iPhone Connection Instructions

Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
1	 TD Phone	Open TD Phone and accept Terms.
2	 TD Phone	Select Device Settings .
3	 TD Phone	Confirm that your I-Series Bluetooth is ON in this panel then continue. If Bluetooth is off, use instructions in FAQs at the end of this document. 
4	 Your iPhone	Change Auto-Lock on your iPhone to Never. Select Settings  > Display & Brightness > Auto-Lock > Never . This keeps the screen unlocked as required by the connection process. We will remind you to return the setting to your preferred time at the end of the connection process. 
5	 Your iPhone	Open the Bluetooth Settings page on your mobile phone. Settings  > Bluetooth

6	 Your iPhone	<p>Make sure Bluetooth is ON.</p> 
<div>  <p>Keep the Bluetooth settings page shown above visible on your iPhone. Do <u>NOT</u> close this page or allow your iPhone to lock.</p>  </div>		
7	 TD Phone	Select Scan in TD Phone.
8	 TD Phone	Select Assistant Ready .
9	 TD Phone	Select the  next to the name of your iPhone.
10	 TD Phone and  Your iPhone	<p>Select Accept in TD Phone <u>AND</u> Pair on the mobile phone when they appear.</p> 
11	 Your iPhone	<p>Select the  next to your I-13 or I-16's name.</p> 
<div>  <p>Do <u>NOT</u> select the text of the device name or it will unpair.</p>  </div>		

Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
12	 Your iPhone	Be sure you are seeing the Bluetooth info page for your device on your iPhone. 
<div>  Keep the Bluetooth info page for your device show above visible on your iPhone. Do <u>NOT</u> close this page or allow your iPhone to lock until the end of the connection process.  </div>		
13	 TD Phone	Select Connect in TD Phone.
14	 Your iPhone	Select Yes to continue or No to enter a new country code in TD Phone
<div>  Connection in TD Phone will stop at Messaging because the necessary permission is not yet available in your iPhone. You will turn them on as they become available in the next few steps.  </div>		
15	 Your iPhone	Turn on Show Notifications in your mobile when it appears. 
16	 TD Phone	Select Retry in TD Phone.
<div>  Connection will succeed but contacts will not transfer because the necessary permission is not yet available in your iPhone. You will turn them on as they become available in the next few steps.  </div>		

Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
17	 Your iPhone	<p>Turn on Sync Contacts on your iPhone.</p> 
18	 TD Phone	<p>Select Update Contacts in TD Phone.</p> <p>Transfer of contacts may take some time depending on how many you have.</p> 
19	 TD Phone	<p>When transfer is complete, select Close  to close Settings and start using TD Phone.</p>
20	 Your iPhone	<p>Return your iPhone's Auto-Lock to your preferred time (typical default = 30 seconds).</p> <p>Select Settings > Display & Brightness > Auto-Lock > your preferred time.</p>

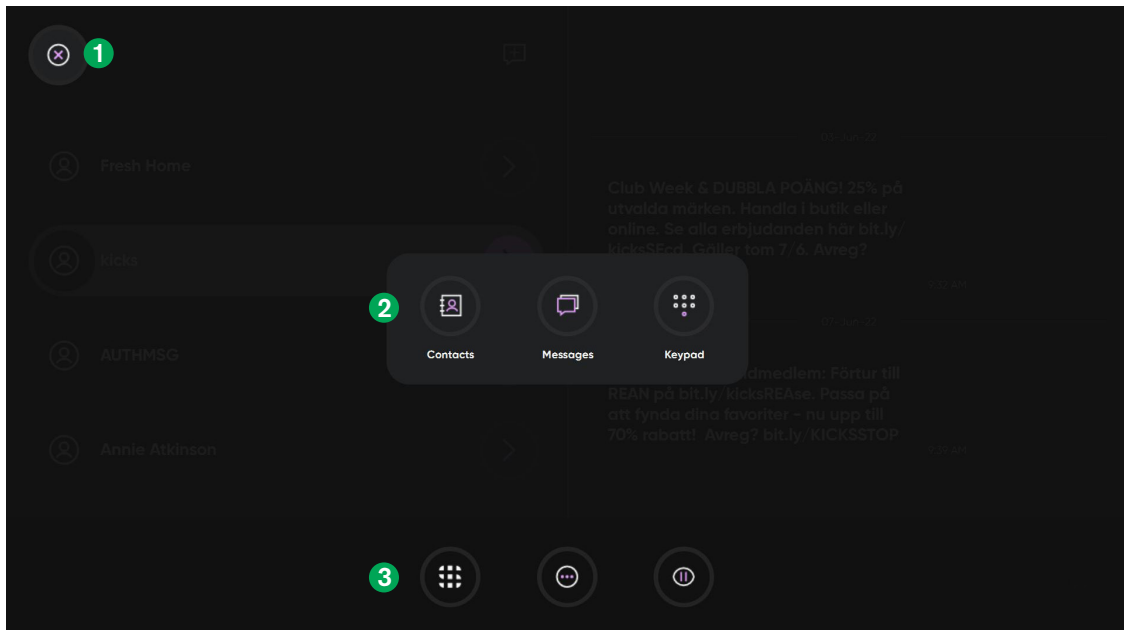
Android Connection Instructions

Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
1	 TD Phone	Open TD Phone and accept Terms.
2	 TD Phone	Select Device Settings .
3	 TD Phone	Confirm that your I-Series Bluetooth is ON in this panel then continue. If Bluetooth is off, use instructions in FAQs at the end of this document. 
4	 Your Android Phone	Change Auto-Lock on your mobile phone to the longest possible time. Select Settings > Security > Automatically Lock > longest possible time .  This keeps the screen unlocked as required by the connection process. We will remind you to return the setting to your preferred time at the end of the connection process.
5	 Your Android Phone	Open the Bluetooth Settings page on your mobile phone. Open Settings  > press and hold Bluetooth 

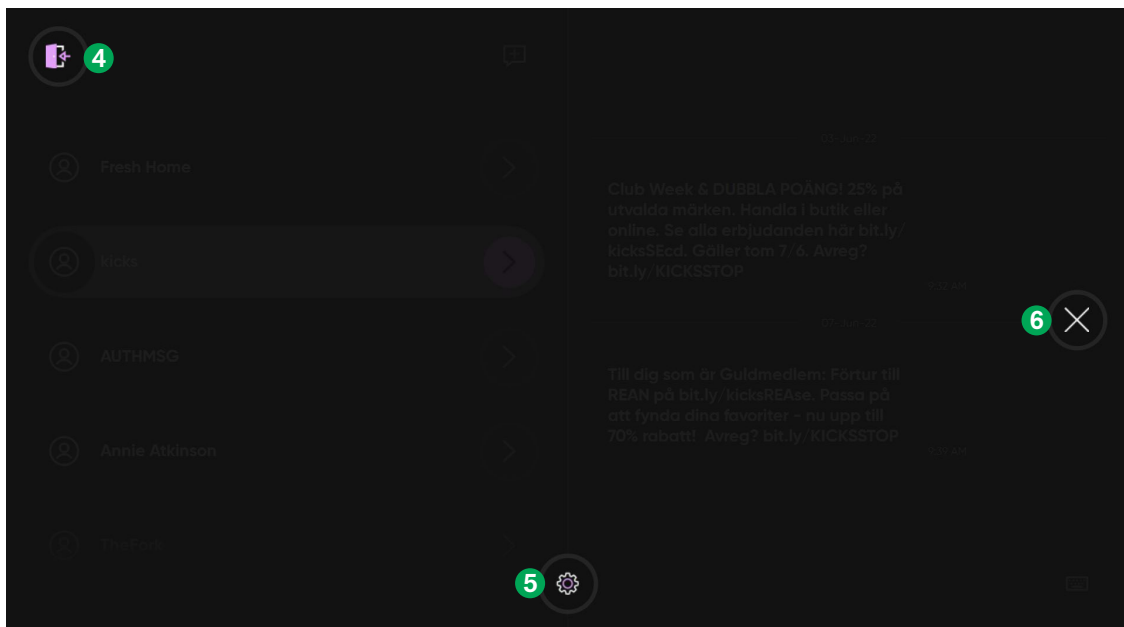
Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
6	 Your Andriod Phone	<p>Make sure Bluetooth is ON.</p> 
<div>  <p>Keep the Bluetooth settings page shown above visible on your Android phone. Do <u>NOT</u> close this page or allow your Android phone to lock.</p>  </div>		
7	 TD Phone	Select Scan in TD Phone.
8	 TD Phone	Select Assistant Ready .
9	 TD Phone	<p>Select the  next to the name of your iPhone.</p> <p>If your I-Series does not appear in the list, see FAQs in this guide.</p>
10	 TD Phone and  Your Andriod Phone	<p>Select Accept in TD Phone <u>AND</u> Pair on the mobile phone when they appear.</p> <div>   </div>
11	 Your Andriod Phone	<p>Select the  next to your I-13 or I-16's name.</p> <p>Look for DESKTOP followed by a series of numbers.</p> 
<div>  <p>Do <u>NOT</u> select the text of the device name or it will unpair.</p>  </div>		

Step	Where to Do Step	What to Do
12	 Your Andriod Phone	<p>Be sure you are seeing the page on your Android phone.</p> 
<div>  <p>Keep the Paired Device page above visible on your Android phone. Do NOT close this page or allow your Android phone to lock until the end of the connection process.</p>  </div>		
13	 TD Phone	Select Connect in TD Phone.
14	 Your iPhone	Select Yes to continue or No to enter a new country code.
15	 Your Andriod Phone	<p>Select Allow for two permissions on your mobile phone when offered.</p> 
16	 TD Phone	When you see My Devices in TD Phone, connection is complete. Select Close  to close Settings and start using TD Phone.
17	 Your Andriod Phone	<p>Return Automatically Lock to your preferred time on your mobile phone.</p> <p>Select Settings > Security > Automatically Lock > your preferred time (typical default = 30 seconds).</p>

Tour of TD Phone



- 1 Open/Close Main Menu.
- 2 Main Menu including Contacts, Messages received and sent, Keypad for texting or calling.
- 3 Off Screen Menu – appears when you look below the tracker contains (left to right) Switcher which allows you to move between apps, Dashboard where you will find Settings, and Pause/Resume eye tracking.
- 4 Exit TD Phone.
- 5 Settings where you will connect your mobile phone to TD Phone.
- 6 Close Dashboard to return to the Main Menu.



Using TD Phone



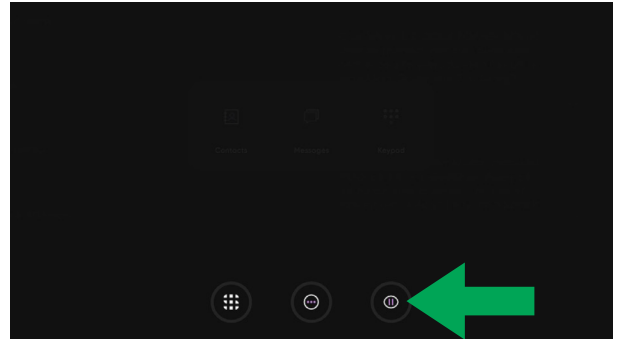
Essential for Use



- TD Phone requires that your mobile phone remain on. It does not need to remain unlocked.
- Your mobile phone should remain within 3-5 meters or 10-16 feet of your computer depending on the mobile phone.

Pause/Resume Eye Tracking

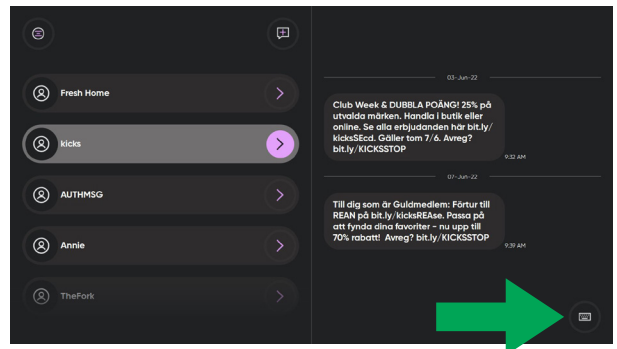
- Pause eye tracking by looking below your eye tracker. The Off Screen Menu will appear. Select **Pause** on the right.
- Resume eye tracking by looking below the eye tracker and select **Resume**.



Send a Text Message

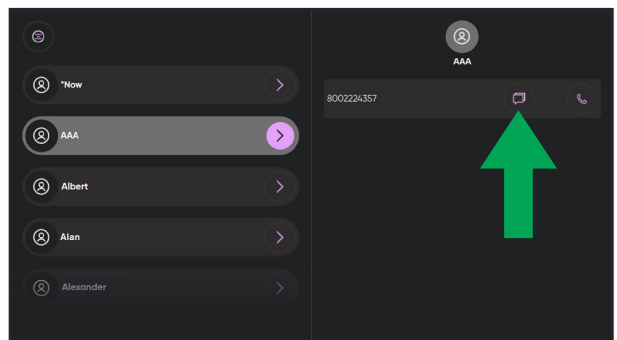
Option 1

Open **Messages** to continue previous conversations. Select the **Keyboard** button to start a new text.



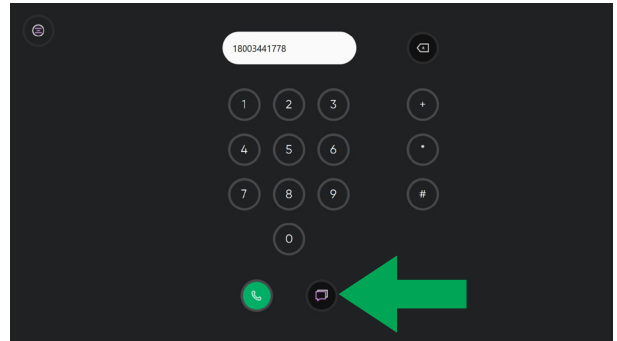
Option 2

Select a contact in Contacts and select the **Message** icon.



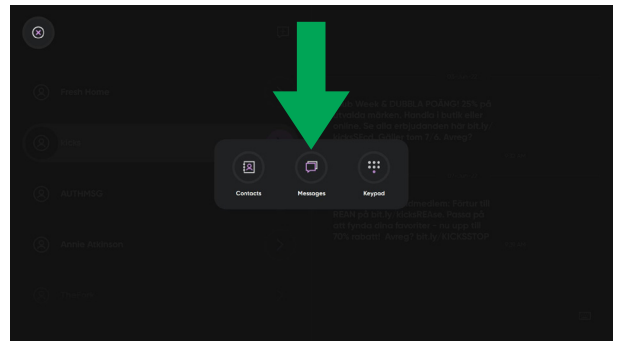
Option 3

Open **Keypad** to enter a phone number then select the **Message** icon.



Receive a Text

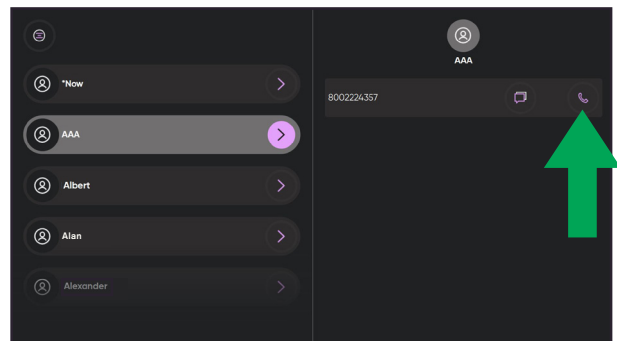
- Received texts will be indicated with a number notification on the Messages icon in the Main Menu.
- Review them when you wish.



Make a Phone Call

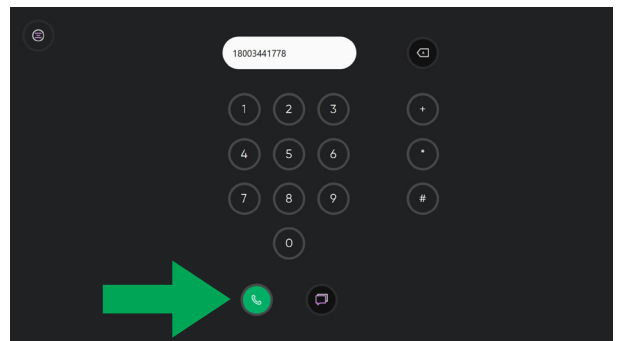
Option 1

Select a contact in Contacts and select the **Phone** icon.



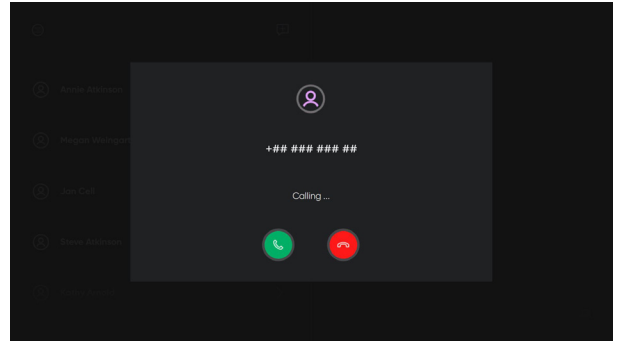
Option 2

Open **Keypad** to enter a phone number then select the **Phone** icon.



Pause/Resume Eye Tracking

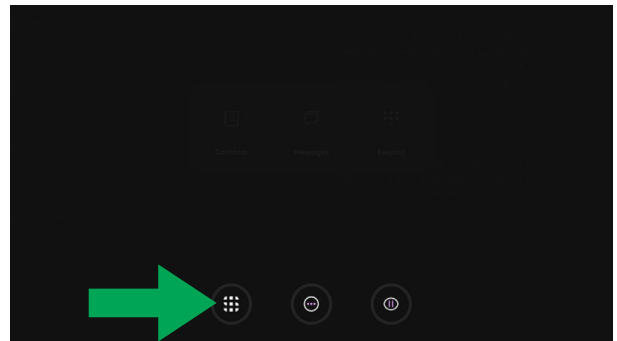
- A call window will appear over your screen.
- Select **Answer** or **Decline**.



Send a Text Message

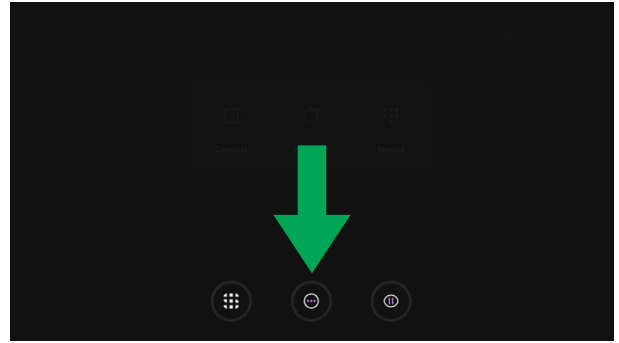
Switcher gives you access to Tobii Dynavox apps, apps you have pinned, and open apps.

- Look below the tracker to pull up the Off Screen Menu.
- Select **Switcher**.

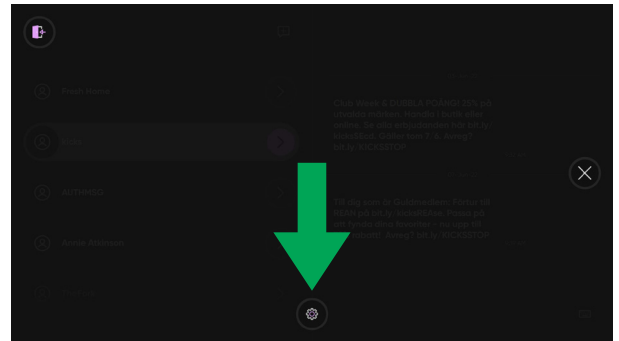


Settings

- Access Settings by opening the **Off Screen Menu** (look below the eye tracker) and selecting **Dashboard**.



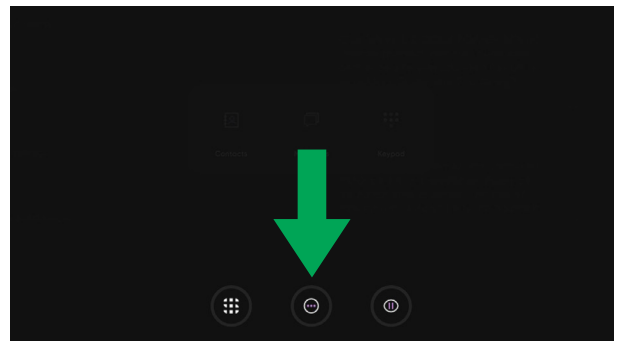
- Select **Settings**.



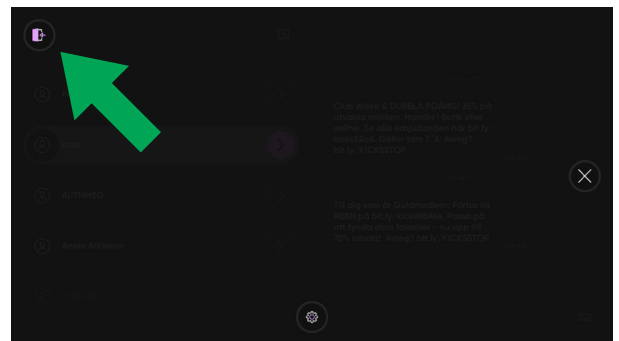
Exit TD Phone

Exit TD Phone only if you no longer need eye tracking. Use Switcher (see above) to continue use of your device with eye tracking.

- Open the **Off Screen Menu** by looking below your eye tracker. Select **Dashboard**.



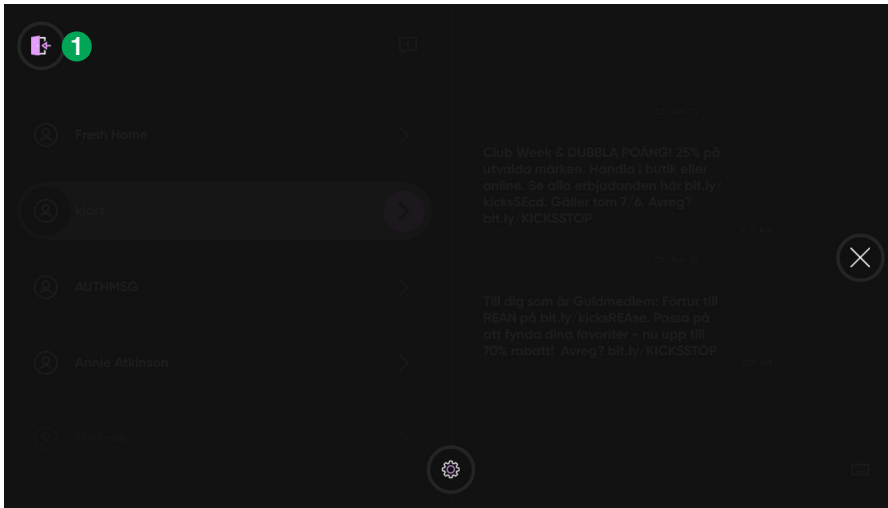
- Select **Exit**.



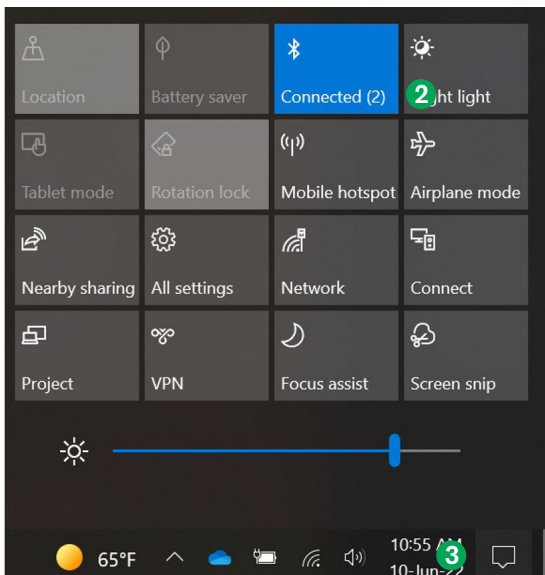
FAQs

How do I turn Bluetooth ON in my I-Series (not mobile phone)?

TD Phone tells you whether your I-Series Bluetooth is on or off. See steps 2-4 of the connection instructions for iPhone or Android. If Bluetooth is OFF in your I-Series. Use the instructions below to turn it on.



- 1 Exit TD Phone (Open the **Off Screen Menu** > select **Dashboard**, then select **Exit**).
- 2 Turn I-Series Bluetooth **ON** (Notifications > Bluetooth). It may be in a different location in your notifications.
- 3 Restart connection instructions for your mobile phone.

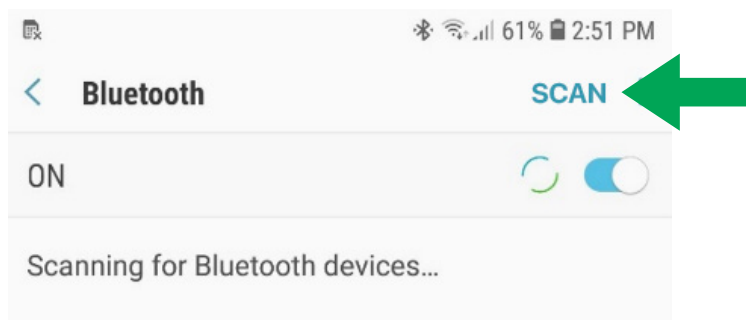


Note

The image depicts how Bluetooth looks when ON. Yours may or may not list any Connections.

What if my device does not appear in Bluetooth of my Android phone?

You may need to select **Scan or Find/pair new devices** in the Bluetooth menu.

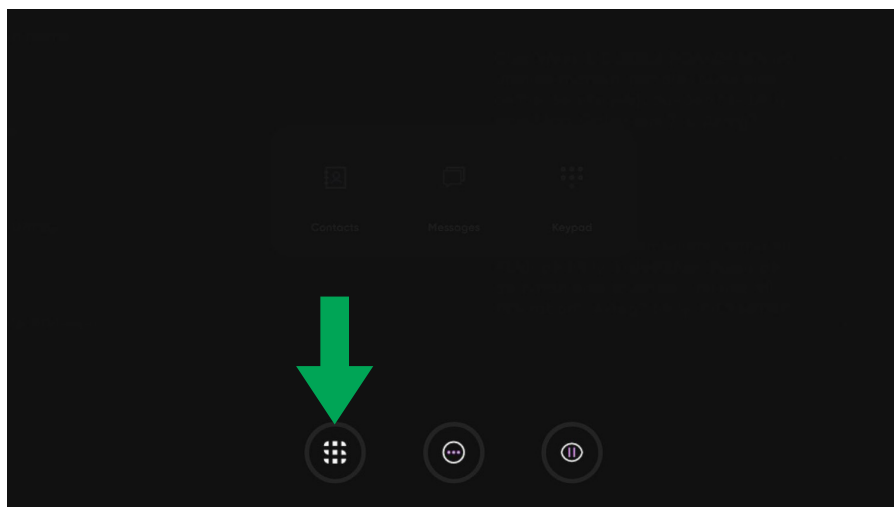


How do I recalibrate or adjust dwell times for TD Phone?

Currently, you will need to open Communicator 5, TD Control, TD Browse, or TD Snap to recalibrate and change dwell times.

How do I switch to another app on my device?

Switcher gives you access to the other Tobii Dynavox apps, your pinned apps, and apps you have open. Look below your eye tracker to open the Off Screen Menu. Switcher is on the left.



Why do I see only the last five of my messages from my iPhone in Messages?

Apple supports importing of only the last five messages. As you use TD Phone, your message history will build. It will be shared between both TD Phone and your iPhone.

How can I adjust the voice of TD Phone?

Voice options are located in TD Phone's Settings.

Off-Screen Menu > Dashboard > Settings > Open on Voice Panel

How can I increase the volume of a phone call?

Mobile phones may have separate volume controls for internal speakers versus Bluetooth devices such as ear buds and the I-Series with TD Phone. You can increase the volume only during an active phone call. Call someone or ask them to call you then adjust volume using the volume buttons on your mobile phone.
