Power PC (Mac OS)


Power PC versions of Mac OS X are not supported.

Creating IPTC Presets

After downloading the IPTC Preset Manager using the ViewNX 2 installer CD supplied with your camera and installing it on your computer, follow the steps below to create IPTC presets.

- 1 Start the IPTC Preset Manager by double-clicking the icon on the desktop (*Windows*) or in the downloads folder (*Mac OS*).
- 2 Enter IPTC information.




"Profile" and "Profile Comment"

The **Profile** field contains the preset name displayed by the camera and is not embedded in photographs. The **Profile Comment** is displayed only by the IPTC Preset Manager and gives information about the preset.

Invalid Entries

Invalid entries are indicated by red outlines and icons; the number of errors is displayed in the status bar at the top of the window. Mouse over the icons for descriptions of the errors.




Error count

- 3 Click **Write file**.
- 4 The dialog at right will be displayed. Choose an identifier between 01 and 99 and click **OK**.

The "IPTC" Folder

IPTC presets are stored in the "IPTC" folder in "My Documents" (Windows XP) or "Documents" (other supported operating systems). The folder can hold up to 99 presets.




Copying IPTC Presets to the Camera


Follow the steps below to copy IPTC presets to the camera.

- 1 Copy the IPTC preset folder ("IPTC") from the documents folder to the "NIKON" folder on the camera memory card.

Mac OS




✓ Important

Be sure to copy the "IPTC" folder to "NIKON" folder. The camera will not recognize the IPTC presets if the folder is copied to another location. If the card does not already contain a "NIKON" folder, create one in the root directory before copying the "IPTC" folder.

- 2 Insert the memory card in the camera.
- 3 Copy the IPTC presets to the camera. For more information, see the camera manual.

The IPTC Preset Manager Window

The controls at the top of the IPTC Preset Manager Window are described below.



Control	Description
① Read file	Open an existing IPTC preset.
② Write file	Save the current IPTC preset.
③ Clear all	Empty all fields in the current preset.
④ Update	Check for updates to the IPTC Preset Manager. If an update is detected, a confirmation dialog will be displayed; click OK to download the update. When update is complete, exit and restart IPTC Preset Manager.
⑤ Language	Choose a language for the IPTC Preset Manager interface.

✓ Uninstalling IPTC Preset Manager

IPTC Preset Manager can be uninstalled by right-clicking in the IPTC Preset Manager window and selecting the appropriate option from the menu displayed.
