




# Front and rear panel illustration

## Front panel




- ① STAND BY

- Please replace batteries when find remote control is out of work or weak sensitivity.




# DVD+ TV

## Notes :


There are five ways of connecting the player , s AV output to the TV set:

- Scart cable (set the video type to RGB)



## Basic operation

1. Connect the DVD player to your TV and amplifier.
2. Turn on the TV.
3. Set the TV to the AV input connected to the DVD player.
4. Turn down the volume on your amplifier, and then power it on.
5. Set the amplifier to the AV input connected to the DVD player.



Step 1: Press the **STAND BY**, and the player will start, "LOAD" is illuminated on the display and the logo is displayed on TV screen.

Step 2: Press **OPEN/CLOSE** either on the front panel or remote control. The player displays "OPEN" on the display. When the tray is open, please put the disc on the tray with the label side up. Press **OPEN/CLOSE** again to close the disc tray.


Step 3: Press the **PLAY** button on the front panel or remote control. The player will automatically read and identify the disc, display the type and total time and begin playback.

# Features setup

## SETUP



In stop mode, press **SETUP**, and the TV screen will display the setup menu as follows:




- A. Press  $\uparrow\downarrow$  to Change items
- B. Press **ENTER** to display the submenu
- C. Press **SETUP** to exit the setup menu





4. Select <DVD menu>, and press **ENTER** to display the <DVD menu> submenu:



- A. Press  $\uparrow\downarrow$  to change your selection
- B. Press **ENTER** to confirm
- C. Press  $\uparrow$  to return to the setup menu
- D. Press **SETUP** to exit the setup menu

Select <Video> in the setup menu, and press

**ENTER** to display the <Video> submenu:

A. Press   to change your selection

2. Select <TV System>, and press **ENTER** to display the <TV System> submenu

# Features setup

## Rating setup

Select <Rating> in the setup menu, and press **ENTER** to display the <Rating> submenu:

A. Press **↑** to return to the setup menu

**Note:** Not all DVDs support ratings.




Use the 0-9 keys to input four digits (set password), then press **ENTER** to confirm. The <Rating> submenu displays as follows:



**Note:** If you forget your password, please use the universal password “8888” to unlock.

Select <Rating>, and press **ENTER** to change <Rating> mode.



- A. Press **ENTER** repeatedly to select:
1. Kid safe, 2. G, 3. PG, 4. PG-13, 5. PG-R, 6. R, 7. NC-17, 8. Adult
- B. Press **↑** to return to the setup menu

**Note:** Unlock the password before setting <Rating>

## Misc setup

Select <Load Factory>, and press **ENTER** to change <Load Factory> mode.



- A. Press **↑↓** to change your selection  
B. Press **ENTER** to confirm  
C. Press **↑** to return to the setup menu  
D. Press **SETUP** to exit the setup menu

# Remote control operation

## OPEN/CLOSE



- To open the disc tray, press **OPEN/CLOSE**  
To close the disc tray, press **OPEN/CLOSE** again.

## TITLE



- During DVD playback, press **TITLE** to display the DVD title menu or play the first title.

**Note:** this function is subject to the disc.

## MENU



- During DVD playback, press **MENU** to display the disc menu of the current title.

**Note:** This function is subject to the disc

## VIDEO



- Under the open mode, Press the button to switch the video of RGB

## PBC



- During VCD playback, Press PBC to select the mode of “PBC On” or “PBC Off”

PBC is: playback control used to navigate VCD

## 0-10 keys



- These keys are used to input the time, as well as title, chapter and track numbers.
- When a CD or VCD is playing (with PBC off), press the 0-9 keys to select a track directly, then press **ENTER** to confirm.
- When a numeric item is displayed on the screen, press the 0-9 keys to Select the desired entry, and press **ENTER** to confirm.

## SLOW



- During DVD, VCD playback, press **SLOW** for slow motion playback.
- Once you press **SLOW**, the disc will play at 1/2, 1/4, 1/6 and 1/8 normal Speed as follows: 
- Press **PLAY** to resume normal playback.

## PREV



- During DVD, CD or VCD playback, press **PREV** to play the previous chapter, title or track.

## NEXT



- During DVD, CD or VCD playback, press **NEXT** to play the next chapter, title or track.

# Remote control operation

## REPEAT



- Each press of the **REPEAT** button will change the repeat mode.
- During VCD,CD playback,there are three modes: repeat Single, repeat All and Off.
- During DVD,playback,there are three modes: Repeat Chapter, Repeat Title and Off.

Note:During VCD playback,the PCB mode must be set to Off

## A-B



- During playback, press **A-B** to select point A
- Press it again to select point B. The player will repeat the section from A to B automatically .
- Press **A-B** a third time to cancel A-B repeat and clear points A and B.

Note: During CD/VCD playback, points A and B must be within the same track.

During DVD playback, points A and B can be selected from different chapters.

## REV



- During DVD, CD or VCD playback, press **REV** to scan in reverse. The player will review the disc at 2, 4, 8 and 16 times speed as follows:




- Press **PLAY** to resume normal playback.

## FWD



- During DVD, CD or VCD playback, press **FWD** to scan forward. The player will cue the disc at 2, 4, 8 and 16 times speed as follows:



- Press **PLAY** to resume normal playback.

## Bookmark



- During DVD,VCD, playback press the Button the menu will display as follow
- Use  $\uparrow \downarrow$  to select the different bookmark
- Press ENTER to input the current time. If it has been input yet, the player will play from this time.

# Remote control operation

## MUTE



- Press **MUTE** to turn off the audio.  
Press **MUTE** again to resume normal sound.

## L/R



- During VCD/SVCD playback, press **L/R** repeatedly to select the channel of audio-output: Stereo/Left/Right.

## CLEAR



- Press **CLEAR** to delete numbers you have entered.
- Press once to delete one digit, press and hold to delete all digits.

## PAUSE/STEP



- Press **PAUSE/STEP** during playback to pause playback.  
Press again to step forward one frame  
Press **PLAY** to resume normal playback.

**NOTE:** the step function is not available during CD playback

## PLAY



- Press **PLAY** from stop mode to start playback.

## STOP



- Press **STOP** once during playback to stop and hold playback.
- Press **PLAY** to resume playback from the point you have pressed **STOP**.
- Press **STOP** twice to stop playback completely.

## RETURN




- Under PCB being turned on, press **STOP** then **RETURN** to return to the program menu during playing VCD/SVCD disc.
- Under menu displaying, press **RETURN** to clear the present display.

## ZOOM



- During VCD/SVCD/DVD playback, press **ZOOM** to magnify the image as follows:



# Remote control operation

## VOL



- Press **VOL** to adjust the volume.  
Press **VOL +** to enlarge the volume.  
Press **VOL -** to reduce the volume.

## ANGLE



- During DVD playback,  
Press **ANGLE** to view scenes from different camera angles.  
Press **ANGLE** repeatedly to change from one camera angle to another.  
**Note:** This function is disc specific.

## SUBTITLE



- During DVD playback,  
Press **SUBT** repeatedly to select from up to 32 subtitle languages.  
**Note:** This function is disc specific (language will vary).

## LANGUAGE




- Press **LANGUAGE** repeatedly to select from up to 8 audio languages/formats during DVD playback.  
Press **LANGUAGE** repeatedly to select from up to 4 audio languages/formats during SVCD playback.  
**Note:** This function is disc specific

## PROG




During VCD playback, press stop then **PROG** and the program menu will display as follow:



Input the track numbers in the desired order.  
When finished, select <play program> and then press ENTER to play the tracks in the new programmed order.

Select <clear all> and press ENTER to clear all the numbers you have input.

During DVD playback, press stop then **PROG** and the <program> menu will display as follow:



Input the title numbers and the chapter numbers in the desired order, then select <play program> and Press ENTER to play the chapters in the order you have set. Select <clear all> and press ENTER to clear all the numbers you have input.

# Kodak Picture CD Playback


A Kodak picture CD has the size and shape of a regular CD.

- The max. size of JPEG picture can be supported: 3840x3840ples.
- JPEG stands for Joint Picture Experts Group. It is a compressing standard. It is the first international standard on Still Picture Compressing:ISO10918-1 constituted by the Committee on Still Picture Compressing Standard of ISO. The pictures on Kodak Picture CD are stored in this format (JPEG). This player can decode the JPEG picture in Kodak Picture CD and playback the picture in different modes.

## Operation instructions:

- You can use number keys to select a special picture.
- Press PREV or NEXT key to select.
- Press PAUSE key to stop playing.

Press **STOP** key to stop playing, and the screen will display as follow:



# Kodak Picture CD Playback


In this window, you can use arrows key to select a special picture, then use **PLAY** or **ENTER** to confirm and display this picture.

## Image rotation

There are three modes to rotate a picture: 90° cw, 180° cw, 90° ccw. Those operations are allowed only when a picture is being displayed normally and will be cancelled automatically when a new picture is displayed. Press **ANGLE** repeatedly, you can select the different rotation modes: original, 90deg cw, 180deg cw, 90deg ccw.

## Zoom function

The player provides both Zoom in/out and pan function. The picture will zoom in/out as follow:



**Note:** During the ZOOM function, slideshow transitions and image rotation are disabled.

Q off: close zoom, press **PLAY** key to resume slideshow transitions.

**Note:** the quality of the pictures displayed on your screen will depend on the quality of your display equipment.

# Troubleshooting

Please read the user's manual carefully before using the DVD player. If you have any Troubles in using this player, try to solve the problems by the suggestions mentioned below. If you can not remove the trouble after using all the suggestions, please contact the company or the technical service center authorized by us. For the sake of your safety please Do not open the cover and repair the player by yourself, if that, it may cause electric shock.

## **NO PICTURE, SOUND AND INDICATION**

- Ensure that the power switch is on.
- Ensure that the wall inlet is ok.
- Ensure that the power cord is not damaged.
- Ensure that the power plug is connected to the inlet tightly.

## **BLACK AND WHITE PICTURE OR SCREEN ROLLING**

- Ensure that you have set the right TV SYSTEM (e.g. PAL, NTSC) setting.

## **FLAWS OF PICTURE OR SOUND**

- Check whether the setting of AUDIO is right.
- Check whether the disc is scratched or stained.
- Check whether the AV connector and the output terminal is stained.

## **DISPLAY NO DISC**

- Ensure that you have put the disc on the tray.
- Check whether the disc is put in the reverse side.
- Check whether the disc is distorted.
- Check whether the disc is stained or scratched badly.  
Turn down the echo level.

# Troubleshooting

## **REMOTE CONTROL IS INSENSITIVE OR DOES NOT WORK**

- Check the batteries of remote control and make sure that they are to be powerful and good conductivity.
- Direct the remote control to the IR sensor of the player.
- Check whether there are some obstacles between the remote control and IR sensor.

## **ABNORMAL FUNCTION OPERATION**

- Turn off the power, and then turn on again.

## **DISC IS LOCKED IN THE TRAY**

- The disc can not be taken out of the tray when the player is reading, so you have to turn off the power and turn on again, and press OPEN/CLOSE key immediately to open the tray.
