Product overview

IBM® Security Directory Integrator is an integrated development environment and runtime service for general-purpose, multi-format, multi-directional, real-time data movement, synchronization, and transformation.

There are two editions of IBM Security Directory Integrator Version 7.2:

- IBM Security Directory Integrator Version 7.2: General Purpose Edition
- IBM Security Directory Integrator Version 7.2: Identity Edition

This Quick Start Guide applies to both editions.

1 Step 1: Access the software



This document shows you how to install IBM Security Directory Integrator by using the product DVDs.


2 Step 2: Evaluate the hardware and system configuration

3 Step 3: Review the base architecture

The following diagram illustrates the base architecture of IBM Security Directory Integrator.



4 Step 4: Access the installer from the IBM Security Directory Integrator Launchpad



On the server computer, access the installation executable file for your operating system and follow these steps:

- 1. Insert the product installation DVD. There is only one DVD for all supported operating systems. On Windows operating systems, the Launchpad launches automatically. For all other operating systems, run the IBM Security Directory Integrator Launchpad executable file. For example, launchpad.sh.
- 2. From the Launchpad menu, select Install IBM Security Directory Integrator.
- 3. On the installation panel, click IBM Security Directory Integrator Installer and follow the installation instructions.

5 Step 5: Install IBM Security Directory Integrator



Install IBM Security Directory Integrator by using a Typical or Custom installation:

- A Typical installation installs the Server, Configuration Editor, JavaDocs, the Administration and Monitoring Console (installed into the Integrated Solutions Console Standard Edition (ISC SE)), Action Manager, and examples.
- A Custom installation allows you to choose individual components to install.

Note: Password Synchronization Plug-ins are installed by using a custom installation with the standard installer.
