## **OPERATION**

## 1.Setup Color, Brightness

Switch on the monitor, press Color Key, or Brightness Key or Contrast Key at the side, then press Up Key (  $\blacktriangle$  ) or Down Key(  $\blacktriangledown$  ) in the front to setup proper color, brightness or contrast accordingly for the screen.

## 2.Visitor's Call

Visitor call Process



Switch on the monitor power.

1. When a visitor presses the "Call" button on either camera unit, the monitor' speaker will sound a "chime" tone to announce that a visitor is at the door.

2. Upon viewing the monitor's screen and the visitor's image, you have two choices;

A. You can choose to "not respond" (by not lifting the handset) the visitor's image will disappear from the monitor's screen within 20 seconds.

B. You can choose to "respond" by lifting the handset and talking to the visitor as if uses a telephone. The visitor's image will remain on the monitor's screen for 60 seconds or until the handset is replaced Back into the cradle.

#### **3. Monitoring**

Press Monitor Button ( ) for the first time, the screen will display the video from camera 1, second time, the screen will display the video from camera 2, third time, end the monitor,



#### 4. Intercom

If an extension handset is installed with this monitor, you can press Intercom Key ( O ) to call the handset to start an internal intercom. Also this monitor can be called form extension handset(s).

### **5.Internal Memory Operation**

I :Standby:

In the standby status, the screen displays calendar.

After a period of time if there is no any action with this device, the screen will be switched off, you can press "EXIT" key to activate the calendar screen.

### II:Visitor's Call:

All the visitor's call will be recorded automatically, both video and audio.

If the call is answered, the recording file will be saved "Answered File".

If the call is answered, the recording file will be saved "Unanswered File".

#### **III:Playback** the recordings

At standby mode, press "ENTER" to see the main menu. There are three entries: "Answered Files", "Unanswered Files" and "Settings". You can use "UP" and "DOWN" keys to select an entry, then press "ENTER" key to go inside.

In "Answered Files" or "Unanswered Files" folds, you can see a file list, each file is labeled with time. Use "UP" and "DOWN" keys to select a file, the press "ENTER" key, you will see the playing of the recorded files, until you press "ENTER" key another time to stop. When the file is playing, Press "INTERCOM" key to stop playing file, if press "ENTER" key, replay the file; if press "INTERCOM" key again, then come to file list.
