

"IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS"

When using the sewing machine, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following.

"Read all instructions before using."

DANGER — To reduce the risk of electric shock.

- 1. The sewing machine should never be left unattended when plugged in. Always unplug this sewing machine from the electrical outlet immediately after using and before cleaning.
- 2. Always unplug before relamping. Replace bulb with same type rated 15 watts.

WARNING — To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.

- 1. Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when the sewing machine is used by or near children.
- 2. Use this sewing machine only for its intended use as described in this manual. Use only accessories recommended by the manufacturer as contained in this manual.
- 3. Never operate this sewing machine if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the sewing machine to the nearest authorized dealer or service center for examination, repair, electrical or mechanical adjustment.
- 4. Never operate the sewing machine with any air openings blocked. Keep ventilation openings of the sewing machine and foot controller free from the accumulation of lint, dust, and loose cloth.
- 5. Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- 6. Do not use outdoors.
- 7. Do not operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- 8. To disconnect, turn the main switch to the symbol "O" position which represents off, then remove plug from outlet.
- 9. Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- 10. Keep fingers away from all moving parts. Special care is required around the sewing machine needle.
- 11. Always use the proper needle plate. The wrong plate can cause the needle to break.
- 12. Do not use bent needles.
- 13. Do not pull or push fabric while stitching. It may deflect the needle causing it to break.
- 14. Switch the sewing machine to the symbol "O" position when making any adjustments in the needle area, such as threading needle, changing needle, threading bobbin, or changing presser foot, and the like.
- 15. Always unplug the sewing machine from the electrical outlet when removing covers, lubricating, or when making any of the user servicing adjustments mentioned in the instruction manual.

Your machine is the most advanced computerized home use sewing machine.

To fully enjoy all the features incorporated, however, we suggest that you study this booklet.

PLEASE READ BEFORE USING YOUR SEWING MACHINE

For safe operation

- Be sure to keep your eye on the needle while sewing. Do not touch the pulley, thread take-up, needle, or other moving parts.
- Remember to turn off the power switch and unplug the cord when:
 - Operation is completed
 - Replacing or removing the needle or any other parts
 - A power failure occurs during use
 - Lubricating and maintaining the machine
 - Leaving the machine unattended.
- 3. Do not store anything on the foot controller.
- 4. Plug the machine directly into the wall. Do not use extension cords.

For a longer service life

- When storing your sewing machine, avoid direct sunlight and high humidity locations. Do not store the sewing machine beside a space heater, iron, or other hot objects.
- Use only neutral soaps or detergents to clean the case. Benzene, thinner, and scouring powders can damage the case and machine, and should never be used.
- 3. Do not drop or hit the machine.
- Always consult the operation manual when replacing or installing any assemblies, the presser, needle, or other parts to assure correct installation.

For repair or adjustment

In the event a malfunction occurs or adjustment is required, first follow the troubleshooting table in the back of the operation manual to inspect and adjust the machine yourself. If the problem persists, please consult your nearest service center.

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
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
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

A. SELECTION KEY

UTILITY STITCH KEY

Use this key when you sew utility stitches such as straight stitch, button hole etc.

- CHARACTER SEWING KEY Use this key when you sew characters such as alphabet, number etc.
- O DECORATIVE STITCH KEY Use this key when you sew decorative stitches.
- BASIC SEWING KEY
 Use this key for basic sewing such as zipper insertion, gathering etc.
- BASIC OPERATION KEY Use this key when you wish to know how to use this sewing machine.

6 SEWING APPLICATION KEY

You can obtain explanation of the stitch selected by using this key such as purpose or how to sew the stitch.


CARD KEY

Use this key when you use Memory card. When you insert or remove the memory card from machine, main power switch should be always turned off.

MEMORY KEY

Use this key when you memorize combinated patterns into machine or call the memory.


STITCH ADJUSTMENT KEY Use this key to adjust stitch length and width or thread tension.









WARNING

Machine does not work properly without upper thread because of upper thread sensor.

With some sewing patterns, needle keeps it's highest position while fabric is fed. Note that unique sound during this operation does not affect operation of machine.






A. "AUTOMATIC THREAD CUT-TER" BUTTON

When you press this button, both upper and lower threads are cut automatically and needle is placed at its highest position.

ADJUSTING SCREEN CONTRAST

B. "NEEDLE POSITION" BUTTON Press for changing needle position from up to down or from down to up.




C. "ENFORCEMENT STITCH" BUTTON

Machine sew reverse stitching with low speed while you press this button.


D. "START/STOP" BUTTON Press to start or stop machine. When foot controller is connected to machine, start/stop is regulated by foot controller.

Adjust brightness of L.C.D.



- 1. Touch "BASIC OPERATION".
- Touch "ADJUSTMENT", "BRIGHTNESS OF LCD" and "NEXT" in this order.
- E. SPEED CONTROL LEVER Controls the speed range. You can change the speed during sewing.


In case foot controller is used, you can control maximum speed by the speed control lever. The control lever should be set at right (Fastest) position for normal usage with foot controller.




 Insert bobbin into shuttle. Mind bobbin spinning direction as illustrated. (Use bobbin code No. X80309 -001)

 Holding thread end, press "START/STOP" button twice. Trim the excess thread after the machine stops.




 Deliver thread end through the slit, pull the thread toward you and cut excess thread.

6. Set speed at maximum.




4. Shut bobbin cover.

- Press "START/STOP" button. Machine stops automatically when bobbin is full. Press "START/STOP" button to stop.









- 1. Raise presser foot lever (If the presser foot is not raised, the upper thread cannot be threaded.)
- 2. Raise needle to up position.
- 3. Thread upper thread as illustrated.4. Lower presser foot.

- You do not need to pull to lower thread up before start sewing.








- Holding thread end by right hand. Lower needle thread lever and position thread to the right side passing beneath the catcher.
- Hook



 Release lever and thread at the same time. This makes needle threader deliver thread through needle eye.



4. Draw loop behind the needle towards the back.

Lower lever to bottom position and make sure thread is located beneath hook.


- 5. Cut threads by "AUTOMATIC THREAD CUTTER" button.
- *5. Cut thick thread (thicker than # 30) by another cutter on face plate as illustrated.



Bobbin thread is running out.

When warning message appears on message screen, lower thread is running out. Replace lower thread.






 When you raise presser foot lever further, presser foot is raised to higher position in order to put heavy material under presser foot easier.




If the fabric won't feed at beginning of sewing, please place another fabric at the back as thick as original.



Place thin paper under the fabric, and start sewing.






Baste edge of the fabric beforehand and sew to the basting. Or place thin paper under the fabric, and start sewing.







Keep needle in material at corner, then raise presser foot and turn material with paper.





Set basting thread at corner point. Turn direction at corner then start sewing pulling basting thread backward.


Support fabric feeding by hand, sew fabric to folded side.




1. Scale on needle plate


The scale of the presser foot "P" is graduated at interval 2 mm (0.079 inch).

- **1** 2 mm (0.079 inch)
- 2 18 (2 x 9) mm [0.709 (0.079 x 9) inch]

NOTE

Stitch guide foot "P" can be used for all utility stitches except button holes.

This foot cannot be used at gap (folded part) of fabric.




In case of straight stitch

Sew slowly, keeping seams in parallel with fabric edge.

Free arm

In case of zigzag stitch

Set stitch length "Short" in order to obtain fine stitch.




Free arm is convenient to sew tubular areas, cuffs, etc.




In case of reinforcement or elastic material



Baste the fabric beforehand and sew along to the basting using stretch straight stitch.


To change stitch length



Touch "STITCH ADJUSTMENT" and adjust the stitch length by touching "L" (Long) or "S" (Short) on screen.

- Original length: 2.5 mm (0.098 inch)
- 2 Long
- Short
- * In case of thin material less than 1 mm (0.039 inch), stitch length is set 4 mm (0.157 inch) automatically during sewing even if you set the length at 5 mm (0.197 inch).

To change needle position




Touch "STITCH ADJUSTMENT" and adjust the needle position by touching "W" (Right) or "N" (Left) on screen.








One point pattern


