IBM<sup>®</sup> Maximo<sup>®</sup> Asset Management Scheduler Plus extends the capabilities of IBM Maximo Asset Management Scheduler. You can manage large projects, book customer appointments, and use weather data to better plan, schedule, and dispatch work.

# Step 1: Access the software and documentation

Access the product software from IBM Passport Advantage or from the product DVD if you requested a product DVD. # Step 2: Plan the installation

Installing Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Plus requires system administrator rights and privileges. Ensure that IBM Maximo Asset Management Version 7.6.0.6 and Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Version 7.6.4 are installed on the same administrative workstation where you plan to install Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Plus Version 7.6.4.

# 3 Step 3: Install the product

To install Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Plus:

- 1. Review the software requirements.
- 2. Prepare to install.
- 3. Install Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Plus.
- 4. For Oracle WebLogic Server environments only: you must deploy the Enterprise Application Archive (EAR) files.
- 5. For the IBM WebSphere<sup>®</sup> Application Server environments: The EAR files are installed when you install the process automation engine. If this task was deferred during the Maximo Asset Management Scheduler Plus installation, deploy the EAR files.
