- When using the Printer on the Netware network environment, install the IPX/SPX setup wizard. Refer to the Operating Instruction (For IPX-SPX setup wizard) on the provided CD-ROM. IPX/SPX Setup Wizard is not available for DP-8020E/8020P/8016P.
- When there are two printer drivers (for Network Port Connection and Parallel / USB Port Connection) for the same model, each printer driver can be used normally.
 The printer driver can be selected from the Printer List of the Print Screen within the application software.

The Job Status Utility software will display the pop-up Completion Notice on your Windows Desktop when the Print, PC Fax, Copy, or a Fax job is completed.

The information displayed in the Completion Notice vary according to the type of job being performed.

• Completion Notice for Fax job is not available for DP-8016P.
