




Attach the strap





- b. Insert the battery in the camera




- To remove the battery, press the battery lock knob in the direction of the arrow.

This section explains how to turn on the camera in shooting mode.


a. Set the mode dial to AUTO



Still picture shooting modes






About the date and time setting screen




- a. Press the $\triangle \mathbf{Z}/\square$ button and $\nabla \dot{\mathbf{S}}$ button to select [Y].
- The first two digits of the year are fixed.



b. Press the > 4 button.



c. Press the $\triangle \mathbf{Z}/\square$ button and the ∇ $\dot{\circ}$) button to select [M].



e. Press the △☑/☐ button and the ∇ (*) button to select [D].



- f. Press the > \$\frac{1}{2}\$ button.
- g. Press the $\triangle \mathbf{Z}/\square$ button and the ∇ $\dot{\otimes}$ button to select "hour" and "minute".
- The time is displayed in the 24-hour format.




- h. Press the > \$\forall \text{ button.}

- For a more accurate setting, you can press the (button when the time signal hits 00 seconds.






Erase pictures
