THE RÉGION CENTRE-VAL DE LOIRE, A HIGH-FLYING ENCOUNTER BETWEEN NATURE AND CULTURE, HERITAGE AND CREATION

In 2023, it has never been easier to reach the region's emblematic territories to discover the wonders they hold. **Indeed, Rémi offers tourist tours from Tours, Bourges, Orléans, Chartres and now from Paris.** With an option for all desires: regular or occasional visitors, for door-to-door trips, alone or in groups...

The Centre-Val de Loire is a reference for cultural tourism and the art of living in France. It is known for the depth of its heritage - with the castles of the Valley of the Kings in the spotlight - but also for the diversity of its natural environment and the richness of its gastronomy.

In the heart of the Loire Valley, there are many reasons to be amazed, from the Château d'Amboise and its splendid panorama, to the Château de Chinon which dominates the old town from its rocky outcrop, or the Château de Chambord and the ZooParc of Beauval.

The Loir-et-Cher is 4 unique destinations, from the Vendôme region in the north to the Cher Valley in the south, passing through the Sologne and the Loire Valley. And how can you miss its unmissable tourist sites, among which are the most beautiful castles of the Loire Valley and the incredible ZooParc of Beauval?

The historic province of Berry reveals emblematic monuments such as the cathedral of Bourges, and sometimes lesser known wonders such as Sancerre, designated "Favorite Village of the French" in 2021.

The Orléanais region shines, beyond the unavoidable visit of the former capital of the kingdom of France, by its abundant nature, marked by the imprint of the forest of Orléans, the numerous canals of Montargis and the Sologne undergrowth.

In the north of the region, the Eure-et-Loir is an opportunity to get away from Paris for an hour, either cultural or "sporty", for a hike on the road to Santiago de Compostela or a great cycling tour.

The Rémi train and buses timetables in this guide are those existing in January 2023. These timetables are successibles to evolve during the year. It is therefore necessary to check the circulation schedules the day before your departure on the Rémi website, JVMalin or at the ticket office.

PRESENTATION

Touraine offers visitors an exceptional historical, architectural and natural heritage. The Loire and its tributaries have shaped its landscapes and made it a rich land. From the monumental Loire Valley to the luminous countryside, between vineyards and charming villages, each territory displays its identity. The visitor will be able to experience Tours and beautiful cities that are Amboise, Chenonceaux, Villandry, Azay-Le-Rideau and Langeais or the medieval cities Chinon and Loches...



TOURS

Beautiful and dynamic, marked by a **lively student life**, the city of Tours is a destination in its own right on the route of the Loire castles. Discover its historic quarters with **half-timbered houses**, or the Plumereau and Châteauneuf squares, which are essential meeting places for many Tourainees, and for visitors!

LOCHES

Loches is one of the **best preserved medieval fortresses in Europe**. In spite of the modifications undergone over the centuries, the city still preserves a large part of its medieval and Renaissance heritage, giving us the opportunity to read and see **1000 years of history and architecture**. In 1968, its remarkably well-preserved historic center became a "**protected area**". Since 2000, Loches has also been part of the national network of Cities and Countries of Art and History.



CHINON

Situated on the Vienne River, in a strategic position on the borders of Touraine, Anjou and Poitou, with a rocky outcrop fortified since antiquity, the city of Chinon has long played a key defensive role. Its imposing fortress **will take you back in time to the Middle Ages**, but you can also stroll through the streets of the old town with its emblematic **half-timbered houses**, or those of the **canons' district**.



VENDÔME

From one bridge to another, from one footbridge to another, the historic city center of Vendôme is **bathed by the arms of the Loir** and dotted with green spaces. Everything here invites you to stroll: **the Ronsard Park**, the terraces of the tea shops where you can taste local or homemade products, the gardens that you keep crossing... Or to discover, by following the golden nails scattered in the ground to go through the history of this city.

ST-AIGNAN-SUR-CHER

On the banks of the Cher River, enjoy a nice walk to contemplate the city, its **medieval city classified as a remarkable heritage site** and its wonderful architecture.

The streets of Saint-Aignan-sur-Cher are filled with beautiful buildings such as the Prévôté, the Hôtel-Dieu attributed to the architect Jules Hardouin-Mansart as well as 14th century gothic houses.

The town is also home to the must **ZooParc of Beaulieu**, so don't forget to visit it!

BLOIS

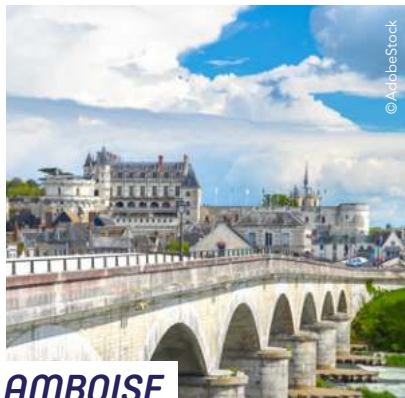
The city of Blois has a historical and architectural heritage that will not leave you indifferent... From the **Château Royal** in the heart of the city, magnified at night by a **sound and light show**, to the many cultural and tourist sites that will arouse the curiosity of young and old alike, such as Robert-Houdin's **Maison de la Magie**, Blois has much to offer. Without forgetting the numerous castles located close to the city, within shuttle distance!

CHAUMONT-SUR-LOIRE

A small tourist town in the Loire Valley, **classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site**, Chaumont-sur-Loire is a summary of the art of living in the Loire Valley. In addition to its castle, which is one of the most beautiful pieces, the city is also home to the famous Domain where the **International Garden Festival** is held every year. There are also gourmet workshops, trips on traditional Loire boats...

AMBOISE

In the heart of the Loire Valley, **classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site** as a "living cultural landscape", the city of Amboise is home to prestigious monuments such as the Château Royal, a former residence of the kings of France overlooking the Loire. It also bears the marks of an **industrial heritage** from the end of the 19th century, of which it retains the know-how today.

Come and discover the French history of Leonardo da Vinci thanks to his bedroom, his restored workshops, the model rooms and the Cultural Park, an open-air museum with giant manipulative machines. Since 2021, the Leonardo da Vinci Galleries allow visitors to admire the artist's 17 masterpieces in relation to his preparatory drawings. Models, 3D animations and video games illustrate the whole world of Leonardo da Vinci, architect, town planner and director of ephemeral shows.

Placed on the first list of historical monuments in France in 1840, and a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1981, the Château de Chambord is one of the most amazing buildings of the Renaissance. Through more than 80 rooms open to visitors, admire the architecture of a castle, take the famous double staircase inspired by the work of Leonardo da Vinci and travel through 500 years of history in the footsteps of François Ist, Louis XIV, Molière, Victor Hugo and many others! In May 2023, one of Chambord's largest restoration projects will be completed. The work made it possible to secure the lanterns and restore their ornaments. Chambord is the largest walled park in Europe, with 5,440 hectares of which more than 1,000 are accessible to all.

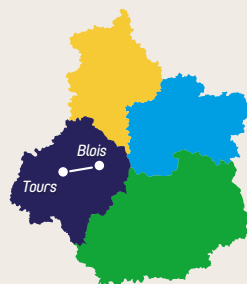

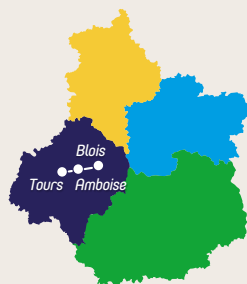

1496, 4 years after the discovery of the Americas by Christopher Columbus, Charles VIII, then young King of France, left with 30,000 knights to conquer Italy and its wonders. He returned, accompanied by "22 men of trade", to found the French Renaissance and its first gardens in Amboise. The royal art of living in the 16th century still reigns in this small Italian palace which welcomes you to the sound of Renaissance music.

The drawbridge of the Château de Langeais is an invitation to discover the life of the lords at the dawn of the Renaissance. It hosted the wedding of Charles VIII and Anne of Brittany on December 6, 1491. This event is recreated in the wedding hall with an immersive audiovisual show, narrated by Stéphane Bern himself. Large rooms and intimate rooms follow one another, adorned with an exceptional collection of furniture and tapestries. The banquet room recreates a sumptuous festive meal, while the "Salle des Preux" presents a unique series of tapestries on the theme of chivalry. A rich program is offered throughout the year, including a falconry show in summer and participation in the event "Noël au pays des Châteaux".

PRESENTATION

Berry is an ancient province composed of the following departments of Indre and Cher, full of emblematic places such as the Cathedral of Bourges, George Sand's Domain, the Château de Valençay or the Abbey of Noirlac! Beyond its emblematic monuments, it's a destination rich in discoveries and beautiful cities such as the beautiful town of Sancerre, elected Favorite Village of the French in 2021, perched on a rocky outcrop that offers a panoramic view of its vineyards and the banks of the Loire.



BOURGES

The third largest city in the région Centre-Val de Loire, Bourges boasts a rich heritage of historical monuments such as **the Palais Jacques Cœur**. It is also one of the greenest cities in France with 135 hectares of marshland in its heart. VIERZON

Did you want to see Vierzon? Easily accessible, located 1h30 from Paris by train, the city benefits from a quality environment, where water plays an important role as **5 rivers cross**. Surrounded by a magnificent **7,500 hectare state forest**, Vierzon has a varied heritage, both historical, natural and industrial. The city is notably known for its know-how in metallurgy and porcelain.



SAINT-AMAND-MONTROND

A small town nestled in the heart of France, Saint-Amand-Montrond is part of the historic provinces of Berry and Bourbonnais. The city cradles its history at the foot of a fortress and in the heart of a city center, which conceals a **remarkably preserved heritage**. It is one of the treasures of the Jacques Cœur route, **the oldest historical route in France**.

CHÂTEAUXROUX

In the historic province of Berry, Châteauroux is a true **"town in the country"**, bordered by the Indre River. PRESENTATION

Impossible to miss the visit of Orléans and its heritage. Some castles of the Loire Valley are easily accessible, such as Meung-sur-Loire or of La Ferté-Saint-Aubin. This historic region is also home to the Orléans forest in the north, the largest state-owned forest in France, the Sologne desundergrowth and ponds to the south. It is crossed by the Loire, the last wild river in Europe and the true vertebrate column of the province. You can ride your bike and cross the bridge of Briare which gracefully spans the Loire.



ORLÉANS

In the heart of the Loire Valley, Orléans is ideally located on the Loire. The "**Cité johannique**" - in reference to Joan of Arc - has many historical and patrimonial assets that make its reputation. On foot or by bike, the city offers a variety of exotic and enriching walks, between parks, gardens, monuments and other remarkable places...



PITHIVIERS

Pithiviers is a small town located in the Loiret region of France. Its name comes from a Gallic word meaning "four", in reference to the four roads: the road from Orléans to Reims crossed the one from Sens to Rennes. Once an important **trading center**, its weekly markets in the central squares continue to draw crowds, while **the St. George's Fair** at the end of April has enlivened the city center for a thousand years.

MONTARGIS

In the heart of the région Centre-Val de Loire, Montargis is an exciting and inspiring city for its economic and cultural life. Ranked among the 100 "**Most Beautiful Detours**" in France, the city is nicknamed the "**Venise du Gâtinais**", with its 131 bridges and footbridges, and has been awarded the 4 Flowers label since 2016 thanks to its numerous landscaping features.





CHÂTEAUNEUF-SUR-LOIRE

Known for its famous castle, Châteauneuf-sur-Loire offers many other cultural outings. At the **Musée de la marine de la Loire**, visitors can discover the epic of navigation on the Loire, through an attractive evocation of the history of the bargemen, their boats and their lives on the river dedicated to transportation and trade.

PRESENTATION

One hour southwest of Paris, the Eure-et-Loir is full of fascinating places of interest. Between the cathedral of Chartres and its medieval quarter, The great castles of the region, The hiking trails on the paths. The choice is wide and varied for those who want to be amazed, to be stimulated or to work out!



CHARTRES

If the city of Chartres is known worldwide for its **remarkable cathedral**, this inescapable edifice should not make us forget the richness of the local cultural offer, between the museums, the Conservatory, the theaters or the **"Chemin des Arts"**. Not forgetting the **Centre international du Vitrail of Chartres**, and its unique collection of original stained glass windows from the Renaissance period.



CHÂTEAUDUN

The city of Châteaudun is distinguished by the beauty of its site, at the top of a rocky promontory overlooking the Loir, and the majesty of its castle. The city, which is home to **58 classified sites and monuments**, can be discovered during a pleasant tour of the historic district. And for geology enthusiasts, the **Grottes de Foulon** offer the possibility to observe thousands of marine geodes and chalcedony quartz.

MAINTENON

A few miles from Rambouillet and Chartres, the town of Maintenon owes its fame to the presence of the famous eponymous castle. The building bears the imprint of great and prestigious names of the 17th century: its most famous hostess of course, **Madame de Maintenon**, but also Racine who came to meditate there, **Le Nôtre** who designed the garden or **Vauban** who designed the aqueduct.



NOGENT-LE-ROTROU

Nogent-le-Rotrou, a small jewel of the Perche natural region, is patiently waiting for you in the heart of the **Regional Natural Park**. The capital of the Counts of Perche is naturally known for the **Château médiéval des Comtes du Perche**, retracing a thousand years of history, from the epic of the Rotrou family to the French Revolution. Below this building is the **emblematic Pâté district**, a concentration of medieval civil architecture.

ILLIERS-COMBRAY

At the crossroads of the Beauce and the Perche, the town of Illiers became Illiers-Combray in 1971, the year of the centenary of Marcel Proust's birth. The name was added in reference to the fictitious village described by the novelist in his great fresco "À la recherche du temps perdu", inspired by his childhood vacations spent at his aunt's house in Illiers. The "**Proustian sites**" remain today a must for all visitors, between the banks of the Loir, the museum dedicated to the author or **the romantic garden of the Pré Catelan**, which was designed by his uncle.

DREUX

Located one hour from Paris, at the gateway to Normandy, the city of Dreux invites you to relax in the heart of the **Eurelian countryside**. You can also explore a unique historical heritage, marked by the remains of fortifications of an imposing **Château médiéval** or the **Chapelle Royale of Dreux**, necropolis of the Orléans family.

ÉPERNON

Between Chartres and Paris, on the edge of the Rambouillet forest, **the medieval city of Épernon** is located on a rocky spur, and is distinguished by a past rich in history of which it has preserved many traces. Today, the town is a favorite place for cycling tourists.

REMI TRAINS ALLOW THE TRANSPORT OF BICYCLES UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS

Verify the nature of your train (Rémi train, Intercités, train Loire à vélo, TGV before to go to avoid unpleasant surprises.



IS YOUR BIKE FOLDABLE?

It must be disassembled and transported in a bag (maximum dimensions 130 cm x 90 cm) to be considered as luggage once folded.



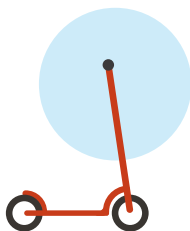
YOUR BIKE IS NOT FOLDABLE?

Bicycles must be placed in the dedicated spaces (indicated by a pictogram), within the strict limits of the available spaces.

Beyond that, SNCF staff reserves the right to refuse additional bikes.

- The bicycle must not hinder the circulation on board and must not generate any particular risk for other passengers.
- The places provided on board (bicycle racks) must be used.
- The traveler is responsible for his or her bicycle (transportation, handling, supervision) throughout the trip.

Because of their size, tandems, trailers, cargo bikes or recumbents are prohibited, except on Loire à Vélo trains from mid-June to mid-September, which are specifically equipped to accommodate them. In case of heavy traffic, access may be denied.



YOU TRAVEL WITH YOUR SCOOTER

Scooters are accepted as hand luggage at the rate of one per passenger on the train. Whether electric or not, the scooter must be folded and labeled and must not exceed 130 x 90 cm when unfolded.

STATION PARKING

Most stations and stops have open bike shelters or racks where you can park your bike for the duration of your trip. They are freely accessible. Only bicycles, electric or not, folding or not, as well as bicycle trailers and scooters are allowed. **Scooters, motorcycles and other mopeds are not allowed.**

Some stations also have **secure Rémi bicycle shelters** (Courville sur Eure, Epernon, Malesherbes, Beaugency, Mer, Loches). Access to these shelters is free for Rémi bus and train subscribers.

For non Rémi subscribers, the rate is €10/year (JVMalin card required for this rate) or €1/ 24H (access code sent by SMS for this rate). RULES TO FOLLOW FOR A SAFE JOURNEY

- **I prefer the less busy Rémi train times** (mid-morning or afternoon). In case of overcrowding, my bike could be refused. The passenger is responsible for his or her bicycle (transport, handling, supervision) throughout the journey.
- **Before accessing, I remove the panniers and the battery from my bike.**
- **On the train, I put my bicycle in the bicycle spaces indicated** outside the train by pictograms indicating the number of bicycle spaces. I do not obstruct traffic, access to exits or service areas with my bicycle.

From Tours, the line serves Amboise, Chenonceaux and Montrichard.

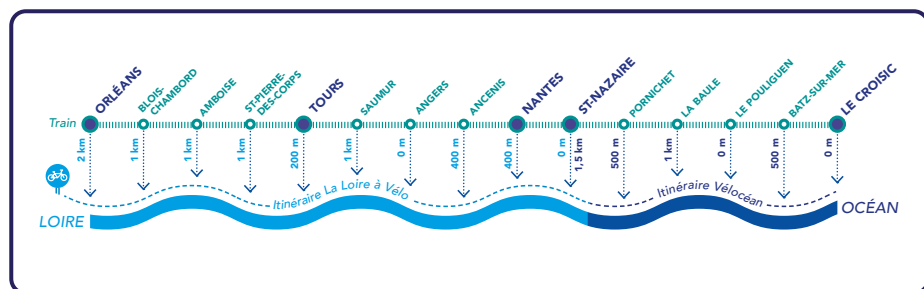


GOOD DEAL
