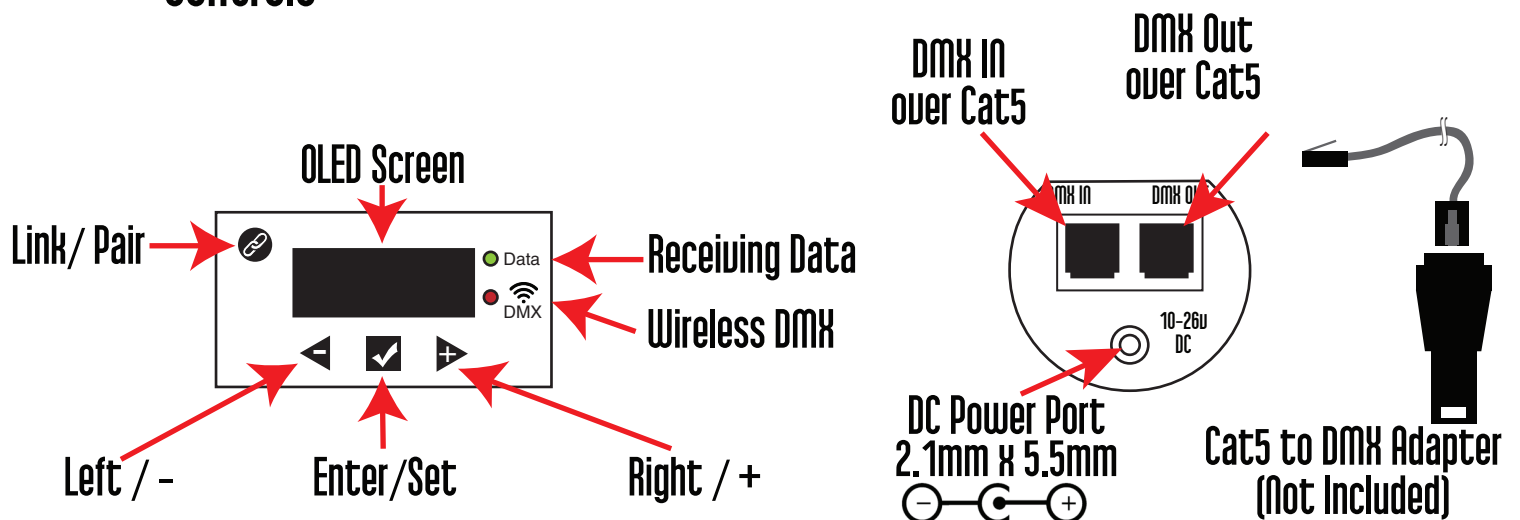

Rainbow Layout Getting Started

Q-Rainbow RGBX Linear LED

- ✓ To Set the Intensity, Color Temp, +/- Green, Saturation and Hue:
Press the ◀ Left or ▶ Right arrows until desired function is selected.
Press ✓ Enter to Select.
The selection carrots > < will move from the >Function< to the >Value<
Press the ◀ or ▶ buttons to set the value. Press ✓ Enter to Save.

- 🔗 To Link a Rainbow lamp to a transmitter,
Go to Config->Wireless, Set to ON, Config->Status Lights to ON
If the Wireless DMX is flashing, press and hold the 🔗 Link button to Unpair.
On the DMX Transmitter, tap the Link button to Pair.
The Wireless DMX Light will start to Flash and turn solid once paired.

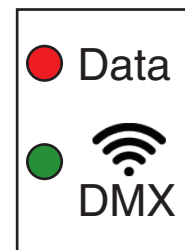

Config Menu

- > DMX Address 001 to 508 (Does not allow address to be outside of 512)
- > Profile 1:HSIC-8 bit, 2:HSIC-16 bit, 3:HSI-8 bit, 4: XFade with CC-8 bit, 5: XFade-8 bit,
-6: CCT & RGB-8 bit, 7: CCT & RGB-16 bit, 8: RGB-8 bit
- > Lead /Follow Lead-Follow1-Follow2-Follow3-Follow4-Follow5
- > Wireless On/Off - Disables the wireless transceiver
- > Status Lights On/Off - Turns off the status lights for use on camera
- > Firmware Displays the Firmware Version on the Lamp
- > Lamp Hours Displays the Hours the lamp has been powered on
- > Reset to Default Sets the lamp back to all its default values

Rainbow Layout Status Lights

- Solid Green Light - Lamp is paired and receiving transmission.
Slow Flashing Green Light - Wireless DMX is paired but transmitter not found.
Fast Flashing Green Light - Wireless DMX is in pairing.
No Green Light - Lamp is Unpaired or Wireless/Status Lights are turned off.
- Solid Red Light - Data Received
No Red Light - No Data Received or Wireless/Status Lights are turned off.

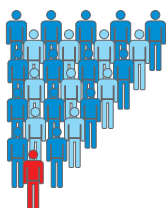


Manual Button Shortcuts

On parameter menus such as intensity, saturation, and hue, when pressing and holding the button to increase the value, tap the button will jump to the next value or max value. The opposite is true when decreasing.

Press and hold the Enter for 5 seconds to disable the status lights.

Press and hold for 3 seconds to Reset the Rainbow to Default settings.



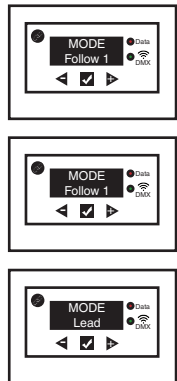
Lead/Follow Mode

Lead/Follow Mode allows one Rainbow lamp to control many lamps at once. The Lead transmits DMX data wired or wirelessly to the followers. When the Lead changes levels, the follows will change as well. Applies to on board FX as well.

To Lead/Follow Mode, go to Config->Lead/Follow. Set the Leader to Lead and set all of the Followers to Follow 1 to match the leader. Follow 2-6 is used with effects to do the same effect with different timings.

To use wired, plug Cat5 cable into the Out of the Lead into the In of the Follow. Repeat out of the follow and into the next. The data light should be illuminated on all the followers

To use wirelessly, on the Follows, press and hold the Link button to Unpair the lamp. Next tap the Link button on the Lead. All of the follows Wireless signal light should begin flashing and then remain solid.



Effects

Effect	Result
Rainbow	Scroll through the Hue from 0° at full Saturation
Short Circuit	Lamp is on with random bursts of turning off
Paparazzi	Lamp is off with random flashes of turning on
Fire 1	A flicker effect with a low weighted center
Fire 2	A flicker effect with a middle weighted center
Fire 3	A flicker effect with a high weighted center
Cop Light 1	Solid Red and Blue alternating colors
Cop Light 2	3 Flashes Red, 3 Flashes Blue alternating colors
Demo	Scroll through the Hue from 0° at 0%, 25%, 50%, 75% and 100% Saturation at 2000k and 6000k

Effect	Choose Effect
Rate	0-200% for the speed of the effect 100% is normal speed
Maximum	Highest intensity level of effect
Minimum	Lowest intensity level of effect
