



Assembly


STEP 1

Assembling the Top Panel, Bottom Panel, Left & Right Sides Panels, and Left & Right Partition Panels




Attaching the STEP 2 **Casters**

Insert the casters firmly.



STEP 3

Attaching the **Shelf Panel**



Insert the shelf supporting pins (3) into the holes on the inward side of the partition panel 66. The shelf can be set at 2 levels.

Shelf Panel 7 Face the black side toward the front.

Incline the panel and place the dented parts over the shelf supporting pins.

STEP 4


Attaching the Rear Panel

Rear panel fastening screws (2)

Rear Panel 3 -

Face the black side toward the inside.


Tighten the rear panel fastening screws ② to strengthen the overall structure.



STEP 5

Attaching the glass doors

Glass panel bushing 4 Upper rotation shaft



Glass Door

Install the door (in "open" conditions.)


- 1. Insert the glass panel bushing ④ into the holes of the top panel.
- 2. In order not to scratch the bottom panel, insert the upper shaft of the glass door (in "open" conditions) into the glass panel bushing (4).
- 3. While pushing the upper rotation shaft upward, slip the lower rotation shaft into the glass panel bushing. Make sure it is locked in position.

STEP 6 Attaching the Shelf Panel

- 2. Attach the plastic position pins ⑦ to the four corners of the glass shelf. (Be sure to do this.)
- Securely screw in the glass shelf support metal position pins (a) (four on each side). The position of the glass shelf can be adjusted in two steps.




Shelf Panel (Glass panel)


3. Fit the glass shelf assembled in step 2 snuggly on the metal position pins.

STEP '


When placing video sets and other instruments




Knock-out (shaded) parts could be removed from the rear panel for wiring and ventilation of the instrument(s) placed inside.



STEP 2 In case of offset or inclination of the doors



- 1. Loosen the screw of the glass panel bushing by using a plus (+) screwdriver.
- 2. Move the bushing left, right, backward or forward to adjust for offset or inclination.
- 3. Tighten the screw after finishing the adjustment.
 - * Do not use electric powered screwdrivers.
