Cellphone Etiquette

Mind Your Manners!

A cellphone always emits weak radio waves while it is turned on, even when you are not talking with it. Enjoy using your cellphone without forgetting to be considerate of those around you.

Some locations do not allow the use of cellphones

- Using a cellphone while driving is dangerous and prohibited by Traffic Control Law.
- Using a cellphone in an aircraft is prohibited by law. Be sure to turn off your cellphone.



Watch out where you use your cellphone, and keep your voice down

- Do not make calls at cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries, or other similar locations. Turn off the cellphone or use Manner Mode to ensure that the ring tone does not disturb others.
- When in public, move to a location where you will not be blocking traffic.
- On the Shinkansen, in a hotel lobby, or in other similar locations, move to a location where you will not disturb others.
- Take care to avoid talking on the phone in a loud voice.
- Before taking a picture of others, be sure to obtain permission first.



Cellphone radio waves may interfere with electrical medical equipment

- On a train or in other crowded locations, there is always the possibility that someone nearby may be wearing a pacemaker. Turn off your cellphone when you are in a crowded area.
- Follow the rules of hospitals and other medical facilities prohibiting the use or possession of cellphones.



Simple Mode

Your W63K has Normal Mode and Simple Mode. Simple Mode lets you display in the menu only frequently used functions such as phone and mail, in an easy-to-use manner. The phone is in Normal Mode at the time of purchase. This manual describes operation for Normal Mode.

Manner Mode

Use Manner Mode to turn off the ring tone so as not to bother others around you.

When the standby screen is displayed, hold down  for at least one second.

If you cannot answer a call, Answer Memo plays an answering message and records the caller's message.

When the standby screen is displayed, hold down  for at least one second.

Checking Power, Signal Strength, and Battery Level

Normally leave the phone turned on



The phone needs to be turned on to make and receive calls.

Hold down  for at least one second.

You cannot talk on the phone if it is unable to receive a signal



Signal strength is low in some areas, even if they are within the service area.

"" indicates the current signal strength.

Keep an eye on the battery level



The phone may not function properly if battery power is low.

"" indicates the current battery level.

Using Your Cellphone While Driving is Prohibited

Do not use your phone while riding a bicycle or a motorbike, or while driving a car. Doing so may cause an accident. Using a cellphone while driving a car or riding a motorcycle is prohibited by Japanese law. You may also be penalized for using a cellphone while riding a bicycle.

Drive Mode

In Drive Mode, the phone will play the message "ただ今、車を運転しています。..."(I am driving right now. . .), and ask the caller to leave a message using Answer Memo.

When the standby screen is displayed,

- select "Manner Mode",
- [Select]→select "Drive Mode",
- [OK]



Beware of Spam and One-ring Calls!

If you receive spam . . .

→Page 52

You can set up mail filters to block specific mail or spoof E-mail.

Your cellphone mainly has the following functions to block spam.

- Blocks mail identified as "未承諾広告※"(Unsolicited advertisement)
- Blocks specific mail
- Blocks spoof E-mail



If you receive a call from an unknown number . . .

A "one-ring call" (wan-giri in Japanese) rings your phone only once, in an attempt to make you call back to a service that automatically bills you very high charges. Beware of one-ring calls.

An "❗" icon at the head of an incoming record indicates that the call rang for only less than three seconds.

Disaster Message Board

The Disaster Message Board lets you use EZweb to register information about your safety in case of a major disaster. The information you register can be accessed from anywhere in Japan over EZweb or the Internet.

Registering safety information

- ◆ When a major disaster strikes, you can use your au cellphone to access the "災害用伝言板"(Disaster Message Board) on EZweb and register your current condition, comments, and other information about your safety.
- ◆ After you register information, it can be sent by mail to family, friends, and other individuals you have registered as a recipient of your Disaster Message Board information.

Checking safety information

- ◆ Disaster Message Board information can be accessed by inputting the phone number of an individual over EZweb or the Internet.
- ※ Disaster Message Board information can be accessed from other brand cellphone, PHS, or PC at <http://dengon.ezweb.ne.jp/>.

Charging the Battery

The battery pack that comes with the phone is not fully charged when purchased. Be sure to charge the battery pack before using the W63K for the first time and whenever the battery level has become depleted.



- 1 Check the shape of the connector for the common AC adaptor 01/02 (option), and insert it straight into terminal of the desktop holder until it clicks.
- 2 Rotate and fold out the power plug for the common AC adaptor 01/02 (option), and plug it into a household 100V AC power outlet.
※The common AC adaptor 02 (option) is usable for up to 240V AC.
- 3 Insert the W63K into the desktop holder until it clicks. Charging begins.

The charging start signal sounds, and the incoming indicator lights red→charging
The charging end signal sounds, and the incoming indicator goes out→charging finished

When charging is completed, remove the W63K from the desktop holder, and remove the power plug from the power outlet.

Note

- You must purchase a common AC adaptor 01/02 (option) for charging. Note that the configuration of the AC adaptor may be different from that shown in the illustration.

Turning Power On/Off

At time of purchase, the appearance of the standby screen, main menu, and other displays will differ depending on the color of your W63K handset. In this manual, screens for a burgundy handset are used.

Initializing E-mail and EZweb


An EZweb subscription is required to use E-mail and EZweb. If you did not subscribe when you purchased your phone, contact your nearest au shop or the au Customer Center. Before using your phone, be sure to make the initial settings. Your E-mail address will be automatically determined by making initial settings.

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press .



- 2 Press  [OK].

Initialization starts. Wait for initialization to end.



- 3 Press  [OK].

To set EZ News Flash, follow the instructions on the screen.

Press  to return to the standby screen.



Checking Your Current Phone Number and E-mail Address

Answering a Call

- The Message menu "MissedCall: △" appears on the standby screen if you did not answer one or more calls. If a Message menu appears, you can call the person back with the following steps.


- When the phone is ringing, the phone number of the caller is displayed. Their name is displayed if their name is registered in the address book.
- One of the following messages appears when the phone number of the caller is not provided for some reason.



ID Unsent	The caller's phone is not sending its phone number.
Not Support	The call is from an area or phone that does not support caller ID.
Payphone	The call is from a pay phone.


Redialing (Outgoing Records/Incoming Records)

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press  (Outgoing records) or  (Incoming records).



Records are displayed in order from the last made (received) call.

- 2 Select a record with  and press .




- The W63K can store up to 10 Answer Memos, each of which can be up to 60 seconds long.
- Even when Answer Memo is off, you can record a caller's message with the following steps.
During a call, press .
- au's Answering Service (Voice Mail) allows callers to leave voice messages if they could not reach you to leave an Answer Memo because your phone was turned off or were in a location with poor signal reception.

Playing an Answer Memo

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press  [Clear Memo].




- 2 Select "Answer Memo" and press  [Select].



When there are unplayed memos, a  icon is displayed.

- 3 Select "Play Memo" and press  [Select].



The Play Memo list is displayed.

- 4 Select the memo to play and press  [Play].



The Answer Memo plays back.
During playback, you can pause play by pressing  [Stop].
During playback, you can play the next recorded Answer Memo by pressing  [Next].

Note

- When Answer Memos are stored, the Message menu "AnswerMemo: △" is displayed on the standby screen. If a Message menu appears, you can play the memo with the following steps.
Select "AnswerMemo:" with ,  [Check] → to step 3
- You can press  [Delete] in step 4 and erase an Answer Memo.

- The layout and contents of the EZ Navi screens in this manual are only examples. They may differ from the display in the actual screen.
- Packet transmission fees will incur for each EZ Navi service you use. Moreover, some of the services may incur separate charges.


EZ News Flash

EZweb Subscription Required

EZ News Flash is a free service that transmits the latest news, weather and horoscope information to your standby screen. A telop of the latest news runs across the standby screen permanently, and you can select it to see the details. You can use EZ News Flash as soon as you perform a few simple steps after configuring the initial settings of EZweb (→Page 22). The transmitted information are all free.

※A packet transmission fee may be incurred when you manually update News Flash or access the EZweb website. A confirmation screen appears when you are about to incur a packet fee.



- The information is updated at regular intervals. "光" flashes when the terminal is receiving new information.
- When you use/set au one My Page, and you select "My Page" from the top screen of EZ News Flash, you can check the updated information of My Page.

Setting EZ News Flash



EZ News Flash can be used after performing a simple setting procedure (free of charge).

Set EZ News Flash after performing "Initializing E-mail and EZweb" (→Page 22).

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press . Select the telop and press  [OK].



- 2 Select "はい"(Yes), press  [選択] (Select), and press  [Select].



The setting is complete.

After you complete the settings and return to the standby screen, you will see a telop with the message "Next bulletin coming soon. Please wait." run across the standby screen.

Note

- Perform the following steps to cancel the News Flash service.
When the standby screen is displayed,  →select the telop,  [OK] →  [メニュー] (Menu) →select "サービス設定解除" (Undo Service Settings),  [選択] (Select) →select "YES",  [選択] (Select) →select "解除する" (Undo),  [Select] →select "OK",  [Select]
- To change the News Flash update notification tone/vibrator settings or the incoming call lamp settings, perform the following steps.
When the standby screen is displayed,  →2がABC →1あ.@ →5*JKL
"NewsFlash Rcv" →Set volume and time etc.
If you do not need notification of updates, set "Volume" and "Vibrator" to "OFF".

Other Functions

Safety Buzzer

Set Safety Buzzer to ON in advance to emit the extreme volume sound in the moment of danger.

"OFF" is set at the time of purchase. Perform the following steps.

Setting Safety Buzzer to "ON"

1 When the standby screen is displayed,

press   かABC  はMNO.

Select "ON" and press  [OK].



■ To emit the Safety Buzzer sound

When the standby screen is displayed, press  (hold down at least one second)

The Safety Buzzer sound is emitted in extreme volume.

■ To stop the Safety Buzzer sound

Enter Lock No. and press  [OK]

Note

- When the Safety Buzzer sound continues, you cannot turn W63K handset off or perform other operations. But you can dial 110 (Police), 118 (Japan Coast Guard) and 119 (Fire brigade).
- The Safety Buzzer sound continues until Lock No. is entered or battery is fully discharged.
- The volume of the Safety Buzzer sound cannot be adjusted.
- The Safety Buzzer sound is emitted from the speaker even with the stereo earphone connected or Manner Mode activated.
- Safety Buzzer does not necessarily guarantee crime prevention or your safety.
- Don't sound the Safety Buzzer in anyone's ear. Doing so may cause hearing impairment.
- Handle Safety Buzzer with care and do not allow children to mishandle it.
- Safety Buzzer is disabled when a screen other than the standby screen is displayed, standby EZ apps is activated or the phone is turned off.

W63K also comes with these features.

GLOBAL PASSPORT (GSM)	The W63K supports the Global Passport function using the au IC-Card. Global Passport is an international roaming service that allows you to connect to the world by simply inserting your au IC-Card into a GSM mobile phone for overseas use. No special application or daily/monthly charges are needed. Charges for overseas are billed together with monthly domestic call charges.
EZ apps (BREW®)	You can download and enjoy game software that is registered in the EZ apps server.
au one My Page	You can save data, such as the data in the data folder to your own server (au one My Page) and manage and check it there.
Decoration Mail	You can freely change the background color, font colors and layouts of your mail or decorate it with pictures and photos.
Barcode Reader & Maker	You can read barcodes (JAN code/QR code) as well as create QR codes using W63K.
Pair Barometer	You can easily make calls or send mails to a pair partner registered in advance (Pair Function). You can also view the frequency of calls and mails to the pair partner in 5 levels on the barometer.
Remote Manner Cancel	If Manner Mode is activated but you need to find your W63K handset, you can call it and cancel Manner Mode so you can hear the ring tone and find it.
PetaMemo	You can transfer the contents of your address book or task lists to your standby screen so you can retrieve them easily any time.
Emotion Mail	Determines whether the mail you received is "Happy", "Sad" or "Important" based on the words in the mail and informs you by displaying character icons.
Infrared communication	You can exchange the data save in your Address Book, Schedule, Bookmarks, or Data Folder with devices supporting infrared communication.
Power Saving Mode	You can switch to Power Saving Mode if the battery level is low and the phone settings automatically switch to a lower power consumption rate.
Fake Incoming Call	You can give the appearance of receiving a phone call, for times such as when walking alone at night.
Graphic Memo	You can manage images by inserting dates, categories and comments.




By setting the "Remote Ctrl Lock", you can set Auto Lock and Address Book Lock to prevent others from using your cellphone.

- ※As of Spring 2008, MyKDDI has been re-branded "auお客さまサポート" (au Customer Support). The new service has the same function as MyKDDI.

- You cannot activate Remote Ctrl Lock if W63K is not turned on, you are outside the coverage area or the Emission OFF is set.
- If you call a number in order to set Remote Ctrl Lock and the call is answered, that call is counted as one of the setting calls.
