# **About the Hymn Player**

#### **■**Introduction

This booklet contains instructions for using the Hymn Player feature of the CA93/CA63 digital piano.

The Hymn Player adapts the instrument's Concert Magic function to offer an additional 88 classical hymns of the faith. These hymns can be played automatically or 'conducted' by rhythmically tapping on the keyboard.

To enjoy performing using the Hymn Player, simply select the desired hymn, then tap any of the 88 piano keys with a steady rhythm and tempo. The Hymn Player will provide the correct melody and accompaniment notes, regardless of which keys are played. With the Hymn Player, anybody, young or old can enjoy performing classic hymns from the moment they sit down at the CA93/CA63 digital piano.

### **■** Hymn Player Song List

The **Hymn Player Song List** section lists the 88 hymns available in Hymn Player mode and 32 hymns available in Prelude mode. Both lists show the song name, selection key, and arrangement type as an abbreviation.

Abbre	viation	Arrangement type	Playing method
Е	ΞB	Easy Beat	Tap a constant steady beat on any key on the keyboard.
N	ΛP	Melody Play	Tap the rhythm of the melody on any key of the keyboard.
S	SK	Skillful	Tap the rhythm of the melody and the accompaniment on any key of the keyboard.

### Using Hymn Player

### 1 Turning Hymn Player On/Off


The Hymn Player function must first be enabled in the 'Basic Settings' menu before the additional features can be accessed from the Music Menu.

### 1. Entering the Basic Settings menu

Press the FUNCTION button on the normal operation screen.


The first functions menu (Basic Settings) will be shown in the LCD display.

Press the FUNCTION button again to enter the Basic Settings menu.



### 2. Selecting the Hymn Player setting

Press the ◀ or ▶ buttons to cycle through the different settings pages until Hymn Player setting is selected.




### 3. Turning the Hymn Player on/off

Press the ▲ or ▼ buttons to turn the Hymn Player setting on/off.

When set to 'On', the Hymn Player function replaces the standard Concert Magic songs with 88 hymns of the faith.

In addition, the standard Demo mode will be replaced by a special 'Prelude' mode in which a selection of the 88 hymns will play repeatedly for use as prelude music.

To return to using the standard Demo and Concert Magic functions/songs, set the Hymn Player setting to 'Off'.



\* The 'User Memory' function can be used to store the preferred Hymn Player on/off setting, allowing the Hymn Player to be enabled automatically every time the CA93/CA63 digital piano is turned on. For more information, please refer to the 'User Memory' instructions on page 53 of the of the CA93/CA63 owner's manual.

### 4. Exiting the Hymn Player setting

Press a SOUND SELECT button to exit the Hymn Player setting and return to normal operation.

### 2 Prelude Mode

With the Hymn Player setting enabled in the 'Basic Settings' menu, a special Prelude feature will replace the standard Demo mode, playing a selection of hymns repeatedly for use as prelude or postlude music. For a complete listing of available hymns, please refer to the 'Prelude Mode Song List' on page 8 of this booklet.

### 1. Entering Prelude mode


Press the MUSIC button, to enter the Music Menu.


The LED indicator for the MUSIC button will start to flash, and the Music Menu will be shown in the LCD display. Prelude mode will be selected automatically.

> Music Menu Prelude

Press the FUNCTION button to enter Prelude mode.

One of the 32 prelude hymns will be selected at random and will start to play, with the name of the hymn shown in the LCD display.






- \* Each hymn will be played for two verses.
- \* At the end of the second verse, there will be a brief pause before the next hymn starts. Playback will then continue in list order.

#### **■** Controlling hymn playback

While Prelude mode is selected and a hymn is playing:

Press the PLAY/STOP button to stop/start hymn playback.

Press the SOUND SELECT buttons to select the desired sound to be used for hymn playback.



### 2. Exiting Prelude mode

Press the MUSIC button to exit Prelude mode and return to normal operation.

## 3 Playing (Listening to) a Hymn

The Hymn Player features 88 classic hymns, with each hymn assigned to one of the 88 piano keys. The hymns are classified into six different categories: Classic, Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter, Patriotic, and Wedding. For a complete listing of available hymns, please refer to the 'Hymn Player Song List' on page 9 of this booklet.


### 1. Entering Hymn Player mode


Press the MUSIC button, then press the ▲ or ▼ buttons until Hymn Player is shown in the LCD Display.

Music Menu Hymn Player

Press the FUNCTION button to enter Hymn Player mode.

The name of the first hymn will be shown in the LCD display.






### 2. Selecting a hymn

Press and hold the MUSIC button, then press the key to which the desired hymn is assigned (page 9).

The number and name of the selected hymn will be shown in the LCD display.

#### 3. Playing the selected hymn


Press the PLAY/STOP button.

The LED indicator for the PLAY/STOP button will turn on and the selected hymn will start to play.



Each hymn will play for one verse, before the next hymn in the same category is selected automatically and starts to play.

Press the PLAY/STOP button to stop hymn playback.



- \* Press the SOUND SELECT buttons to select the desired sound to be used for hymn playback.
- \* Press the ◀ or ▶ buttons to adjust the volume of the left/right-hand parts of the hymn.
- \* Press and hold the METRONOME button, then press the ▲ or ▼ buttons to increase or decrease the tempo of the hymn.

### 4. Exiting Hymn Player mode

Press the MUSIC button to exit Hymn Player mode and return to normal operation.

### 4 Performing a Hymn


The Hymn Player allows complete beginners to 'conduct' hymns by simply tapping the keyboard with a steady rhythm and tempo.


### 2. Selecting a hymn

Enter Hymn Player mode.

Press and hold the MUSIC button, then press the key to which the desired hymn is assigned.

The number and name of the selected hymn will be shown in the LCD display.






### 3. Performing the selected hymn

Press a key on the keyboard with a constant steady beat.

The hymn will advance with every key that is pressed. Pressing the keys gently will produce a soft sound, while pressing heavily will produce a loud sound.

- \* Press the SOUND SELECT buttons to select the desired sound to be used for hymn playback.
- \* Press the ◀ or ▶ buttons to adjust the volume of the left/right-hand parts of the hymn.

The hymn will repeat continuously from the beginning.




### Steady Beat and Normal playing modes

By default, the Hymn Player will use the 'Steady Beat' playing mode, allowing hymns to be performed by simply tapping any key with a constant beat.

Press the FUNCTION button to show the current playing mode in the LCD display, then press the FUNCTION button again to select 'Normal' playing mode for a more challenging playing experience.

### 4. Exiting Hymn Player mode

Press the MUSIC button to exit Hymn Player mode and return to normal operation.
