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



Pull the string loop through the hole in the lens cap.




Put the strap through the string





- Loosen the strap in the stopper beforehand to adjust the strap
- Thread the strap through the **5** stopper as indicated by the arrows. When the strap length is satisfactory, pull on the strap to make sure it is securely fastened.




Attach the strap to the other 6 strap eyelet following steps 3 – 5.

### **Quick View**



To return to the shooting mode, press the shutter button halfway. • The monitor turns off. You can now shoot pictures using the viewfinder.


### **Loading the batteries**



Make sure the camera is turned off (i.e. the mode dial is set to OFF).




Slide the battery compartment lock on the battery compartment cover in the direction of 3.



Slide the battery compartment cover in the direction of the arrow printed on it, using your fingertip.



When using CR-V3 (Olympus LB-01) lithium battery pack





When using AA (R6) batteries




Close the battery compartment cover, then press it down and slide it in the opposite direction of the arrow printed on it.

- When pressing the battery compartment cover shut. be sure to press the center of the cover, as it may be difficult to close properly by pressing the edge.
- Make sure the cover is completely closed.





# 3 Inserting a SmartMedia removable

Insert the card fully with the contact area facing towards the monitor side (back of the camera). Push the card down firmly, being careful not to bend it. The card will lock into position and not pop back up when properly inserted.





Push in the card lightly to unlock it, then pull it


Close the cover tightly.



• NEVER open the card cover, eject the card, remove the batteries, or disconnect the optional AC adapter while the camera is in use or the camera is communicating with a computer. Doing so could destroy all data on the card.




Display the movie frame (picture with ₽) you want to play back. → See steps 1 and 2 in "Viewing still pictures".

# Single-frame erase



Zoom in on a subject (telephoto) Press the zoom lever toward T to zoom in




### S-Prg : Scene program shooting



### **Menu functions for shooting operation**

### **CAMERA**

DRIVE	Selects the drive mode from sequential shooting, auto bracketting, or self-timer shooting.
ISO	Selects the ISO sensitivity. (AUTO/100/200/400)
A/S/M/sil	Selects the exposure mode from A (Aperture priority auto), S (Shutter priority auto), M (Manual mode), or \$\omega\$ (My mode setup) when the Mode dial is set to "A/S/M/\$\omega\$".
\$*	Adjusts the flash intensity for different shooting conditions.
\$ SLOW	Adjusts the flash for slow shutter speeds. (\$SLOW1/③ \$SLOW/\$SLOW2)
NOISE REDUCTION	Reduces the noise on images during long exposures.
DIGITAL ZOOM	Zooming can be set up to 7.5x in combination with the optical 3x zooming (equivalent to 32 mm-96 mm on a 35 mm camera).
FULLTIME AF	Keeps the image in focus at all times without having to press the shutter button halfway.

PANORAMA

The Olympus standard SmartMedia card (supplied with this camera) allows you to combine pictures side by side. (\*CAMEDIA Master software must be uesd to create panoramas after the images are taken with the camera.)

### **PICTURE**

<b>4</b>	Sets the record mode. (TIFF/SHQ/HQ/SQ)
WB	Adjusts the white balance according to the light source. (AUTO/PRESET/ [])
WB½	Allows you to make fine changes to the white balance manually.
SHARPNESS	Adjusts the sharpness of images.
CONTRAST	Adjusts the contrast of images.

### Menu functions for playback operation

### (still pictures)

Runs through all saved pictures one after another (slide-show).

### **MOVIE PLAY (movies)**

Plays back movies.

### INFO

Changes the amount of shooting information (ISO, White Balance, etc.) displayed on the Monitor.

### **ROTATE** (still pictures)

Changes the orientation of the played back picture among three angles. (-90°/+90°/0°)

### **CARD**

CARD SETUP	Formats SmartMedia cards (FORMAT) (*All existing data stored on the card is erased when the card is formatted.), or erases all images in the card (ALL ERASE).
