


Preparation for operating

■ INSTALLING BATTERIES

Installing and replacing batteries should be done at stop position.

1. Open the battery cover and place 2 AAA typed alkaline batteries in the compartment and then replace the cover.





(Battery Type: AAA or LR03 or UM-4 or equivalent)

* Different Battery type and Volume level can cause different Battery Life Time

Using battery

- 1.For managing battery life time efficiently, the unit will be automatically shut off if you do not press any button for more than 1 minute. And then the unit converts to CLOCK mode.
- 2.Please let HOLD switch ON position when you don't use the unit.

Preparation for operating


■ Power On/Off

Set HOLD button OFF and press PLAY/STOP() or FUNC/DISP() or REC/STOP() button shortly. The unit will be powered on. With long pressing each button, the concerned operation will start if the unit doesn't operate for more than 1 minute. if converts to CLOCK mode.

■ Setting the Clock

- lets you set the clock when you replace batteries. When you replace batteries, ALL DISPLAY will light on LCD and SET DATE will be displayed. Press MENU button for a long time.
- 2.Set Date/Month: Select the blinking part of LCD by ★/¥jog key and press MENU(1111111) button.
- 3. Set 12H/24H MODE: Select one mode from blinking "12H" and "24H" by

 ↑ ▼jog key and then press MENU(Time) button.
- 4. Set time : Select the blinking part of LCD by ★/¥ jog key and press MENU (। button.
- e.g) To set 8: 17 PM on March 1st, 2000, operate as follows.



♣ To change the clock, press MENU(Till) button for more than 1 second on Clock or Stop mode.


Operating Recorder

■ Button Functions

- PLAY/STOP(): Plays and Stops a message playing back.
- FUNC/DISP(): Selects Function and Display condition.
- REC/STOP(): Records and Stops a message recording.
- MENU/REPEAT(:: Selects MENU, SEARCH, REPEAT, FF, REW function.
- VOLUME()+.-: Controls a volume.
- ERASE("): Erases recoreded messages.
- HOLD(i): Prevents mis-operation by setting Hold mode.

■ Recording Messages

- Slide HOLD(() button to OFF position and press one button among PLAY/STOP(), REC/STOP() and FUNC/DISP(), so that the unit gets POWER ON.
- (Press REC(**⑥**) button for more than 1 second on Clock Mode, the recording will also start.)
- Let MIC toward sound source and press REC/STOP() button. Recording File will be added and recording will be continued.



Press Rec/ Stop button, REC will be displayed for 3 seconds and proceeded recording time will be displayed.

- 3. To stop recording, press REC/STOP() button one more time.

 (If you press REC/STOP() button within 2 seconds after starting recording mode, recording will be stopped and canceled.)
- Press PLAY/STOP() button just after recording, the last recording file will be played.
- A Do test recording in advance to prevent from failing recording.

♣ If MEMORY is exhausted or file number gets more than 100 messages in one folder, "FULL" will be displayed and recording won't be continued.



* VOLUME level won't be adjusted during recording.

■ Playing back Messages

1.Let HOLD() button OFF position and press one button among PLAY/STOP (), REC/STOP() and FUNC/DISP() button, so that the unit gets

with 2 message files

Select FILE number with ★/▼jog key.

(Press PLAY/STOP() button for more than 1 second on Clock Mode, the playing back will also start.)

- 3. At CONTINUOUS PLAYBACK ON mode, all files in a folder will be played back till the end of the concerned folder continuously. At CONTINUOUS PLAYBACK OFF mode, just the current playing file will be played and stopped (refer to setting MENU)
- 4. Adjust VOLUME level with VOLUME() button.
- 5. To stop playing back, press PLAY/STOP() button one more time.



A During playing back messages, MENU won't be operated.

■ Erasing Messages

<Erasing a single message>

- 1. Select a FILE with ∤/Ţjog key at STOP mode and press ERASE (") button for more than 3 seconds. ERASE will be blinking on LCD for checking the message The fore and hind part of erasing file will be played for 5 seconds.
- 2. Press ERASE(") button one more time, selected file will be erased and a following FILE No. will be changed as current FILE No.



<Erasing all messages in a FOLDER>

- 1. Select FOLDER with MENU(i) and ¼/√ jog key.
- 2. Press both ERASE () and REC/STOP() buttons for more than 3 seconds, ALL ERASE will be blinking on LCD.
- 3. And then press ERASE(🛗) button one more time, so that all messages in the selected folder will be erased. The locked message won't be erased.

<FORMAT>

1. Press ERASE(") and REC/STOP() button for 7 seconds at the same time, All CLEAR displays. And press EARSE (") button shortly, all data files of the recorder will be deleted.





An erased message can't be restored.

At FORMAT mode, all data even including locked file will be erased.

■ Hearing AID Function

- 1. Changing to Hearing Aid mode
- Press FUNC/DISPLAY() button shortly at stop position so that the unit will be changed to the Hearing Aid Mode.
- EARPHONE will be used as a Hearing Aid by inserting earphone into EAR terminal of the unit.
- 2. Canceling Hearing Aid Mode



- Volume adjusting
- The sound of Hearing Aid can be adjusted with VOLUME() button.
- 4. Recording on the Hearing Aid Mode
- To record, press REC() button on the Hearing Aid Mode.
- Press REC() button one more time after recording and the mode changes to the Hearing Aid mode.
- To pause during recording, press FUNC/DISPLAY() button once.
- To stop pausing, press FUNC/DISPLAY() button one more time.

☞Reference

♣ Function Key operation order :VOICE→HEAR→TEL→VOICE When the batteries are low, LO Batt appears. Replace the batteries.

■ Setting the Menu

- 1. Slide HOLD(((11111)) button to OFF position and press PLAY/STOP((●)), REC/STOP((●)) or FUNC/DISP((●)) button shortly. The unit will be powered on.
- Select Folder
 NORMAL TYPE

Max. 100 voice recording files record into each divided A, B, C, D folder.Press MENU (☐☐☐☐) button shortly to convert into FOLD Mode and select A,B,C,D folder with ¼√ jog key.

USB TYPE

Max. 100 voice recording files record into each divided A, B, C folder.Press MENU (☐☐☐☐ button shortly to convert into FOLD Mode and select A,B,C folder with ⚠️ jog key.

Select Recording Mode

Press MENU (Time) button shortly on Folder mode to convert into Recording Mode and select HQ, SP, LP with \$\int\{\text{f}}\) jog key.

• Select VOS(Voice Operated Recording System)

File Erasing Lock

If you lock on the important message, the locked message won't be erased even with erasing key. Press MENU() button shortly on VOS mode to convert into LOCK Mode and select ON, OFF with **★**/¥ jog key.



Continuous Playback

Set CONTINUOUS PLAYBACK to ON, all files in a folder will be played back till the end of the concerned folder continuously. Press MENU() button shortly on LOCK mode to convert into CONTI Mode and select ON,OFF with ★/¥ jog key.



■ Convenient Recording Function

<PAUSE>

Press FUNC/DISP() button during recording, recording will be paused. Press FUNC/DISP() button once again or REC/STOP() button, PAUSE will be released. (If PAUSE mode continues for more than 30 minutes, the unit will be AUTO OFF and converted to CLOCK mode.)

<DISPLAY FUNCTION>

Press FUNC/DISP() button for more than 1 second RECORDING STATUS -> CURRENT TIME->REC DATE->REMAIN TIME will be displayed

<REC MONITOR>

During recording, you can monitor recording message by inserting earphone into earphone iack.

<INDEX ADDITION>

Slide up ★ jog key during mode, FILE number will be added and recording will be continued.

<MIC SENSE >

To control MIC sensitivity, you can select HI /NOR/LO MIC SENSE with MENU (button.

<VOS>

Recording will be proceeded only with voice and other actual sound.

Operating Recorder

■ CONVENIENT PLAYBACK FUNCTION

< Volume Adjustment>

Controls volume level from 0 to 20 with VOLUME () button on playing back mode.



Press FUNC/DISP() button during PLAYBACK, PLAYBACK will be paused. Press FUNC/DISP() or PLAY/STOP() button PAUSE will be released. (If PAUSE mode continues for more than 30 minutes, the unit will be AUTO OFF and converted to CLOCK mode.)



<DISPLAY FUNCTION>

Press FUNC/DISP() button for more than 1 second during PLAYBACK, PLAYBACK STATUS-> CURRENT TIME-> REC DATE-> REMAIN TIME will be displayed successively. (If there's no recorded message, REC DATE won't be displayed)

<SCAN PLAY>

Press PLAY/STOP() button for more than 1 second on stop mode, the fore part of each file in current folder will be played for 5 seconds in order.

<REW & FF>

Slide up \$\frac{1}{4}\) jog key shortly on PLAYBACK mode, the previous and afterward recording message will play back. Slide up \$\frac{1}{4}\) jog key for a long time on PLAYBACK mode, the first 10 seconds of message will play quickly and then the remaining part of message will play slowly. Slide up \$\frac{1}{4}\) jog key for more than 1 second, the message playing will be skipped some part.

<FILE REPEAT>

Press MENU(🛗) button for more than 1 second during PLAYBACK, current playing file will be repeated. And press PLAY/STOP(🌖) button, FILE REPEAT will be canceled.



<A-B SECTION REPEAT>

Press MENU (Thin) button one time shortly druing PLAYBACK mode, Point A will be selected. And please press MENU button one more time. Point B will be selected. And then A-B section will be played repeatedly. (If you don't select point B after selecting point A, A-END section will be played repeatedly.)

Operating Recorder

<ADDITIONAL RECORDING>

Press REC/STOP() button for more than 1 second on PLAYBACK mode, "Add-R" will be displayed and a recording file will be added just after current playing message file.


<RESUME PLAY>

If you re-play a message just after pressing STOP button, PLAYBACK will be proceeded continuously from the pre-stopped time. (If another button except for PLAY/STOP() button is pressed at STOP position, the fore part of the last recording file will be played.)

<PLAY SPEED CONTROL>

To control the playing speed, press PLAY ($\ensuremath{\bigcirc}$) button for more than 1 second. The unit will be on SPEED Mode.


To cancel the SPEED Mode, press PLAY() button shortly. Select NOR, FAST(+30%), SLOW(-30%) Mode with ↑ ↓ jog key on SPEED Mode.



■ EDITING MESSAGES

Press MENU (This) button for a long time on Pause Mode, Div->Join> Move->OFF will be displayed in order.

Dividing a Message File




Reference

- A If memory or file number is FULL, file dividing can't be proceeded.
- . The recording dates of the two divided files are the same.
- ♣ With the edited message file, a playing time difference can be about 0.5 second.
- A The file less than 5 seconds recording can't be divided.

2. Combining Message files

Select Join Mode, let the fore message file play from 2 files you want to combine and press FUNC/DISP() Press MENU() button twice (first for a long time and second shortly), OFF/JOIN will be displayed. Select ON with \$\frac{1}{2}\text{(jog key and press MENU () in) button. Message files will be combined and the following file number will be decreased.

3. Moving a Message File

Press MENU(""") button for a long time on Pause Mode, the unit turns to "DIV" mode. Press MENU(""") button for a long time on Pause Mode, JOIN->MOVE->OFF will be displayed in order. Select Move ON with ∜ jog key and press MENU key (""") . And then select a folder (A,B,C,D) with ∜ √ jog key. Press MENU key(""") and confirm the moving a file.



☞Reference

- REC DATE will be effective for fore file number.
- ♣ If LOCK is set-up on one file out of 2 files, LOCK will be effective for the combined file.
- \clubsuit Files with different REC MODE can not be combined each other.
- ♣ The last message file can't be combined.



- All editing operation will be operated only on PAUSE Mode. If memory or file number is FULL,DIV->JOIN->MOV can't be operated and "CAN NOT" will be displayed.
- 2. Do not replace batteries on DIV->JOIN->MOV operation. File can't play back properly.

4.FILE EDIT

- 1. Editing a part of file
- 1) Divide the part(fore, mid, hind) which you want to edit.
- 2) Erase the file which you want to throw away.
- 3) If necessary, combine message files.
- 2. Adding new recording file
- 1) Divide file at the part where you want to add recording file.
- 2) Operate Add-R in the fore part of divided message file.
- 3) Combine files, again.
- 3. Inserting file
- 1) Divide file at the part where you want to insert.
- 2) Move the file which you want to insert into between the divided files.
- 3) Combine files twice.

■ CONNECTING WITH EXTERNAL APPLIANCE

1. Recording with external microphone

If you connect external microphone into MIC JACK, built-in mic will be excluded and you can record with optional external microphone. (You can clip external microphone onto your lapel, so that you can take free action. Also, you can record with much better sound quality by approaching sound source.)



- 2. In case of recording from external appliance into VR unit(audio cable1) Connect optional audio cable into both EARPHONE of external appliance and MIC of unit and press REC button. (Recording will be proceeded with L-ch mono and you can check recording condition with earphone.)
- 3. In case of recording from VR unit into external appliance(audio cable 2) Connect optional audio cable into both EAR of VR unit and MIC or external INPUT of external appliance and press both PLAY/STOP() button of VR unit and press REC button of external appliance. (Do test-recording in advance and you can't adjust volume level with VOLUME button of the voice recorder unit.)



Check3 Did you check the battery capacity? → Replace batteries.

In case of no sound from speaker

Check1 Isn't your VOLUME at 0 (Zero) position? → Adjust the

VOLUME button.

Check2 Isn't your Earphone inserted in?

Take the Earphone Jack OFF.

In case of no sound from Earphone

Check1 Isn't your VOLUME at 0 (Zero) position?

→ Adjust the VOLUME

Check2 Is your Earphone properly inserted in?

➡ Insert the Earphone Jack completely.
