

# **Zebra GK420d Label Printer Troubleshooting Guide**

#### **STATUS LIGHT ERRORS**

#### No Light - Printer not receiving power

- Check to make sure Power Switch is in the On position
- Check power connections from wall to adapter to printer

# Solid Green Light - Printer is idle

· Check Interface Connectors in the back of the printer

# **Double Flashing Green - Paused**


Press the Feed Button to continue printing


### Flashing Amber - Stopped

• Turn the Power Switch off and then on

#### Flashing Red - Stopped

- Check label roll to make sure it has not run out of labels
- Check to make sure label roll is secure on Media Guides (black)/Media Hangers (green)
- Check to make sure top cover is closed

# **PRINT QUALITY PROBLEMS**


#### No print on the label

Check to make sure the label roll is loaded correctly

#### The printed barcode and information does not look right

• Clean the printhead using an alcohol wipe

### The label is misaligned



- 1. Pull the release latches toward the front of the printer
- 2. Open the Media Guides and hold open the Media Hangers
- 3. Lower the roll between the hangers
- 4. Make sure to position the roll so that its printing surface will be up as it passes over the media guides
- 5. For some models, close the media guides by turning the guide adjuster knob to the front
- 6. The media guide edges should touch but should not restrict the edges of the roll
- 7. Close the top cover and press down until the latches snap into place
- 8. Press the Feed Button to verify that the labels come out properly
