
A CAUTION

- Do not keep this instruction manual or the key inside the cash box. To prevent them from losing, keep them in a separate place.
- The dial unlock code is printed on this instruction manual. Do not keep it inside the cash box.






[WAY TO READ THE COIN COUNTER]

< WAY TO READ >

There is no indication of the number of coins for ¥1, ¥10, and ¥100.

Please read the number shown on top of the stack of coins.

The coin counter is based on the average thickness of coins in circulation. If you store coins that are deformed or extremely worn, errors may occur.

3. HOW TO OPEN THE COVER (WAY TO UNLOCK THE CYLINDER LOCK AND DIAL LOCK)




When opening the cover, both cylinder lock and dial lock have to be unlocked. The cover cannot be opened if only either one of the locks is unlocked.


1) Put the key in the keyhole and turn it clockwise (OPEN) to unlock.



② Slide down the D Lock (Dial lock lever) to enable the dial to turn.



③ Turn the dial clockwise at least 2 full circles.




There is no need to set the dial to any specific number.

This procedure is for clearing all unlocking status of the

If there is an error in the unlocking operation such as turning the dial too much in step ④⑤, perform this step, and then start again.

(4) Turn the dial clockwise again and set to the position of the below number






⚠ The unlock code of the dial cannot be changed.


(5) From the position (4), turn the dial anti-clockwise and set to the position of the below number. * Please do not turn more than 1 circle





⚠ The unlock code of the dial cannot be changed.

⑥ Hold down the open lever.



4. HOW TO CLOSE THE COVER (WAY TO LOCK THE CYLINDER LOCK AND DIAL LOCK)

To close the cover, both cylinder lock and dial lock have to be unlocked first. The cover cannot be closed if only either one of the locks is unlocked.

- ① Check below before closing the cover.
- Do not put this instruction manual or the key inside the cash box.
- Make sure that the things inside are in place and would not hinder. the cover from closing.
- Make sure that the tray is in place and not slanting.
- 2 Ensure the cylinder lock is unlocked.
- ③ Ensure the dial lock is unlocked.
- 4 Close the cover gently till clicked.
- (5) Put the key in the keyhole and turn it anti-clockwise (LOCK) to lock.




© Turn the dial clockwise at least 2 full circles.


Do not keep your key and unlock code tag inside

When the cover is opened, the cover cannot be closed if either the cylinder lock or the dial lock

is locked. Closing the cover under this condition will lead to product damage or malfunction.



5. COVER FLIP-UP ADJUSTMENT KNOB (FOR CB-8670, CB-8770 ONLY)



The strength of the cover flipping open can be adjusted by turning the "cover flip-up adjustment knob".

Adjust the strength depending on the number of documents.

⚠ CAUTION

Do not keep too many documents in the document holder.

6. COIN ANTI SCATTERING COVER (FOR CB-8570, CB-8670, CB-8770 ONLY)



The "coin anti scattering cover" prevents the scattering of the coins inside the coin tray when carrying the cash box.

The "coin anti scattering cover" is linked with the outer cover and will automatically open and close.


A CAUTION

Do not keep things on top of the coin anti scattering cover. This may be the reason for making the cover unable to close.

7. HOW TO CHANGE THE WAY TO MANAGE THE LOCK

[USING ONLY THE CYLINDER LOCK]

- ① Turn the dial clockwise at least 2 full circles.
- 2 Turn the dial clockwise and set to the position of the first unlock code
- ③ From the position ②, turn the dial anti-clockwise and set to the position of the second unlock




4) Put the key in the keyhole and turn it clockwise (OPEN) to unlock.



- ⑤ Hold down the open lever and check if the cover
- X If the cover is not opened, it may due to the wrong unlock code used. Do the unlocking operation again.



⑥ Slide up the D Lock (Dial lock lever) to disable the dial to turn.




[USING ONLY THE DIAL LOCK]

- 1) Put the key in the keyhole and turn it clockwise (OPEN) to unlock.
- ② Take away the key



USING BOTH THE CYLINDER LOCK AND THE DIAL LOCK

① Slide down the D Lock (Dial lock lever) to enable the dial to turn.



⚠ CAUTION

Do not keep the key and unlock code tag inside the cash box to prevent them from getting locked.
