#### 1.2 Set up your device



#### Remove the back cover

Remove the battery cover by gently lifting up in the direction shown. There is a notch located on the bottom left hand corner of the phone's back cover to help lift it up.

#### Replace the back cover

Replace the back cover properly by aligning it with the back of the device. Make sure the speaker holes are positioned at the top and press gently until the back cover clicks into place on all sides.



#### **Remove the battery**

Gently lift the battery up from the notch located at the center top of the battery and remove it from the slot.

#### Install the battery

Line up the gold contacts on the battery with the gold connectors at the bottom of the battery slot, and gently push the battery down into the slot.



#### Insert a SIM or microSD<sup>™</sup> card

With the battery removed, hold the new SIM with metal contacts facing downward and the cut corner at the lower left. Slide the card into the SIM slot on the left. For a microSD card, slide the card with gold contacts facing downward into the microSD card slot on the right. Your phone's memory is expandable by up to 32GB with a compatible microSD card (sold separately).

#### Remove nano SIM or microSD<sup>™</sup> card

Push down on the plastic clip located at the edge of the SIM or microSD card slot to allow the card to slide out of the slot. Slide the SIM or microSD card out of the slot.

Your phone only supports Nano-SIM cards. Do not attempt to insert a Mini or Micro SIM card or you may damage your phone.



#### Charge the battery

Insert the smaller end of the charger into the device charging port and plug the charger into an electrical outlet.



To reduce power consumption and energy waste, disconnect your charger when the battery is fully charged.

#### 1.3 Power options

#### Power On

Press down on the **Power button** for an extended time until the phone powers on. The Home screen will be displayed. If screen lock is set up, enter your passcode to access the Home screen.

**Note:** If you don't know your passcode or if you have forgotten it, contact your service provider. Do not store passcodes within your phone; instead store passcodes in a location that is accessible without using your phone.

#### **Power Off Options**

Press and hold the **Power button** until the power options display. You can select **Power Off, Restart** or **Clean Up Memory**, and press **OK or** to confirm.

# 1.4 Set up your phone for the first time

**1.** Press the **Power button** on your device for three seconds to power it on, and then follow the prompts to set up your device. Use the **Navigation ring** to select your preferred language and press **OK** or.

However, the repaired or replaced parts are guaranteed in the same manner and for the same defect for a period of ninety days after delivery of the repaired product, even if their initial warranty period has expired. Proof of purchase required.

#### Implementation of the Warranty:

If your product is faulty under normal conditions of use and maintenance, in order to benefit from the present warranty, please contact AT&T Prepaid Customer Service at 1-800-901-9878. The customer support center will then provide you with instructions on how to return the product for support under warranty.

#### Warranty exclusions:

Manufacturer guarantees its products against material, design and manufacturing defects. The Warranty does not apply in the following cases:

- 1. Normal wear and tear of the product (including on camera lenses, batteries and screens) requiring periodic repair and replacement.
- 2.
