What is Adobe Long-Term Support?

Details of Adobe Long Term Supported Versions (LTS) can be reviewed on their [website](#).

When a security patch to a LTS version is released, Certiport tests it as quickly as possible. During this validation period, if the unpatched LTS version was supported, the patches version should continue to run, unless the security patch was a breaking change. After validation, Certiport updates this guide and the Technical Requirements page to indicate whether the new LTS version is supported.

The following table shows which applications can be used to run the exam in the long-term supported versions of the 2021 to 2023 applications. It also shows which minor application versions can be used to run the 2021 exam.

Important: Adobe only supports the 2021, 2022, and 2023 applications on Mac OSX 11.0 (Big Sur) or higher.

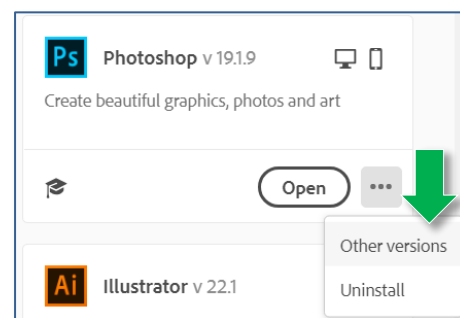
Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I install the required versions of the applications from Creative Cloud Desktop?

A: Open the Creative Cloud desktop application. On the application tile, click the "... " and choose "Other Versions". Click Install next to the desired version of the application.

Q: I cannot install the 2022 version of the application from Creative Cloud Desktop.

A: When Adobe released the 2024 versions of the applications, they discontinued support for the 2022 versions of the applications in Creative Cloud Desktop. If you do not have access to Admin Console to create a package, you need to install and administer the 2023 exams.



Q: What is the difference between a Named User License and a Feature Restricted User License?

A: *Adobe software is licensed using one of two models:*

- **Named user license** – *This licensing model requires users to sign in before they can use Adobe software. The user can only be simultaneously signed in on two computers. Users can install, update, and launch applications from Creative Cloud Desktop.*
- **Feature-restricted license** – *This licensing model does not require users to sign in. Applications can be deployed only by creating Adobe Admin Console packages. Creative Cloud Desktop is not installed.*
