# Cell Phone Etiquette

## Etiquette for Cell Phone Use

- The cell phone always emits weak radio waves when the power is on.
- Use the cell phone in an enjoyable and safe manner without forgetting to be considerate of others around you.

- The use of cell phones is not allowed in some places
  - Do not use the cell phone while you are driving. Doing so is both dangerous and prohibited by law.
  - Using a cell phone in an aircraft is prohibited by law. Be sure to turn the cell phone off.



- Radio waves from cell phones may interfere with medical electrical equipment
  - Some people close to you in busy places such as crowded trains may be using a pacemaker. Turn the cell phone off in such places.
  - Abide by the rules of hospitals and other medical institutions where it is forbidden to use or carry cell phones.



- Be considerate of where you use the cell phone and how loudly you talk
  - Do not make calls from cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries, and other similar places. Turn the power off or set the manner mode to prevent others around you from being inconvenienced by ring tones for incoming calls or mail.



- Do not use the cell phone in places where you will be in the way of others.
- Move to areas where you will not inconvenience others on trains or in hotel lobbies.
- Take care not to talk too loudly during calls.



- Obtain the permission of other people before you take their photos with the cell phone's camera.



- Do not use the cell phone's camera for recording information in bookstores and other locations where taking photos is not permitted.





# Manner Mode and Voice Memo

## Manner Mode



You can turn off the incoming call ring tone and other tones so as not to inconvenience other people.

When the standby screen is displayed, press  (side key 2), use  to select *Normal*, and press  (Select).

# Spam and One-ring Calls

## If you receive spam:

You can set the mail filters to reject only specific mail or mail indicated by "未承諾広告※" (unsolicited advertisement), which often tends to be spam.

The following mail filters are available for rejecting spam:

- ・ 未承諾広告フィルター (Unsolicited advertisement filter)
- ・ アドレスフィルター (Address filters)
  - 指定拒否設定 (for not receiving specific mail)
  - 指定受信設定 (for receiving specific mail only)

It may be an attempt to get you to return a call to a service with very high charges.


# Charging the Battery Pack

The battery pack is insufficiently charged at the time of purchase. Before you use the cell phone for the first time, charge the built-in battery pack.



Before Use

## How to Charge the Battery Pack



If you attach the attachment for data communication to the desktop holder, you can perform data communication during charging.

### 1 Connect the Toshiba AC adapter 02 to the desktop holder.

➔ With inscription of the connector facing down, connect the Toshiba AC adapter 02 to the power terminal on the rear of the desktop holder.

### 2 Connect the Toshiba AC adapter 02's power plug to a 100 V AC power outlet.

### 3 While the A5506T is closed and the battery pack attached, insert it into the desktop holder as shown in the figure.

### 4 Confirm that the charge indicator lights.




Hold the desktop holder while removing the A5506T.



Use the battery level indicator (see page 11) on the display as a guide for charging.

# Extending the Antenna

Hold the tip of the antenna and fully extend the antenna in the direction of the arrow.



 If the antenna is not fully extended, a sufficient signal may not be able to be sent and received. Also, if the antenna is extended perpendicular to the ground, it is easier to send and receive a signal.

 When retracting the antenna, hold the base of the antenna and slide it straight back into the A5506T. Holding the tip and using excessive force while retracting the antenna may result in the antenna being damaged.

**1** Hold down  for at least one second.









## Warp Function Key


Press the up, down, left, or right button to perform operations such as selecting an item or moving the cursor, and press the center button to confirm a selected item.

## Soft Keys

When indications such as the following are displayed at the bottom of the display, you can press the corresponding soft keys to perform the indicated operations. The soft key indications vary depending on the screen.




Soft key 1 	Performs the operation indicated at the bottom left of the screen.

# Using Menus

## Launcher Menu

You can access various A5506T functions from the Launcher menu. The Launcher menu contains the following items.

While the power is on, press the center button of the warp function key.





If you press  when  is displayed in a screen for making function settings, entering characters, or performing other operations, an Option menu for performing various related operations opens.




# Indicators


The indicators (pictures that indicate functions or states) allow you to check whether you have new incoming mail, the current settings of functions, and other information. It is useful to memorize the main indicators.

- ① Indicates the signal strength
- ② Indicates the battery level
- ③ : Indicates EZweb (Internet) is in use
- : Indicates a call is in progress
- ④ Indicates received or unread e-mail/c-mail
- ⑤ Indicates the current time and date
- ⑥ Indicates the manner mode is set
- ⑦ Indicates the voice memo or manner mode is set
- ⑧ Appears on the standby screen when a miniSD™ card (commercially available) is inserted. You can save moving and still images directly to a miniSD™ card.
- ⑨ Indicates new incoming mail or missed call



The time indication is set automatically to the current time and date.



The layouts and content of screens appearing in descriptions are only examples for the purpose of explanation and contain some indicators that cannot appear at the same time.



# Making Initial Settings

## Initial Settings for the A5506T

**1** When the standby screen is displayed, press .

➔The 初期設定 (Initial Settings) menu appears.



**2** Use  to select **設定しない (Do Not Setup)** and press  (**選択 [Select]**).

➔The Launcher menu appears.



-  Even if you do not make the initial settings, you can still make and answer calls.
-  The initial settings include changing the lock number and setting the character size, Caller ID, and incoming call ring tone.
-  You only need to make initial settings when first using the cell phone. Furthermore, you can also change the initial settings later.
-  After making initial settings, you can switch the display language to English (see page 20).
-  If you select **設定しない (Do Not Setup)**, the initial settings are as shown below.


## Making Initial Settings for E-mail and EZweb (Internet)

To use e-mail and EZweb (Internet), you need to apply for an EZweb subscription. If you did not apply for an EZweb subscription at the time of purchase, contact the au Customer Service Center or an au shop. Also, before use, be sure to make the initial settings. Your e-mail address is assigned automatically when you make the initial settings. For details on changing this e-mail address, see page 48.

.



### 2 Press (OK).

➔Wait a short while until the screen on the right appears to notify you that the settings are complete.



# Switching the Display Language to English

You can switch the display language for function names and other items to English.





# Checking Your Phone Number and E-mail Address

**1** When the standby screen is displayed, press .

➔The Launcher menu appears.

**2** Use  to select (Profile) and press  (Select).

➔The Profile screen appears and you can check your phone number and e-mail address.




From the standby screen, you can also check your phone number and e-mail address by pressing  and . However, no e-mail address will appear if you have not made the e-mail and EZweb (Internet) initial settings.

# Making and Receiving Calls

## Making a Call

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, use  to  to enter the recipient's phone number.



### Calling a regular phone

Enter the phone number starting with the area code.

### Calling a cell phone or PHS

Enter all 11 digits of the phone number starting with 0.

-  After you enter a phone number, you can add 184 or 186 to the phone number if you press  (Option), use  to select *Add/Off SP No...*, press  (Select), select *184* or *186*, and press  (Select).  
Add 184 if you do not want to notify the recipient of your phone number.  
Add 186 if you want to notify the recipient of your phone number.

- 2 Press .

- ➔ If the recipient's name is in the phone book, the name is also displayed.
- ➔ Wait a short while until you hear the ring tone.
- ➔ When you have finished the call, press .



# Answering a Call

## 1 The ring tone plays.

The phone number is displayed. If the caller's name is in the phone book, the name is also displayed.

- When "ID Unsent" is displayed, the caller has not sent Caller ID.
- When "Pay Phone" is displayed, the call is from a pay phone.
- When "Not Support" is displayed, the call is from a phone that cannot send Caller ID.



## 2 To answer the call, press .

➔When you have finished the call, press .



### Missed Call Notification

If you missed a call, you are notified of the call on the display.

To check the caller's phone number, use  to select  *Call* and press . You can then return the call (see page 25).




# Redialing and Returning Calls (Outgoing/Incoming History)

Example: Returning a call to a phone number in the incoming history

**1** When the standby screen is displayed, press .

→The Incoming History screen appears.




 To display the outgoing history, press  when the standby screen is displayed.

 The phone numbers are displayed in order of the most to least recent.

**2** Use  to select the phone number you want to call and press  (Info).

→The call information appears.



 To make a call without checking the information, press .

 If you press  (→OutH), the Outgoing History screen is displayed.

**3** Press  (Call) or .

→A call is made to the phone number displayed.



 The cell phone can store up to 20 phone numbers in each of the incoming history and outgoing history in order of the most to least recent.


# One-ring Calls

## What is a One-ring Call?

This is a call from an unknown caller that only rings once and is stored in the incoming history. The caller is attempting to get you to return a call to a service, such as a dating service, with very high charges.

## One-ring Indicator

When you have received a one-ring call (the ring tone played for less than three seconds), the red indicator  is displayed in the incoming history and "Absent" is displayed in the information for the call. Be careful when you return a call to an unknown caller.




# Setting the Manner Mode

The cell phone informs you of a call by vibrating.

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press  (side key 2).

→ The Manner Mode menu appears.



## Indicators

-  (Normal mode) : Sound related settings are turned off. This mode is convenient for times when sound would disturb other people such as during conferences, etc.
-  (Drive mode) : When answering calls is difficult such as during driving, have the voice memo answer calls for you.
-  (Original mode) : This mode allows you to configure the sound, vibrator, and other settings however you want.

- 2 Use  to select *Normal* and press  (Select).

→ The manner mode is set and  and  are displayed on the standby screen. The voice memo is set at the same time and  is also displayed on the standby screen.



 You can also set the manner mode by holding down  for at least one second when the standby screen is displayed.

## Canceling the Manner Mode

When the standby screen is displayed, hold down  for at least one second.

→ The manner mode is canceled and  and  disappear. The voice memo, which was set at the same time, is also canceled and  disappears.




 Even if the manner mode is set, the record start/end tone and shutter sound can still be heard during camera use.

# Setting the Voice Memo

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, hold down  for at least one second.

→The answering message (Japanese) is played, then the voice memo is set and  appears on the standby screen.



## Canceling the Voice Memo

When the standby screen is displayed, hold down  for at least one second.

→The voice memo is canceled and  disappears.



-  The cell phone can record a maximum of three messages, each up to 30 seconds long.
-  Use the answering service when you have turned off the power or are in a location where a signal cannot be received.
-  The cell phone can record up to a total of three voice memos and call voice memos. A call voice memo is for recording the voice of the other party during a call.

# Playing a Voice Memo

## If a voice memo is recorded

➔ *Memo* and the number of memos appear on the standby screen.



The number of memos is displayed next to the voice memo indicator on the standby screen.


x: Indicates that the cell phone has recorded x voice memos and has space to record.

x: Indicates that the cell phone has recorded x voice memos and has no space to record.

: Indicates that the cell phone has recorded only call voice memos and has no space to record.

## 1 Use to select *Memo* and press .

➔The Play Voice Memo list appears.



## 2 Use to select the voice memo you want to play and press (Play).

➔A voice memo plays.



To stop the voice memo, press (Stop).



To delete the voice memo that is playing, press (Option), select *Delete*, and press (Select). Then, use to select *Yes* and press (OK).

# Changing the Incoming Ring Tone

You can select an incoming ring tone from 14 fixed patterns, 6 fixed melodies, 7 effect sounds, and a melody in Data folder (1 melody by default), or search for a melody on EZweb.

**1** When the standby screen is displayed, press .

→The Launcher menu appears.




**2** Use  to select (Function) and press  (Select).




**3** Use  to select *Sound/Vibrator* and press  (Select).

→The Sound/Vibrator menu appears.




**4** Use  to select *Melody* and press  (Select).

→The Melody menu appears.




**5** Use  to select *Incoming Call* and press  (Select).

➔The Incoming Call menu appears.



**6** Use  to select *Fixed Pattern* and press  (Select).

➔The Fixed Pattern menu appears.



**7** Use  to select *Pattern 3* and press  (Play).

 If you press  (Back) or , the tone stops playing and you can select another tone.



**8** Press  (OK).

➔The incoming ring tone is set.



 The A5506T comes with incoming ring tones pre-installed.

# Adjusting the Incoming Ring Tone Volume

**1** When the standby screen is displayed, press .

→ The Launcher menu appears.

**2** Use  to select (Function) and press  (Select).




**3** Use  to select *Sound/Vibrator* and press  (Select).

→ The Sound/Vibrator menu appears.




**4** Use  to select *Volume* and press  (Select).



## 5 Use to select *Incoming Call* and press (Select).

➔The screen for adjusting the incoming call ring tone appears.



## 6 Use to adjust the volume and press (OK).

Each press of  increases or decreases the volume.



After the cell phone vibrates, the incoming ring tone plays at a gradually increasing volume.

STEP DOWN:

The incoming ring tone plays at a gradually decreasing volume.

STEP UP:

The incoming ring tone plays at a gradually increasing volume.

➔The Tel. #1 entry screen appears.



## 4 Enter a phone number and press (OK).

➔The Tel. #1 Class menu appears.



If the phone number is for a regular phone, enter the phone number starting with the area code. If the phone number is for a cell phone or PHS, be sure to enter all 11 digits of the phone number.



You can also open, for example, the outgoing history or incoming history to select a phone number to enter. Press  (Option), use  to select *History/Memo...*, press  (Select), and use  to select *Outgo History* (Outgoing History), *Incom History* (Incoming History), or another item.


## 5 Use to select a phone number class and press (Select).

➔The New screen reappears.




## 6 Use to select *E-mail 1* and press (Select).

➔The E-mail 1 entry screen appears. To skip entering an e-mail address, proceed to Step 9.



## 7 Enter an e-mail address and press (OK).

➔The E-mail 1 Class menu appears.



For details on entering e-mail addresses, see page 78.



You can also open, for example, the sent history to select an e-mail address to enter. Press  (Option), use  to select *History/Memo...*, press  (Select), and use  to select *Sent History* or another item.

**8** Use  to select an e-mail address class and press  (Select).

➔ The New screen reappears.



**9** Press  (Add) and press  (Add).

➔ The entry is saved as the phone book memory number 000.



The cell phone automatically saves the entry as the lowest available memory number from 000 to 499.



You can save two phone numbers and two e-mail addresses to each phone book entry.



You can also set other items such as a group, postal address, birthday, and URL.

# Calling a Phone Number from the Phone Book

- 1 When the standby screen is displayed, press  to display the phone book list.



To scroll through the screens, use .  
The entries are in the Japanese syllabary order (あ to 他).



- 2 Use  to select the entry containing the phone number you want to dial and press  (Select).

➔The information saved to the entry appears.



- 3 Select the phone number and press .

➔A call is made to the phone number in the selected entry.




 If there is more than one phone number in the entry, use  to select the phone number you want to dial and then press .

# Editing Phone Book Entries



**1** Press  (Option), use  to select *Edit*, and press  (Select).

➔The Edit screen appears.



**2** Edit the contents and press  (Add).

**3** Use  to select *Overwrite* and press  (OK).

➔The contents of the phone book entry are edited.






## Using E-mail

To use e-mail, you need to apply for an EZweb (Internet) subscription. If you did not apply for an EZweb subscription at the time of purchase, contact the au Customer Service Center or an au shop. Also, before use, be sure to make the initial settings. If you have not yet made the initial settings, see page 19.


The e-mail service enables you to use an Internet e-mail address for exchanging text information (messages) with e-mail compatible cell phones, personal computers, and other devices. The cell phone is capable of sending messages containing up to 10,000 single-byte characters (5000 double-byte characters), as well as moving images (movies), still images (photos) and other information.

E-mail fees are charged as data communication fees that vary according to the amount of data (packet data) you send and receive via e-mail.

### Outing Menu




Displays the menu items of various navigation services useful for an outing.

### Go Home



Register the information of places to navigate to such as places you visit frequently.

### My Spot



Create mail to notify somebody of your current position.

### Current Mail



The EZnaviWalk application is required to use EZnaviWalk. If you do not have the application, the cell phone will download it automatically when you attempt to use EZnaviWalk. Follow the on-screen instructions.




Registration with the EZnaviWalk service (pay service) is required to use EZnaviWalk.



The layouts and content of screens appearing in descriptions are only examples for the purpose of explanation. The layouts and content of actual screens are subject to change.

## Cell Phone with Navigation System!

EZnaviWalk is a full-fledged pedestrian navigation system to guide you to your destination. It includes various easy-to-use features to help when you are on an outing or lost. Let's try it out.



### ① When you want to know where you are, use Current Map.


Use this feature to find out where you are when you first visit somewhere or are lost. Just selecting *Current Map* displays a map of your current location in real time.



Your first positioning result is indicated by ★. Once the map has been displayed, your current position is continuously obtained and then indicated by in real time.

### ③ When you want to know the way home, use Go Home.

No matter where you are, you will receive easy-to-follow navigation information on the route home if you have registered the location of your home beforehand. This feature is also extremely useful for finding out where to change trains and scheduled arrival times.



## ② When you are on an outing, use Outing Menu.

### ●おすすりスポット (Recommended Spots)

Introduces popular spots for people who want to always go to different places, such as people dating.

### ●電車／終電ナビ (Train Schedule/Last Train Navigation)

Search for information on changing trains and the time of the last train by specifying departure and arrival stations.

### ●地図検索 (Map Search)


Use various search methods to find a place. You can also register a place as a new My Spot entry.

### ●道路交通情報 (Road Traffic Information)

Use the vehicle information and communication system to check traffic information on any of the main roads nationwide in real time.

## ④ When you find a place you like, register it as a My Spot entry.


Register places you go to frequently and enjoyed (home, company, friend's house, store, etc.) so as to easily navigate to them from wherever you are.



## ⑤ When you want to let somebody know where you are, use Current Mail.

When, for example, you have arranged to meet somebody, send a message to let the person know your current location. The person can then navigate to your location (EZnaviWalk compatible cell phones only).

# Registering Your Current Location as Your Home (My Spot)

Register the information of places you go to frequently and enjoyed (home, company, friend's house, store, etc.) to My Spot and use that information to check maps of the surrounding areas.


- 1** From the EZnaviWalk menu, use  to select *My Spot*, and press  (Select).

➔The My Spot menu appears.



- 2** Use  to select *Home*, press  (Option), use  to select *Add GPS Info*, and press  (Select).

➔The Pick GPS Info menu appears.



- 3** Use  to select *Current Point*, press  (Select) to obtain the GPS information, and press  (OK).

➔Your current location is registered as your home.





# Entering Characters

## Character Entry Modes

When a character entry screen is displayed, you can select the character entry mode if you press .

### Menu Items

Kanji: Kanji conversion mode

a A: Double-byte alphanumeric mode


abAB: Single-byte alphanumeric mode

1 2: Double-byte number mode

1234: Single-byte number mode

Use  to select a character entry mode and

press  (Select).



## Entering Single-byte Alphanumeric Characters



Before you enter single-byte alphanumeric characters, switch to the single-byte alphanumeric mode.

You can use the keys  to  to enter characters. More than one character is assigned to each key. For example, each press of  changes the displayed character to the next character assigned to the key in the order of a → b → c → A → B → C → 2.



When you change your e-mail address, you cannot use the characters in  for the account name (part of the address before @).

## Entering Characters Assigned to the Same Key Consecutively

After you enter the first character, press  to move the cursor (■) to the right and then enter the next character.

Example: Entering "ab"



## Deleting Characters

To delete one character at a time, move the cursor to the character you want to delete and press . To delete all characters after the cursor, hold down  for at least one second. If there are no characters after the cursor, holding down  for at least one second deletes all characters.

## Starting a New line

Press .

➔ You cannot add a line break in the c-mail entry screen and some other entry screens.

# Entering E-mail Addresses



Before you enter an e-mail address, switch to single-byte alphanumeric mode.

## E-mail Address Compatible Characters

For the account name (part before @), you can enter up to 20 single-byte alphanumeric characters including hyphens (-) and periods (.). However, you cannot enter periods consecutively or at the beginning or end, or enter a zero (0) at the beginning.

## How to Enter E-mail Addresses



To enter ".co.jp," etc., you can use the Sentence Category menu.

Use to to enter characters and numbers.





**2** Use  to select   and press  (Select).

➔The Pictogram screen appears.



**3** Use  to select the pictogram you want to enter and press  (Select).

➔The pictogram is entered in the character entry screen.



 You can enter pictograms consecutively if you press  (Repeat) instead of  (Select).

 Pictograms are not displayed properly on non-au cell phones, personal computers, and other devices.

## Only Mail

Send a message with a movie or photo attachment to a specific recipient without opening the A5506T.

## Cuckoo Clock

On the hour, a movie is played on the sub display to inform you of the time.

## EZ Chaku-Uta™

Set a song of an artist as is as an incoming ring tone.

## Movie Setting

Set a movie you recorded yourself as an incoming ring tone or incoming screen.

## Edit Movie

Add subtitles (2 lines of 10 characters) and record a voiceover after recording a movie.

## EZ Applications (BREW™)

Enjoy various applications including high-volume games rich in expressive features and standby applications.

## Photo Mixer

Use an animation template with melody to create your own original animation from a mixture of photos and text. You can send the animation attached to e-mail.

## Smart Mode

By switching to smart mode, you can ensure cell phone operation is simple by limiting functions to those used frequently such as the phone, phone book, camera, mail, and EZweb (Internet).
