
General Description


These N-Channel Logic Level MOSFETs are produced using Fairchild Semiconductor's advanced PowerTrench process that has been especially tailored to minimize the on-state resistance and yet maintain superior switching performance.

These devices are particularly suited for low voltage applications in notebook computers, portable phones, PCMCIA cards, and other battery powered circuits where fast switching, and low in-line power loss are needed in a very small outline surface mount package.




Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics.




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature.




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics.




Figure 2. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate Voltage.




Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage.





Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature.





Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics.








Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area.

Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation.




Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve.
