Product overview

ITCAM for Microsoft Applications helps achieve higher availability and optimized performance of the following applications through effective and proactive management: Windows servers with Active Directory, MS BizTalk Server, MS Cluster Server, MS Exchange Server, MS Host Integration Server, MS Hyper-V Server, MS Internet Information Services, MS .NET Framework, MS Lync Server, MS SharePoint Server, MS SQL Server, .NET Data Collector, Microsoft Windows, and VMware ESX Servers and Virtual Center. SNMP-enabled devices can also be monitored. This product is compatible with IBM® Tivoli® Monitoring V6.2.3, Fix Pack 3, or later.

1 Step 1: Choose an installation method



You can install the ITCAM for Microsoft Applications software by using an automated tool or manually. These choices are described in the Offering Guide that is available at IBM Tivoli Composite Application Manager for Microsoft Applications Knowledge Center.

2 Step 2: Access the software and documentation

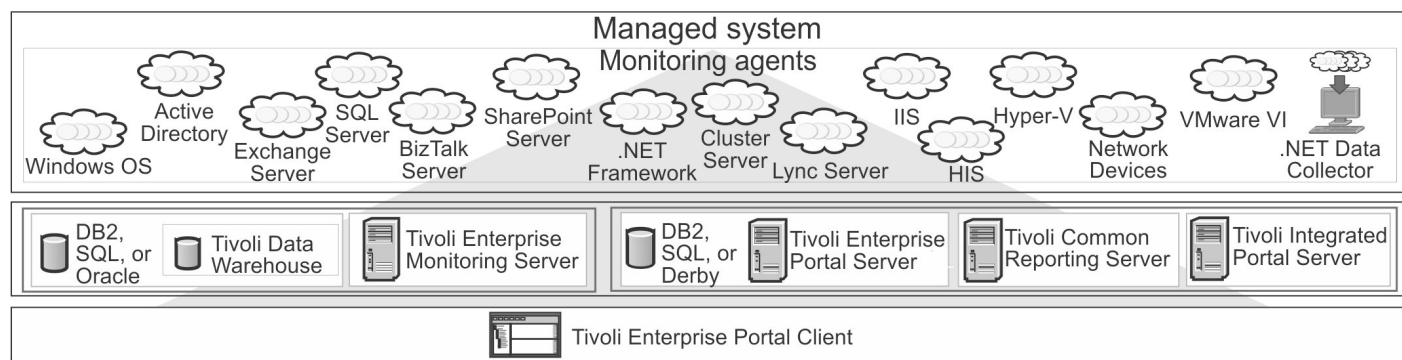
3 Step 3: Evaluate the hardware and system configuration
