Please read carefully before use!





Important Safeguards & Tips Please read carefully before use-

- Stainless Steel blades are sharp, please handle carefully
- Operate only with the lid, pitcher & base in the fully locked position
- To ensure stability use the C-Clamp on a dry, stable surface .
- Never put your hand or utensils inside the pitcher during operation.
- Do not immerse the Stainless Steel base in water
- Do not overload the blender, if operation becomes too difficult, you may need to add more liquid or remove some of the food/ ice from the pitcher.
- Adult supervision is required if the Vortex Blender™ is used by or near children.
- Do not attempt to attach a power drill onto the Vortex™, or alter it's design in any way
- Hand wash pitcher, blade assembly, lid and shot cap in warm soapy water. Do not use abrasive pads to clean parts. Do not wash in dishwasher.



Quick Start Instructions for Frozen Drinks Step 1-

Attach the C-Clamp to the Blender Base- the clamp locks securely up into the bottom of the base

Step 2-

After attaching the C-Clamp to the Blender Base, Securely tighten the base/clamp unit to a <u>stable</u>/dry surface

Step 3-

Attach pitcher to the base by turning clockwise into the base and locking it securely with the handle facing away from the Clamp side of the base. (3 possible positions)

Step 4-

Add liquids first, then food, fruit or ice into the pitcher (break up any large chunks of ice before adding)

Step 5-

Lock the Lid onto the Pitcher by turning clockwise

Step 6-

Start by turning the handle in the Top Position (Low Speed), for about 30 seconds (aprox. 55 revolutions) until the ice is crushed into smaller pieces

Note: you can crank from either left or right side of the handle. Forward and Reverse.

Step 7-

Move the handle to the Bottom Position (High Speed) and continue to crank until the mixture has reached desired consistency. If you happen to encounter any resistance, turn the handle back in the opposite direction a few strokes and continue forward when smooth.

Example: A n ice drink with 4 cups of ice, 2 cups of liquid can be blended in 30 seconds on top setting & 30 seconds on bottom setting.

Step 8-

To remove the pitcher, turn counter clockwise and lift off the base then remove the shot cap for serving.

Mountain Madness Margaritas

Start with the following for each Margarita desired-

6 fl. oz. Gold Tequila

4 oz Triple sec or Grand Mariner

2 fl. oz. Fresh lime juice

Add-

3 Cups Ice

Making the libation: Measure the fresh lime juice, tequila, and orange liqueur of choice into the pitcher of the Vortex™ Lexan® Blender.

Add in ice, and follow quick start instructions 6-8.

Tropical Temptation Banana Daiquiri

Start with the following for each Daiquiri desired-

6 fl. oz. Rum

6 fl. oz. Banana Liqueur

4 tablespoons Lemon juice

Add-

8 teaspoons Sugar

2 Bananas sliced in 1 in. pieces

4 Cups Ice

Making the libation: Measure the fresh lemon juice, rum, and banana liqueur of choice into the pitcher of the Vortex™ Lexan® Blender.

Add in ice, banana, sugar and follow quick start instructions 6-8.

Banana-Berry Summit Smoothie

Start with the following for each Smoothie desired-

16 fl. oz. Orange Juice

2 Bananas sliced in 1 in. pieces

2 Cups Frozen Berries

Add-

4 Cups Ice

Making the libation: Measure the orange juice, in the pitcher of the Vortex™ Lexan® Blender.

Add in banana, berries and ice, and follow quick start instructions 6-8.

Java Jolt Shake

Start with the following for each shake desired-

8 fl. oz. Coffee or espresso

8 fl. oz. Milk

2 Cups Vanilla Ice Cream, Ice Milk or Frozen Yogurt

Add-

4 Cups Ice

Making the libation: Measure the coffee and milk in the pitcher of the Vortex™ Lexan® Blender.

Add in ice cream and ice, then follow quick start instructions 6-8.

Recipes yield approximately four servings.
