Etiquette

Cellphone etiquette

Cellphones always emit weak signals while its power is on.

Enjoy using your cellphone safely without disturbing those around you.

Some places forbid the use of cellphones.

- Do not use your cellphone while you are driving. Doing so is dangerous and against the law.
- The use of a cellphone on aircraft is against the law. Be sure to turn your cellphone off before you board an aircraft.

Consider where to use your cellphone and be careful of how loud you are speaking.

- Do not make calls while in cinemas, theaters, museums, libraries or other similar places. Turn your cellphone off or set it to the manner mode to prevent others around you from being disturbed by the ringtone.
- Use your cellphone in places where you are not blocking traffic from passing.
- Move to areas where you do not disturb others on trains or in hotel lobbies.



· Ask for other people's permission before taking their photos with your cellphone's camera.

Signals from cellphones may adversely effect medical apparatus and equipment.

- Some people close to you in busy places such as crowded trains may have a pacemaker. Turn your cellphone off in such places.
- Abide by the rules of hospitals and other medical institutions where it is forbidden to use or possess cellphones.





Basics of the cellphone

What W53S offers



You can send mails to other cellphones or PCs.





Camera

You can take photos or record movies and send them by e-mail easily.



You can download Chaku-Uta®(ringtones), Chaku-Uta-Full®(full songs) or wallpapers.





EZ Navi

W53S supports "EZ Navi Walk," "Passenger Seat Navi," "Evacuate Navi" and "Security Navi" functions to confirm various location information.





W53S can be used as a portable music player.





EZ FeliCa

You can use W53S as electronic money for shopping, member's cards, point cards, or to get e-coupon information as well.



+JOG (plus jog)

With +JOG, you can directly call up W53S features and perform operations simply.



Custom Menu

You can customise your own menu by setting frequently used functions.



Manner mode and record message

Manner mode

You can use the manner mode to turn ringtones and other tones off to prevent others from being disturbed.

Hold down $(\overline{\mbox{gr}})$ for at least one second in the idle screen.



Record message

You can record messages from other parties using answering message when you are unable to answer the call. Hold down (KED) for at least one second in the idle screen.



Check the power, the signal, and the battery!

Usually, keep the cellphone's "power" on.

To make or receive calls, turn the power on. Hold down for at least one second.



You cannot connect where you are not able to get a "signal."

It is sometimes difficult to get a signal in places even within the service area.

indicates the reception strength.



Pay attention to the remaining "battery" power.

The cellphone may not function properly if the remaining battery power is low.

indicates the remaining battery power.



Do not use the cellphone while driving

It is against the law to even handle a cellphone while driving. (November 1, 2004 Implementation of the Revised Road Traffic Law Enforcement)

Use drive mode or turn the power off while driving

Drive mode

When the drive mode is set, the answering message saying "I am driving right now. Please leave your name and message after the beep." plays in Japanese and the caller's message can be recorded.

Press Press in the idle screen, and use \clubsuit and \blacksquare to select "Drive."



Watch out for spam and one-ring call!

If you get incoming spam...

You can use the mail filter function to block the mail you specify/spoof e-mail.

The following are the main mail filter functions available for preventing spam:

- · Reject e-mails marked with "未承諾広告※."
- · Reject specified e-mails.
- · Reject spoof e-mail.



If you have an incoming call from an unknown number...

Such calls may be a scam to get you to return a call to the service with very high charges. This is called a "one-ring call."



The icon *icon* will appear in the Received calls when you receive a one-ring call.

Be careful when you return a call to a number you don't know.



Disaster Message Board Service

If a large scale disaster occurs, you can register your vital information through EZweb. The registered vital information can be viewed from anywhere in Japan through EZweb or the Internet.

> If a large scale disaster occurs, you can use your au cellphone to register your vital information such as your condition or comments to the "Disaster Message Board" created on EZweb.

Registering the vital information

After registering your vital information, you can notify it by e-mail to your preregistered family or acquaintances. They will be able to know that you posted your vital information on the "Disaster Message Board."

Viewing the vital information You can view the vital information of a person you want to know by entering the phone number from EZweb or the Internet.^{**1}
 You can view the vital information from other carriers' cellphones.

How to charge the battery

The battery pack is not fully charged at the time of purchase. Before you use the W53S, charge the battery pack.

Connect the standard AC adaptor 01 (optional) to the connecting terminal of the desktop holder.

Carefully check the connector shape, and then connect it.



Fold out the power plug of the standard AC adaptor 01 (optional), and plug it into a 100 V AC power outlet.



Place W53S (closed, Battery pack attached) onto the desktop holder.



• Charging is in progress Charge start tone sounds and the charge indicator lights up in red.

• Charging is finished Charge completed tone sounds and the charge indicator light turns off.

When the battery is fully charged, pull out W53S upwards.

Charging by directly connecting the standard AC adaptor 01 (optional)

You can also charge the battery pack by directly connecting the standard AC adaptor 01 (optional) to the W53S.

Carefully check the connector shape, and then connect it.



How to attach Style-Up Panel

To remove

Style-Up Pane

- 1 Open the slot cover.
- ② Lift the panel up from the center of the bottom edge (shown as (A)) and remove.

To attach

- 1 Open the slot cover.
- ② Set protruding edges to corresponding notches on W53S as shown below.
- ③ Attach the panel in the direction of the arrow.

Push the (B) part downwards until it clicks into place.

④ Close the slot cover.



Be sure to close "Memory Stick Duo" slot cover completely (the slot cover is also used to lock the Style-Up Panel).



How to connect stereo earphone to W53S

Connect the stereo earphone to the Sony Ericsson roundtype earphone jack conversion adaptor 01.

Slide the earphone terminal cover to open in the direction of the arrow, as shown below. Then insert the Sony Ericsson round-type earphone jack conversion adaptor 01 plug straight to the terminal.

Do not force to connect in the wrong direction. Otherwise, it may cause damage. Please connect in the direction as shown in the illustration above.

How to use +JOG

With W53S, you can call up features or select items by using +JOG (plus jog) and Soft Keys. +JOG contains cross key and "Jog Dial" in the center. When selecting items, press cross key or turn the Jog Dial up and down to move the cursor to where you want to place it. Then press the Jog Dial to enter your selection.

. In this manual, operations to move the cursor are explained with cross key movement.





Soft keys work according to the displayed indication as shown below.

The displayed indications and function of the keys will vary depending on the operation selected.

The display if you are unable to answer a call

If you are unable to answer a call, you are notified that you had a call on the display.

If you press (select), you can confirm the phone number of the other party that called you and redial that party.

Setting the manner mode

The W53S vibrates to notify you of incoming calls.





To cancel the manner mode

Hold down $\fbox{r-}$ for at least one second in the idle screen.

There are four types of manner settings: "Manner," "Silent," "Drive" and "Original."

Setting the record message



Hold down (RED) for at least one second in the idle screen.





Record message is set, and prears in the display.

You can also use the record message to record a message from the other party by pressing 20 (memo) while receiving a call.

You can record up to three messages within 20 seconds each.

To cancel record message

Hold down $(\ensuremath{\texttt{XED}})$ for at least one second in the idle screen.

- If the record message still contains any message, [[1]] remains in the display even after canceling record message. [[1]] disappears when record message data is deleted.
- When you turn the power off or when you are in a place where the signal is weak, use Answering Service (Voice Mail).

When the front passenger check for driving route information: "Passenger Seat Navi"

Passenger Seat Navi is the service for the passenger (sitting next to the driver) to provide the optimum route information to the destination using map and voice navigation.
