# Theracare Leg Lifter

The Theracare Leg Lifter from Theraposture has been designed to enable users to safely and easily get their legs into bed. This simple daily task can prove difficult or even impossible for many people who may have lost muscle tone and therefore strength and general mobility.

The Leg Lifter is compatible with most types of bed whether they are non-adjustable or adjustable. It will comfortably lift legs up, over and onto the sleeping surface, requiring very little movement or repositioning. This Theraposture solution is unlike alternative leg lifters that simply lift the legs beside the bed, which is the key difference that distinguishes the Theracare Leg Lifter from many alternative devices available. The motor is quiet and strong enough to lift severely oedemic (swollen) legs.

It can be specified and fitted to either side of most beds. The height of the Leg Lifter is fully adjustable with straps and a stability bar secures it to the bed. It can be fitted easily and only weighs 12kg.



The Theracare Leg Lifter is compatible with many types of adjustable bed. It can not be used in conjunction with cot sides.

# Chair bed

A unique adaptation of a riser recliner chair that can be power adjusted to provide a flat sleeping surface.

The Chair Bed from Theraposture is ideal for individuals who are unable to sleep in a bed and have resorted to the unhealthy situation of sleeping in a domestic chair.







The Chair Bed is an ergonomically modified dual motor adjustable chair that can provide support whilst sitting, reclining and when in a recumbent position. It has been specifically designed to provide both a comfortable bed and a supportive chair for individuals who live with restricted mobility.

The leg and back rest can be adjusted independently to achieve an infinite range of positions and the mechanism also assists users achieve a standing





transfer. This riser action can be essential for safe, stable movement in and out of the chair without the risk of muscle strain or injury.

Following a personal assessment by a trusted Theraposture Assessor, each Chair Bed is tailor-made to meet individual needs. Proven features include:

- A reclining action to an almost flat position unlike a dual motor, meaning there is no lumber support protruding into the user's back when lying down
- Arm rests that drop down to contribute to the sleeping surface and as there are no back rest wings, the user can move freely on the sleeping surface, just as they would in a bed
- Option to specify a Chair Bed that is up to 38'' wide wider than a single bed
- A removable topper that is filled with memory foam and covered in a waterproof fabric. This offers pressure-relieving properties and increases comfort levels
- Easy-to-use, 4-button illuminated controller
- Extensive range of fabrics and additional safety systems

# Rotocare<sup>®</sup> rotational bed

The Theraposture Rotocare bed is an electrically operated, height adjustable and profiling bed with an additional manually controlled rotation that allows a carer to mobilise the user and to get them out of their bed.

The Rotocare is essentially a Rotoflex but without powered turning, which makes it a better price. It is suitable where the user may have permanent assistance and it could be considered as a labour saving manual handling device that also provides independence and dignity to the user.





The Theraposture Rotocare is the proven assistive sleeping solution for individuals and their carers who require support when completing a bed transfer. Through its unique manual rotating action, a single carer can assist a user from a lying to a seated position. This results in reduced care costs and the opportunity for people with mobility issues to remain in the comfort of their own home.

The Rotocare will rotate to either side of the bed and is compatible with most room situations. In addition to the rotation function which is operated by a carer, the Rotocare also has electrically powered profiling and variable height function for bespoke positioning. This is beneficial to both user and carer in terms of comfort, safety and flexible access.

The Rotocare and its more advanced version, the Rotoflex, can be hand-crafted as either a single or within a double combination bed and is available in a variety of surrounds.
