Product overview

ITCAM for Microsoft Applications helps achieve higher availability and optimized performance of the following applications through effective and proactive management: Windows servers with Active Directory, MS BizTalk Server, MS Cluster Server, MS Exchange Server, MS Host Integration Server, MS Hyper-V Server, MS Internet Information Services, MS .NET Framework, MS Lync Server, MS SharePoint Server, MS SQL Server, .NET Data Collector, Microsoft Windows, and VMware ESX Servers and Virtual Center. SNMP-enabled devices can also be monitored. This product is compatible with IBM® Tivoli® Monitoring V6.2.3, Fix Pack 1 and later.

1 Step 1: Choose an installation method

You can install the ITCAM for Microsoft Applications software using an automated tool or manually. 
3 Step 3: Evaluate your hardware and system configuration

7 Step 7: Install the operating system agent
