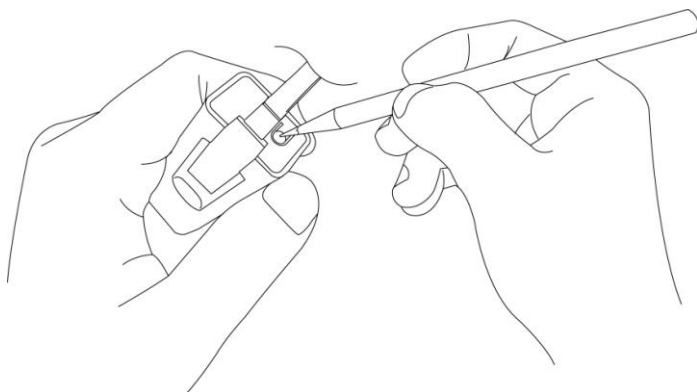


VI. 如何重新设定 BR-6258nL

若您发现您的 BR-6258nL 未正常运作，或者您想要重设/移除所有设定，您可以依下列步骤，重置 BR-6258nL，将其恢复至出厂预设状态。

1. 请确认您的 BR-6258nL 已经正确接上电源 (将 BR-6258nL 本体上的 USB 端口接至计算机的 USB 端口或连接一 USB 电源变压器)
