Post mailbox or outlet

How to install your WiFi modem.

1. What you'll need.



Before you start, make sure to download the **MyShaw app** on your mobile phone.

2. Place your modem.



Where should you place the modem?

- In a central, visible and elevated-off-the-ground location
- · Avoid basement/underground spots, cabinets or hiding it behind any objects
- Away from appliances, electrical equipment and metal / stainless steel objects


4. Power up!



3. Connect.

Connect the **coax cable** from a cable wall outlet to the cable in port on your modem.

Make sure the connection is secure (hand-tightened).





Connect the **power cord** to the modem

5. Activate your modem.

If this is your first time activating your Shaw services, open the MyShaw app to:

- a. Create your MyShaw ID and password; and
- b. Complete the activation process.

Common questions.

What if I need to connect my modem and TV box to the same outlet?

This step is **optional**. You'll need a 2-way splitter and (3) lengths of coax cable total.

- a. Connect one end of the coax cable to a cable outlet in your wall and the other end to the **IN** port on the splitter
- b. Connect a second coax cable to the splitter and the modem
- c. Connect a third coax cable (included in your TV box) to the splitter and to the CABLE IN or RF IN on the back of your Shaw TV box
- d. Continue with step 4

What's my WiFi network name and password?

The sticker on the front of your modem contains your WiFi information. The **SSID** is the network name that you'll connect on your device(s) to.

Your network password is labeled as the WiFi Keu.

Your Shaw Internet plan includes access to thousands of Shaw Go WiFi hotspots.
