
- c. Remove the entire decal, position in place and slide the decal backing material from under the decal and onto the model as close to final position as possible.
- d. Gently blot out excess water with a clean paper towel. e. Allow decals to set overnight before applying protective clear coat.
- 10. When decals are dry, spray entire rocket (body and nose cone separately) with a light coat of Testors Gloss Lacguer (#1961). This will provide added protection and shine to your Satellite Interceptor™ rocket!
