1-2 For recording / playback

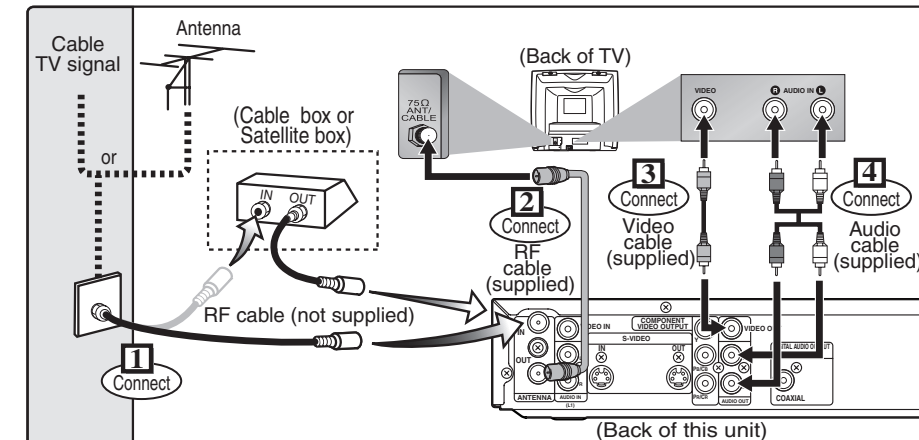
This unit can record to DVD-R and DVD-RW discs. DVD-R discs can only be recorded once, and cannot be erased. DVD-RW discs can be recorded and erased many times. DVD-R discs can only be recorded in Video mode, while DVD-RW discs can select a recording format between Video mode and VR mode.

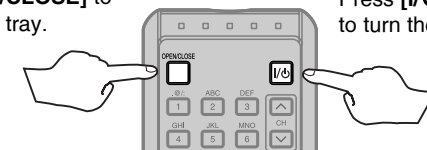
Watching TV/DVD

After all the necessary connections,

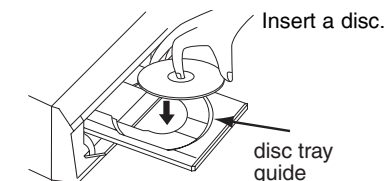
- Turn on the equipment connected to the recorder.
 - Select the corresponding video input on your television.
- Perform these selections whenever you operate the recorder.

3-1 DVD Playback

Press **[OPEN/CLOSE]** to open the disc tray.

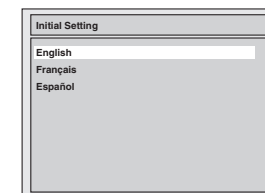


Press **[I/O ON/STANDBY]** to turn the unit on.

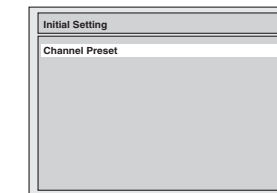


3-2 Initial Setting

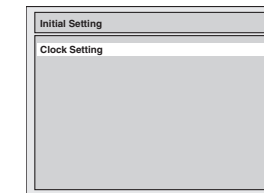
1. Turn on this unit for the first time, "Initial Setting" will appear. Using **[▲ / ▼]**, select your desired language for the OSD. Then press **[ENTER]** to go to next step.



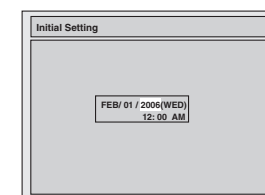
2. Press **[ENTER]** to start Channel Preset. The unit will start getting channels available in your area.



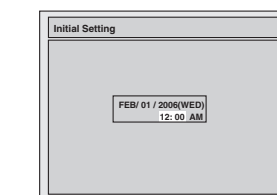
3. Clock Setting menu will appear. Press **[ENTER]** twice, default date will appear.



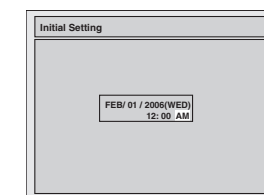
4. Using **[▲ / ▼]**, enter the date (month / day / year). Press **[◀ / ▶]** to move the cursor.



5. Using **[▲ / ▼]**, enter the time (hour / minute). Press **[◀ / ▶]** to move the cursor.



6. Press **[▲ / ▼]** to select "AM" or "PM". Press **[ENTER]**.



TV Program will automatically appear. (usually near channel 0)

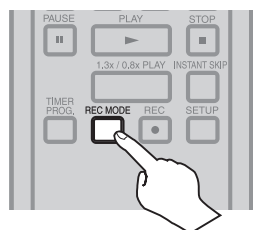

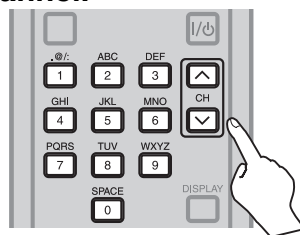
DVD Recording

4-1 Easy Recording

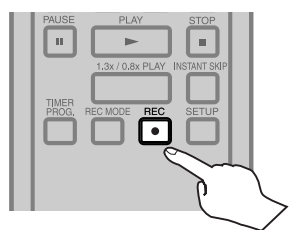
Select the recording mode.



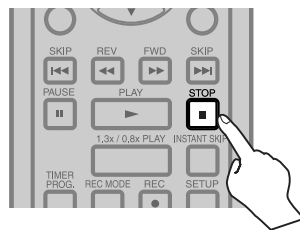
Select the desired channel.



Record on DVD disc.



Stop the recording.

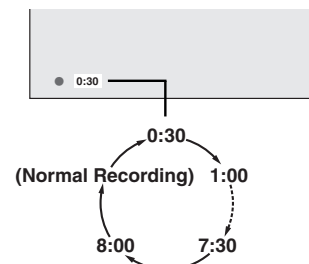
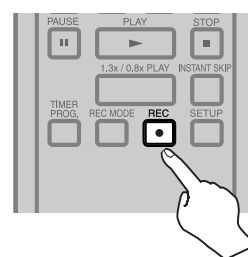

Press repeatedly to select desired recording time.

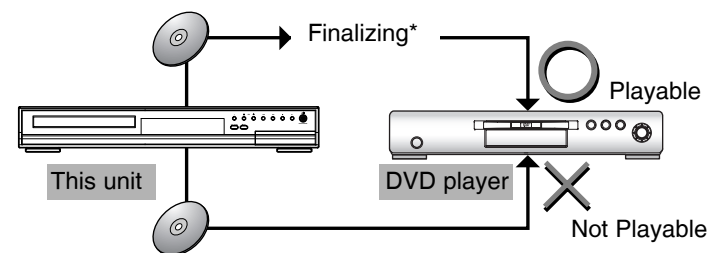
Recording times appear on the TV screen (30 minutes to 8 hours).
Recording will start.



When the unit reaches the specified time, it will be turned off automatically.

After all recordings, finalize your disc.

After recording, you must finalize the disc in order to play on other units. To finalize the disc, see page 74 of the owner's manual.

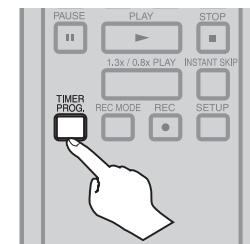


* You cannot finalize discs recorded in other DVD recorders.

4-2 Timer Recording

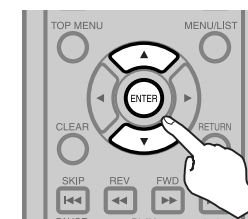
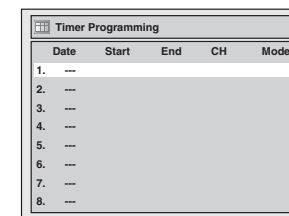
- You can set up to 8 programs (once, daily or weekly).
- Be sure to set the clock before starting a timer programming.

Press [TIMER PROG.].

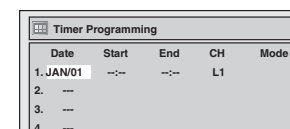


Timer Programming list appears.

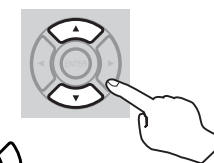
Select any blank line with [▲ / ▼] and press [ENTER].



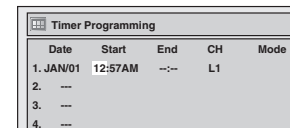
Set the date.



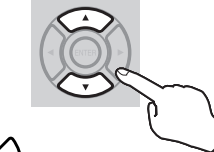
Move to next



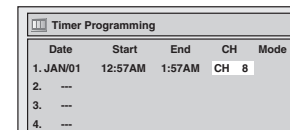
Set start and end time.



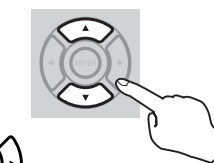

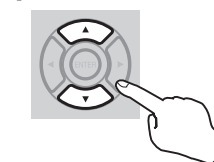
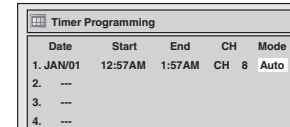
Select the channel number to record.



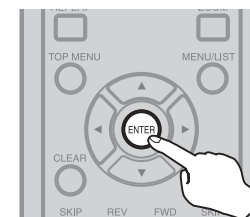
Move to next



Select the recording speed.

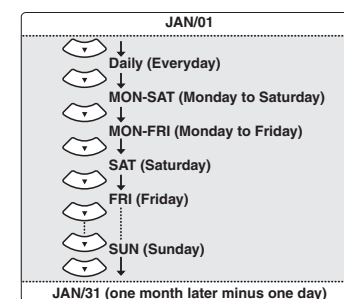


Save the Timer Program setting.



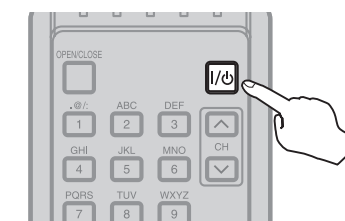
Timer Recording is now set.

Set the Timer Standby mode

Turn the unit off.

Hints for DVD Recording

- Formatting is not needed when inserting a new disc. **UNIT AUTOMATICALLY PREPARES THE DISC FOR RECORDING.**
- Timer Recording will not work when the power is on.
