The programmes are time-controlled for lightly soiled textiles. If textiles are heavily soiled, reduce the load or select additional functions, e.g. "Wash Plus. Programmes without prewash – pour detergent into dispenser II, programmes with prewash – divide detergent between dispensers I and II.

Rinse/Freshen Up 🌞, Spin©, Drain

Select the **Wash Plus** additional function if washing 7 kg of cottons and coloureds.


- Pull out the mains plug!
- Machine housing, control panel
- Wipe with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive detergents.
- Immediately remove washing and cleaning agent residue.
- Do not clean the appliance with a water jet.


## Clean the detergent drawer ...

... if it contains detergent or fabric softener residue.



- Open the cover.
- Clean with water and dry.
- 4. Close and lock the cover (place cylinder on guide pin).
- Insert detergent drawer.







Leave detergent drawer open so that residual water can evaporate.

Leave washing machine door open so that the drum can dry out.

Rust stains - use chlorine-free cleaning agent, not steel wool.

**Descaling** No washing in the machine!

Descale according to the instructions of the descaling agent-manufacturer, not required for correct detergent dosage.

# Information on the display panel depending on model

F:16	Close the washing machine door properly; washing may be caught.
F:17	Turn on the tap, supply hose kinked/jammed; clean filter ( <i>page</i> 9), water pressure too low.
F:18	Clean detergent-solution pump (page 9), outlet pipe/drainage hose blocked.
F:23	Water in the base pan, appliance leaking. Call customer service!

# Maintenance



- Risk of scalding! Allow detergent solution to cool down!
- Turn off the tap!

#### Detergent-solution pump

Set programme selector to **Off**, pull out the mains plug.

1. Open and remove service flap.



For models with drainage hose:

2. Take drainage hose out of the holder and pull out of the housing. Remove sealing cap, allow detergent solution to flow out.

Press on sealing cap and insert drainage hose into the holder.


For models without drainage hose:

2\* Carefully unscrew pump cover until the detergent solution begins to run out. When the service flap is half full. screw back the pump cover and empty the service flap.

Repeat steps until all the detergent solution has run out.



- 4. Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent-solution pump must rotate).
- Reinsert and screw on pump cover.
- 6. Insert and close service flap.





#### Filters in the water supply



Risk of electric shock! Do not immerse Aqua-Stop safety device in water (contains electric valve).

Release water pressure in the supply hose:

- 1. Turn off the tap!
- Select any programme (except Spin@/Drain ).
- Press Start . Leave programme for approx. 40 seconds.
- Set programme selector to **Off**.
- Remove hose from tap.
- 6. Clean filter with small brush.
- Depending on the model, remove hose from the rear of the appliance and clean the filter.

- If a fault cannot be rectified or a repair is required:
  - Set programme selector to **Off** and pull out the mains plug.
  - Turn off the tap and call customer service (Installation instructions).



# ▲ Safety instructions

- Read and follow the operating and installation instructions and all other information enclosed with the washing machine.
- Retain documents for subsequent use.

Risk of electric shock

- Never pull out the mains plug by tugging the power cord!
- Never insert/pull out the mains plug with damp hands.

Risk of injury

- Washing machine door may become very hot.
- Caution when draining hot detergent solution.
- Do not climb on the washing machine.
- Do not lean on the open washing machine door.

Risk of posioning Risk of suffocation

- Keep detergents and care products out of the reach of children.
- Keep packaging, plastic film and packaging parts out of the reach of children.

Danger to life

On redundant appliances:

- Pull out the mains plug.
- Sever the power cord and discard together with the plug.
- Destroy the lock on the washing machine door. This will prevent children from locking themselves in and suffocating.

Risk of explosion

 Caused by detergents containing solvents, e.g. stain remover/items of washing pretreated with solvent naphtha may result in an explosion after being loaded into the washing machine. Beforehand thoroughly rinse items of washing by hand.
