Other types of accreditation

Two Part Pass

① First Part Card / Identity Card

2 Access Card / Upgrade Card

Both must be worn together to access a venue.



Upgrade Card

Non-nominative

Transferable to accredited individuals multiple times.

Will not be replaced if lost or stolen.



Day Pass

Temporary accreditation card to access venues and/or zones. Valid only on the day of issue.

Only available to workforce.



Access Control System with Facial Recognition

An IC chip has been integrated to the Olympic Identity and Accreditation Card.

Upon entering a venue, the Face Recognition System will read the information stored in the IC chip, to confirm your identity. The system will also check if you have the access privileges for that venue.

- If you are wearing something that hides your face when performing face recognition, it may cause a recognition error.
- Please remove it before your turn comes.
- * Regular transparent glasses are OK

- When passing the face recognition device, consciously look into the camera.
- To have your IC chip read by the device, be sure to tap the card firmly on the card reader.





• If you have additional cards, such as an Upgrade card, touch the card reader with the card with your photo first, then the upgrade card, one after the other.

FAQ

1. Can I decorate my Accreditation Card?

Do not place pins or stickers onto, or make holes in your Accreditation Card.

Such alterations could render the card unusable.

2. What should I do if my Accreditation Card is lost, stolen or damaged?

Every lost, stolen or damaged Accreditation Card must be reported immediately to the nearest accreditation facility, where it will be cancelled in the accreditation system.

When reporting the loss or damage of your card, please take and show your identity card or passport. A new card will be issued on presentation of a request for a replacement Accreditation Card.

3. What does the colouring (White/Black/Grey/Light Green) of the access codes indicate?

White letters on a black background enable access to competition venues.

Black letters on a white background enable access to non-competition venues.

The designation of a specific sport code enables access to all venues for that sport.

Grey background does not enable access to prime events.

Examples:

- **OLS** Olympic Stadium (competition venue)
- ATH All competition and training venue for Athletics (sport-specific code)
- ATH All training venue for Athletics including competition venue in training mode (sport-specific code)
- IBC International Broadcast Centre (noncompetition venue)
- ALL Access to all competition venues
 - ALL Access to all competition venues except prime events

4. What is a Prime Event?

Prime Events are events or sessions where there is insufficient accredited seating to meet the demand.

In order to ensure seating availability and prevent overcrowding in the Olympic Family areas, some members of the Olympic Family are not granted Prime Event Access (PEA). The access code ALL on a grey background printed on Accreditation Cards indicates that the Accreditation Card is not valid for Prime Events.
