





Photos

To view pictures, select “**photos**” from the main menu and press the **[MODE]** button to enter the photo browser.

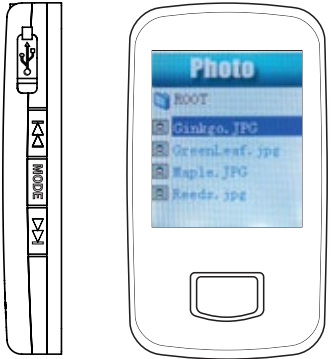


Photo browser screen

- 1. Use the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to scroll through the “**ROOT**” folder and select a photo you would like to view, and press the **[MAIN]** button.
- 2. Use the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to scroll through your pictures.
- 3. Press the **[MAIN]** button again to return to the “**ROOT**” folder.

Photo menu

While in the “**ROOT**” folder, press the **[MODE]** button to access the photo menu where you can select from the following options:

Photo	<b>Local folder</b> – browse photo files on the player
>>Local folder	<b>Slideshow</b> – set slideshow mode
>>Slideshow	<b>Delete file</b> – delete a single photo file
>>Delete file	<b>Delete all</b> – delete all photo files
>>Delete all	<b>Exit</b> – exit to photo playback screen
>>Exit	

Slideshow

- 1. To view all pictures in slideshow mode, press the **[MODE]** button while in the “**ROOT**” folder to enter the photo menu, then select “**Playback set**”, then choose “**Auto Play**”.
- 2. Choose a time interval between photos, then press the **[MAIN]** button to start the slidshow.
- 3. To stop the slideshow and return to the “**ROOT**” menu, press the **[MAIN]** button again
- .

Record

To record voice memos, select “**record**” from the main menu and press the **[MODE]** button to enter the recording mode.

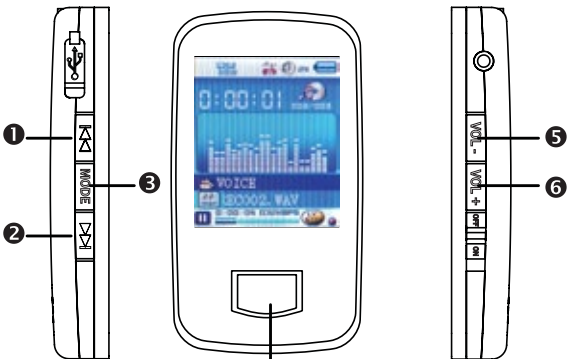
- 1. Press the **[MAIN]** button to start recording.
- 2. To pause recording, press the **[MAIN]** button again.
- 3. To save the recording and exit to the main menu, press and HOLD the **[MAIN]** button or the **[MODE]** button.

Voice

To play back recorded voice memos, select “voice” from the main menu and press the **[MODE]** button to enter the voice memos mode.

Voice playback controls

- 1. **[◀▶]** button – Previous memo / Rewind (hold)
- 2. **[▶▶]** button – Next memo / Fast forward (hold)
- 3. **[MODE]** button – Enter voice memo menu
- 4. **[MAIN]** button – Play / Pause
- 5. **[VOL-]** button – Decrease volume
- 6. **[VOL +]** button – Increase volume

Voice Menu 1

While music is PLAYING, press the **[MODE]** button to access music menu 1 where you can select from the following options:

Voice	
>>Repeat	<b>Repeat</b> – memo repeat options
>>Replay mode	<b>Replay mode</b> – memo loop options
>>Exit	<b>Exit</b> – exit to voice memo playback screen

Voice menu 2

While music is PAUSED, press the **[MENU]** button to access music menu 2 where you can select from the following options:

Voice	<b>Local folder</b> – browse voice memos on the player
>>Local folder	<b>Delete file</b> – delete a single voice memos
>>Delete file	<b>Delete all</b> – delete all voice memos
>>Delete all	<b>Exit</b> – exit to voice memo playback screen
>>Exit	

To listen to radio, select “radio” from the main menu and press the **[MODE]** button to enter the radio mode.

- 1. Press the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to tune the radio manually through the FM dial.
- 2. Press and HOLD the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button for one second to tune backward or forward to the next available station.

**To save a station to the preset list:**  
You can save up to 20 preset stations for your enjoyment.

- 1. While liseting to a station you want to save, press the **[MODE]** button.
- 2. Use the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to select “Save” from the music menu and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm. The station will now be saved to the preset list.
- 3. To scroll through the Preset Stations, press the **[▶■]** button.

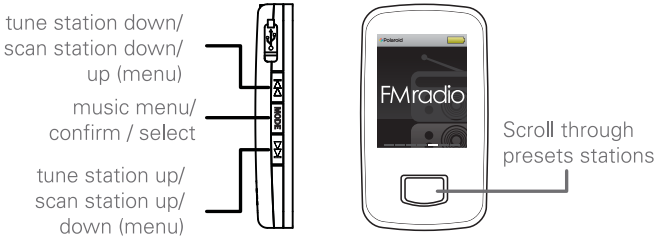
Note: The headphones must by plugged into the player for the FM Radio feature to work.

To delete a station from the preset list:

- 1. Tune to the station you would like to delete and press the **[MODE]** button.
- 2.Use the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to select “Delete” and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.
- 3.If you would like to delete all preset stations, select “Delete all” and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.

Autoscan:

- 1. To make the player autoscan and save all available stations to your preset list, press the **[MODE]** button, then select “**Auto Search**” and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.
- 2. The player will scan through all available stations and save them to your Preset list.



Note: Selecting “Autoscan” will erase your previously saved preset stations and replace them with all available stations in your area.

Recording FM Radio

- 1. While listening to FM radio, press the **[MODE]** button, use the **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to select “record”, then press the **[MODE]** button to confirm. The FM record screen will open.
- 2. To start recording, press the **[▶■]** button.
- 3. To stop recording, press the the **[▶■]** button.
- 4. To continue recording within the same file press the **[▶■]** button, the press the **[▶■]** button to stop recording.
- 5. To save the file press and HOLD the **[MODE]** button.

To listen to your FM Recorded files:

- 1. Select “voice” from the main menu and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.
- 2. Press the **[MODE]** button, select “Local folder” and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.
- 3. Select “Voice Memos” and press the **[MODE]** button to confirm.
- 4. You can now browse your recorded FM Radio files and press the **[▶■]** button to listen to your choice.

Settings

In the settings menu you can customize various player settings such as power usage, language, display settings and more.

- 1. To adjust date and time, select “**Clock**” from the setup menu. Press the **[MAIN]** button to select an option and use **[◀▶]** or **[▶▶]** button to adjust.

Adjust the “LCD Set” and “Power off” options to extend and optimize battery performance.

Troubleshooting

- Can not power on**
  - The battery may be exhausted, please recharge the battery.
- Files can not be transferred to the player**
  - Check if the driver is installed correctly in the computer by disconnecting and then reconnecting the player to the computer
  - Check the connection between the player and PC, and confirm the USB cable is properly connected.
- No sound from the headphones**
  - Please ensure the volume is turned up, and the \ headphones are properly connected.
  - Check if the format of music file is supported by the player.
- Can not record**
  - Check if there is enough memory and battery capacity.
- Display is in the wrong language**
  - Please ensure you selected the correct language from the “Settings” menu.
- I cannot display my .jpg files**
  - Many digital cameras and image editing softwares add hidden data to the .jpg files. This data can prevent the player from loading the images. Try to eliminate them by saving the file with another name.
